

Despite what God's Word instructs us, there are many in the church who are revising God's Word in various ways. For instance, there are those in the church who now support the LGBTQIA+ movement & even abortion, claiming the church needs to change because the culture has changed in its attitudes toward such ideas. They reinterpret God's Word to fit with the changing v i e w s o f t h e world. Actually, revisionist history is a major tool of the devil. He used it on Eve 6,000 years ago as recorded in Genesis 3:1, asking, "Did God actually say...?" Paul warns us in 2 Corinthians 11:3 that the devil will use the same method on us. In other words, there will always be pressure to reinterpret God's clear word to fit with what the devil wants us to believe. Such revisionist history has happened in different ways down through time. The Reformation was a movement to overcome a particular type of revisionist history & return to God's Word. Our modern era of revisionist history really began in the 1800s when church leaders began compromising to fit millions of years & evolution into God's Word. This unlocked a door to teach younger generations that they could take man's ideas & reinterpret God's Word. This revisionist history in Genesis has now permeated much of Scripture, as many in the younger generations - though brought up in the church - now reinterpret God's Word in regard to marriage & many other issues. The devil has always used revisionist history to undermine God's Word. Take heed of God's warning: But I am afraid that as the serpent deceived Eve by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere & pure devotion to Christ. (2 Corinthians 11:3)
