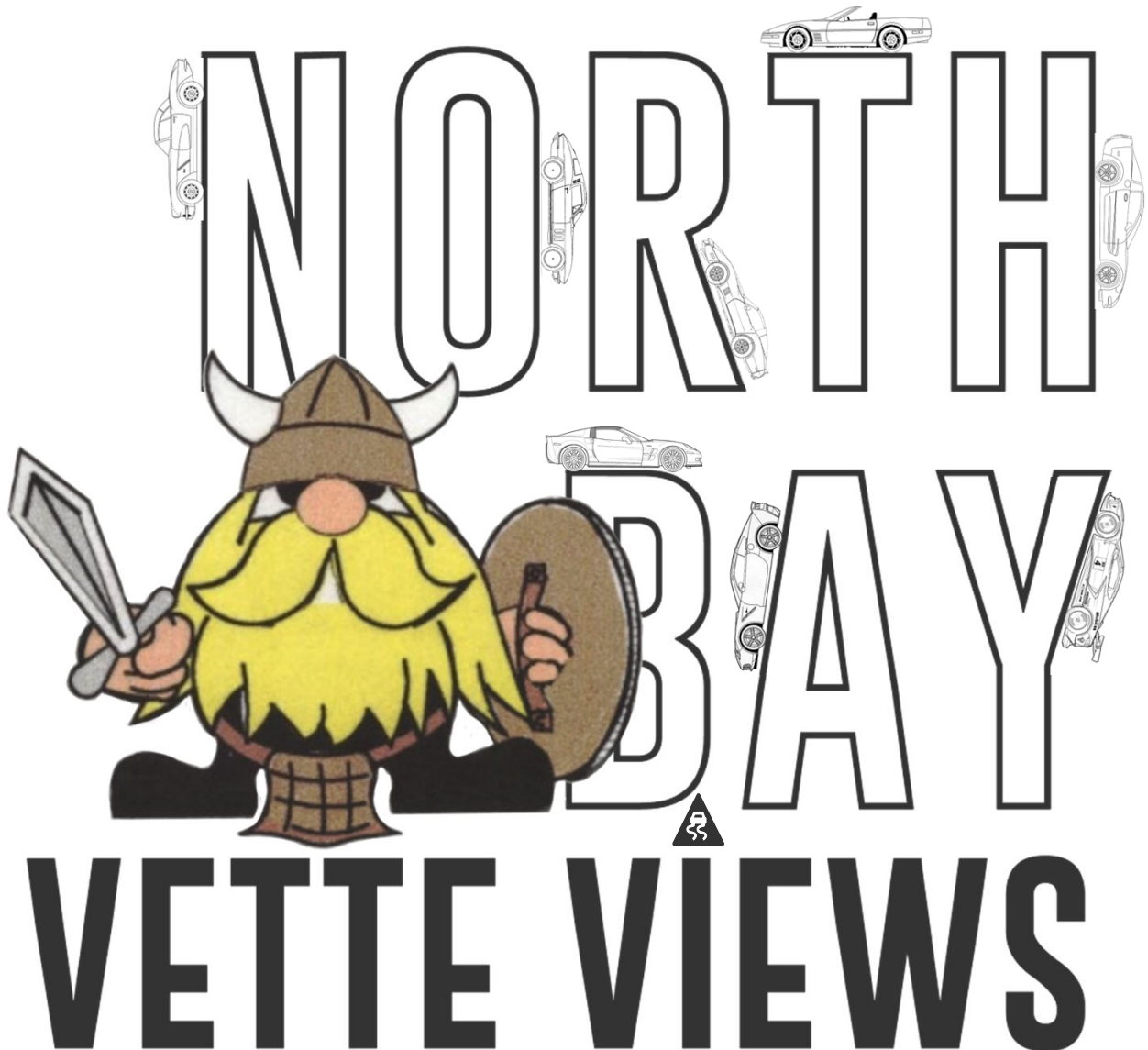

Hello NBCA members:

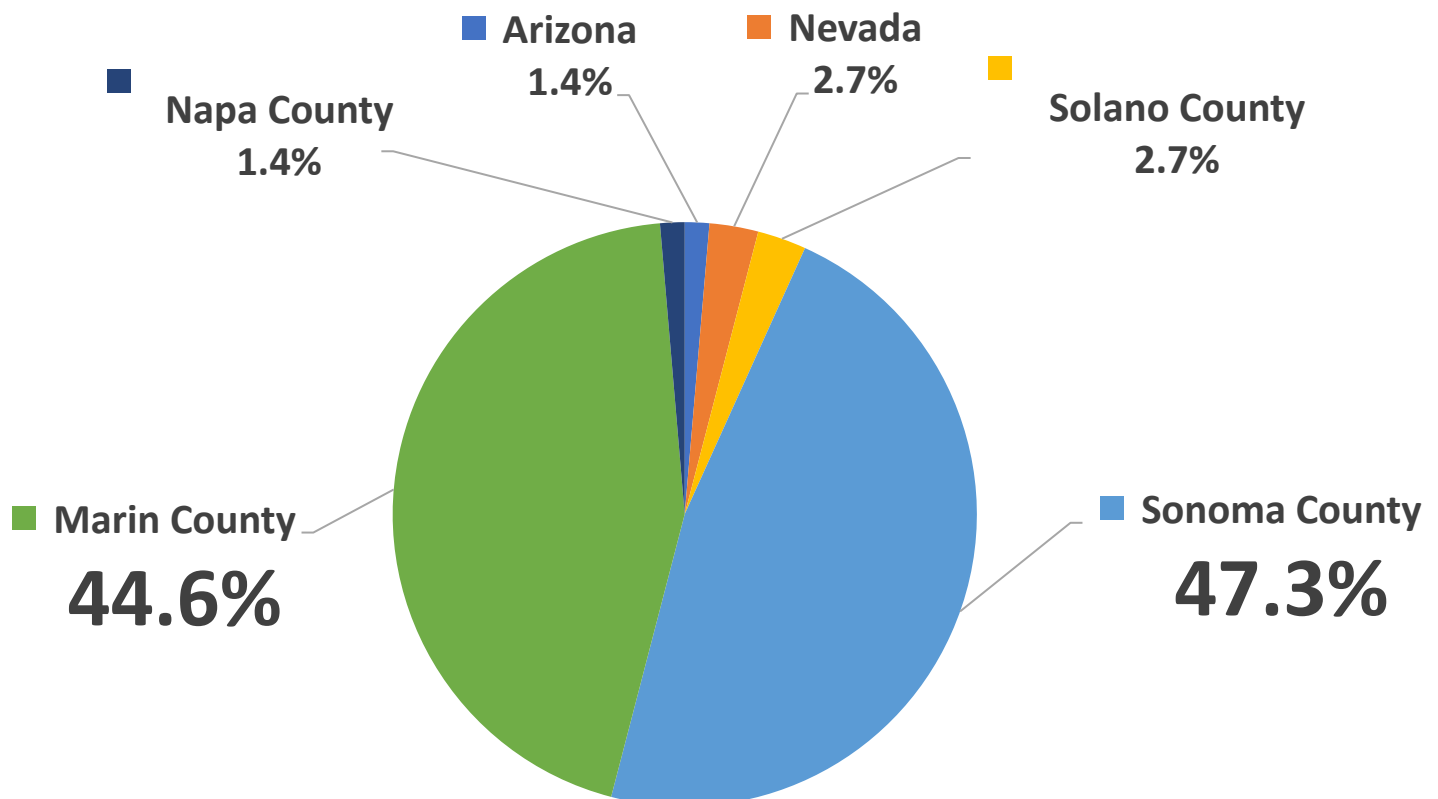
Just FYI I had an incredible vacation in Nashville last month and I recommend going to anyone! So much fun!!

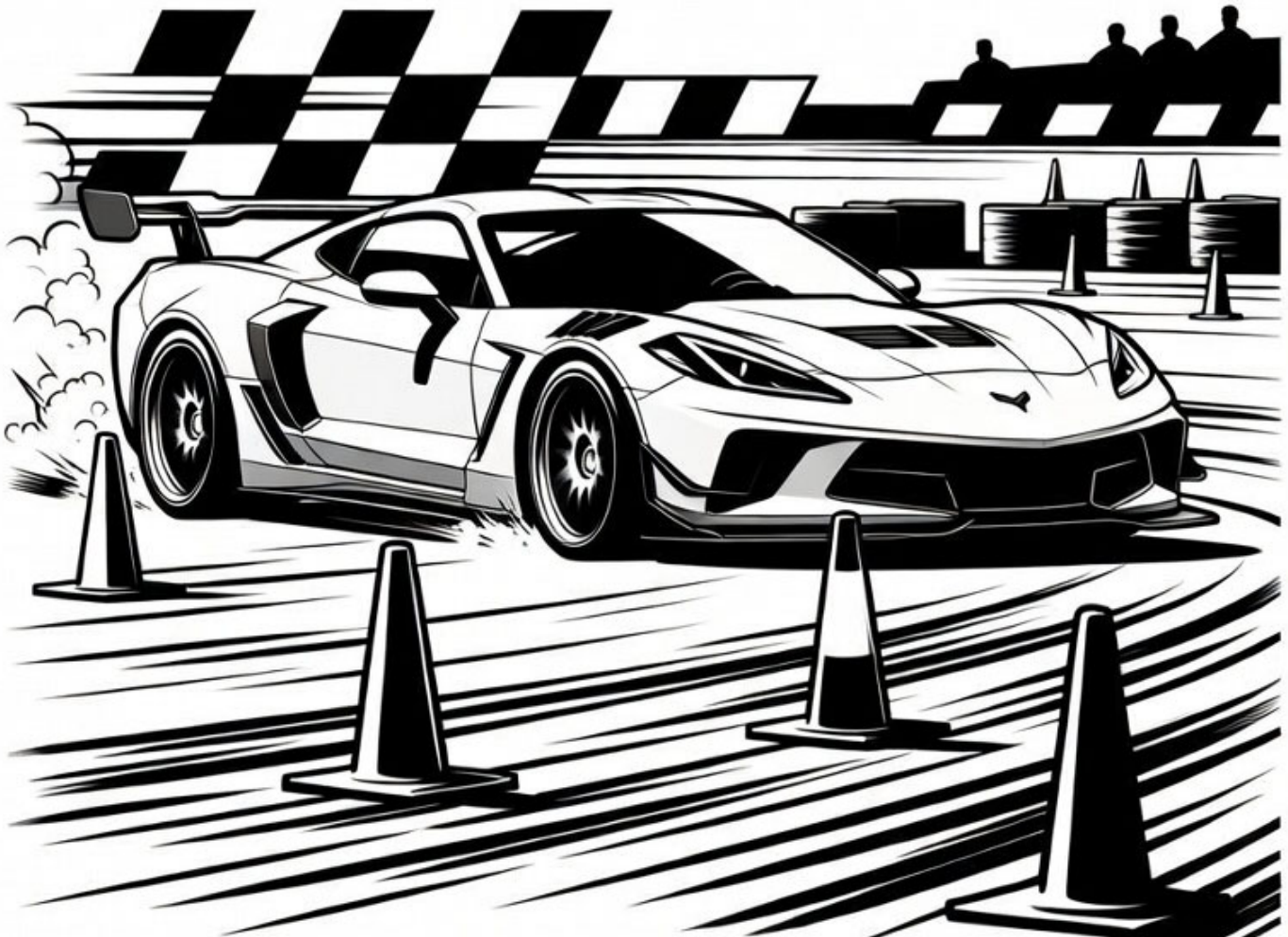
General Meeting:

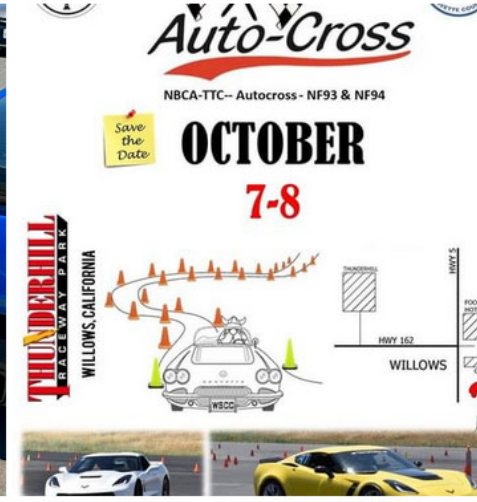

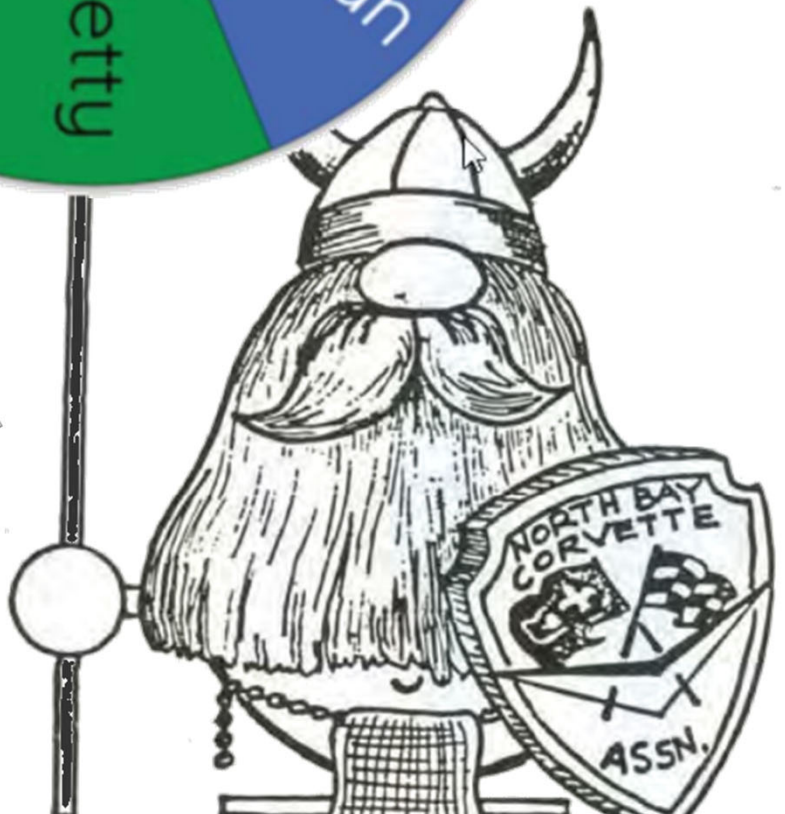

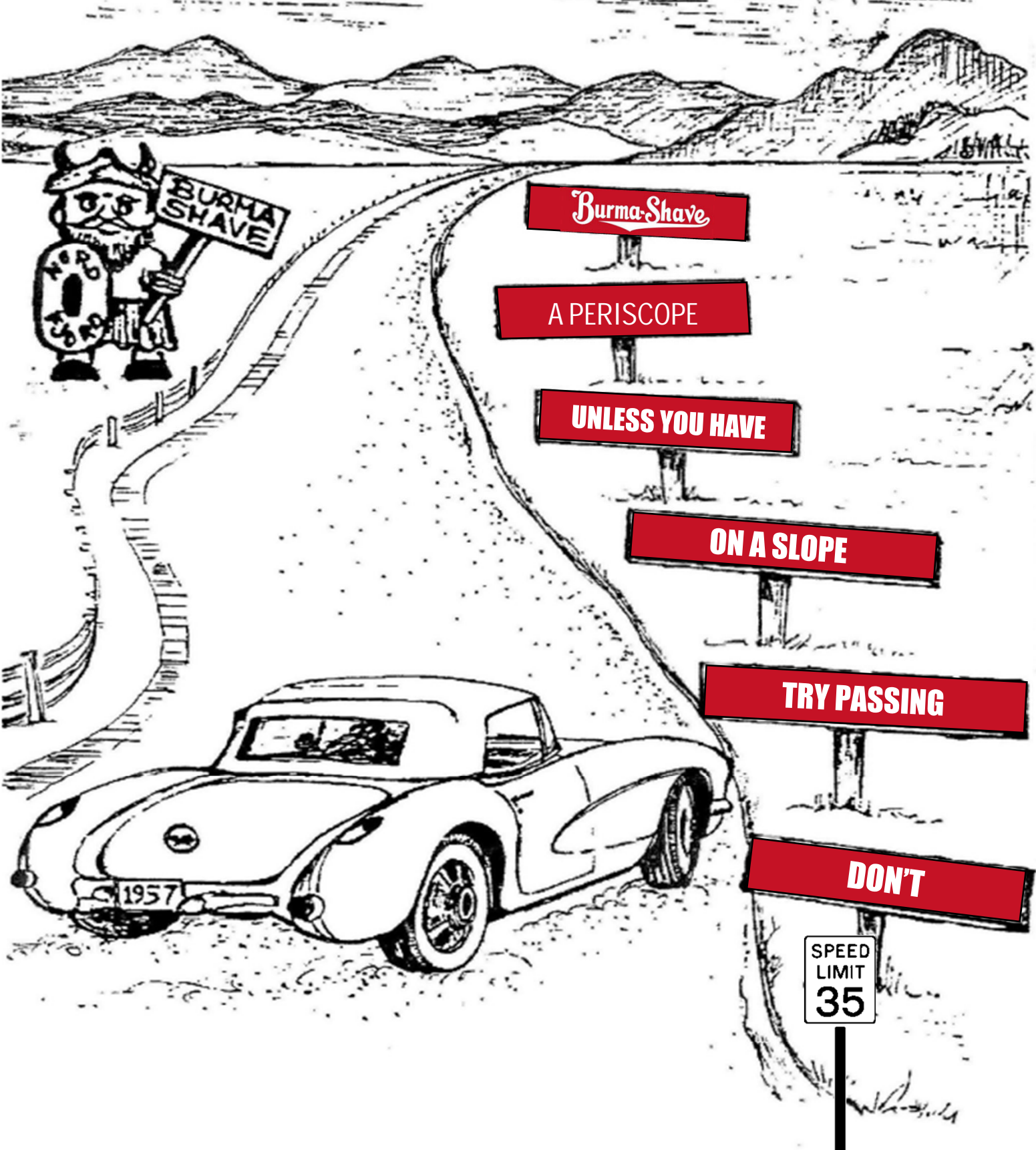
