Applicant Eligibility:

Must have applied and received a letter of acceptance to South Carolina State University (SCSU)

- Must be from the Metropolitan Atlanta* area for the \$6,000.00 tuition-supported book scholarship
- Must be an incoming freshman (the first year after graduating high school)
- Must exhibit a financial need after completion of all financial resources. Must have a minimum 2.8 Grade Point Average
- Must maintain good academic standing throughout the term of enrollment
- By signing this application, you give Atlanta Chapter-SCSUNAA permission to use your photograph on our website and social media if selected for the award.

Application Process:

- Scholarship Essay describing ambitions and goals as well as what would hope to contribute to society through educational training from South Carolina State University (100 words not to exceed 300 words) using MLA Word format
- Upload official copy high school transcript. Do not submit zip files, timed uploads or password protected documents.
- Upload 2 letters of recommendations. One letter MUST be from your school's counselor on letterhead. The other letter may be from a teacher, a community mentor or a non-family member SCSU alumnus, with an address and contact number on the letter.
- Demonstrated financial need: SCSU Financial Aid Award Letter, SCSU verified financial transcript, FAFSA Award Letter
- Upload evidence of community service, leadership and any other extra-curricular awards.
