Dan Divita seconded.





Western States Corvette Council (WSCC) News

This from WSCC.....We are putting the final details together for a couple of fun events! We wanted to let you know to save the dates and keep an eye out for more details

First, we are planning dinner, a train ride and an overnight stay in beautiful Oakhurst, CA on May 31st. We will have a flyer out soon with all the details.

Next is our 60th Anniversary Celebration which we are planning on from Sept 4th - Sept 7th. This will be held in the Reno, NV area. There will be a survey to poll ideas from our members out shortly.

WSCC had a few public sites. www.wscc.net is an old website and it has outdated information. It has an error showing on the Member Club page and it shows the logos of all the clubs from a few years ago. There is also a Facebook page that is set as a Private Group, meaning you can only see what is on there if you become a member of their Facebook group. The Facebook page was created in 2010 and the page states that 311 people registered to the group. On February 5, 2025, the site stated that there were 3 posts on that day and 37 for the last month. Something is being posted, but I'm not sure what it is.

National Council of Corvette Clubs (NCCC) News

The NCCC website is not exactly new looking, but at least they have a secure site certificate now. While I had trouble a month ago, I was able to open up the West Coast website when checking recently. I get a warning that the site is not secure. I hope at some point they rebuild the website, as it uses web templates from more than a dozen years ago. The site looks very old and tired. In fact, the background graphic on the site is a C5 emblem. I emailed the regional competition director asking how to get our autocross listed on their events page (which I doubt gets many views.)

Autocross

Our September Autocross is moving forward as a planned event. Now that we are with NCCC, this will be a sanctioned non-points event. We have to use the NCCC insurance waiver as a requirement of their insurance broker, so when the time comes for registration, we won't be using the online waivers this time, unless I get an acceptance from the NCCC competition director that online waivers are permitted. We received contact from a friend in the Model T Club of the East Bay and they want to do a Funkhana with us on Sunday afternoon. It would be neat to see a bunch of Model Ts at the racetrack, if we can get it organized - more to come.
