- Must be from the from Metropolitan Atlanta* area for the \$6,000.00 tuition-supported/book scholarship.
- Must be an incoming freshman, (the first year after graduating high school).
- Must exhibit a Financial Need after completion of all financial resources.
- Must have a minimum 2.8 Grade Point Average.
- Must maintain good academic standing throughout the term of enrollment.

Application Process:

- Scholarship Essay describing his/her ambitions and goals, as well as what he/she would hope to contribute to society through educational training from South Carolina State University. (100 words not to exceed 300 words) using MLA Word format.
- Upload official copy high school transcript. Do not submit zip files, timed uploads or password protected documents.
- Upload 2 letters of recommendations. **One letter <u>MUST</u> be from your school's counselor on letterhead.** The other letter may be a teacher, a community mentor or a <u>non-family member</u> SCSU alumnus, with an address and contact number on the letter.
- Demonstrated Financial Need (SCSU Financial Aid Award Letter or SCSU verified financial transcript), FAFSA Award Letter
- Upload evidence of community service, leadership and any other extra-curricular awards.
