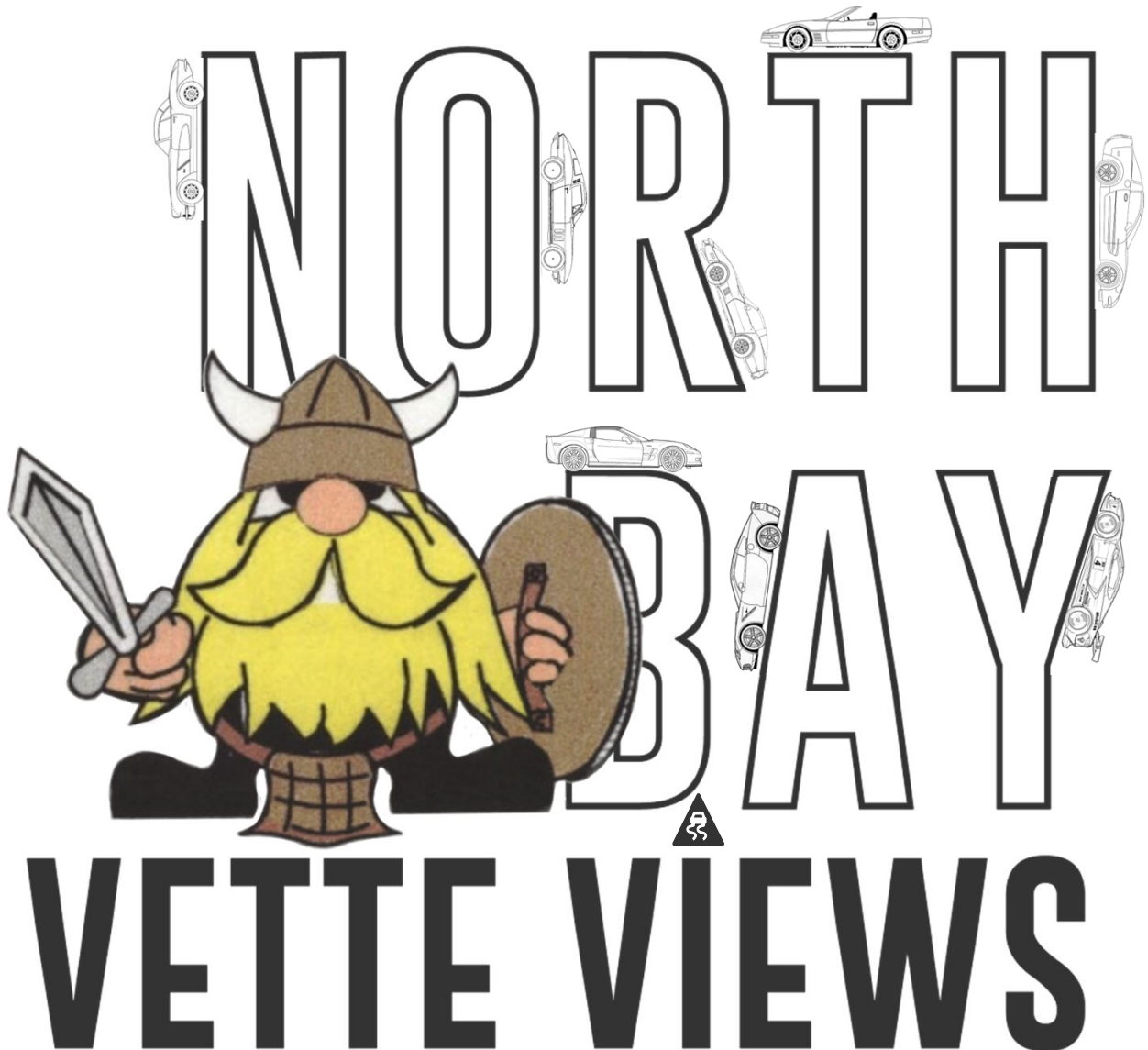

NBCA is still at 74 members as of this report. We do have 3 prospective members and I have sent them the information about our website and our June 10th membership meeting. I am hoping they will attend.

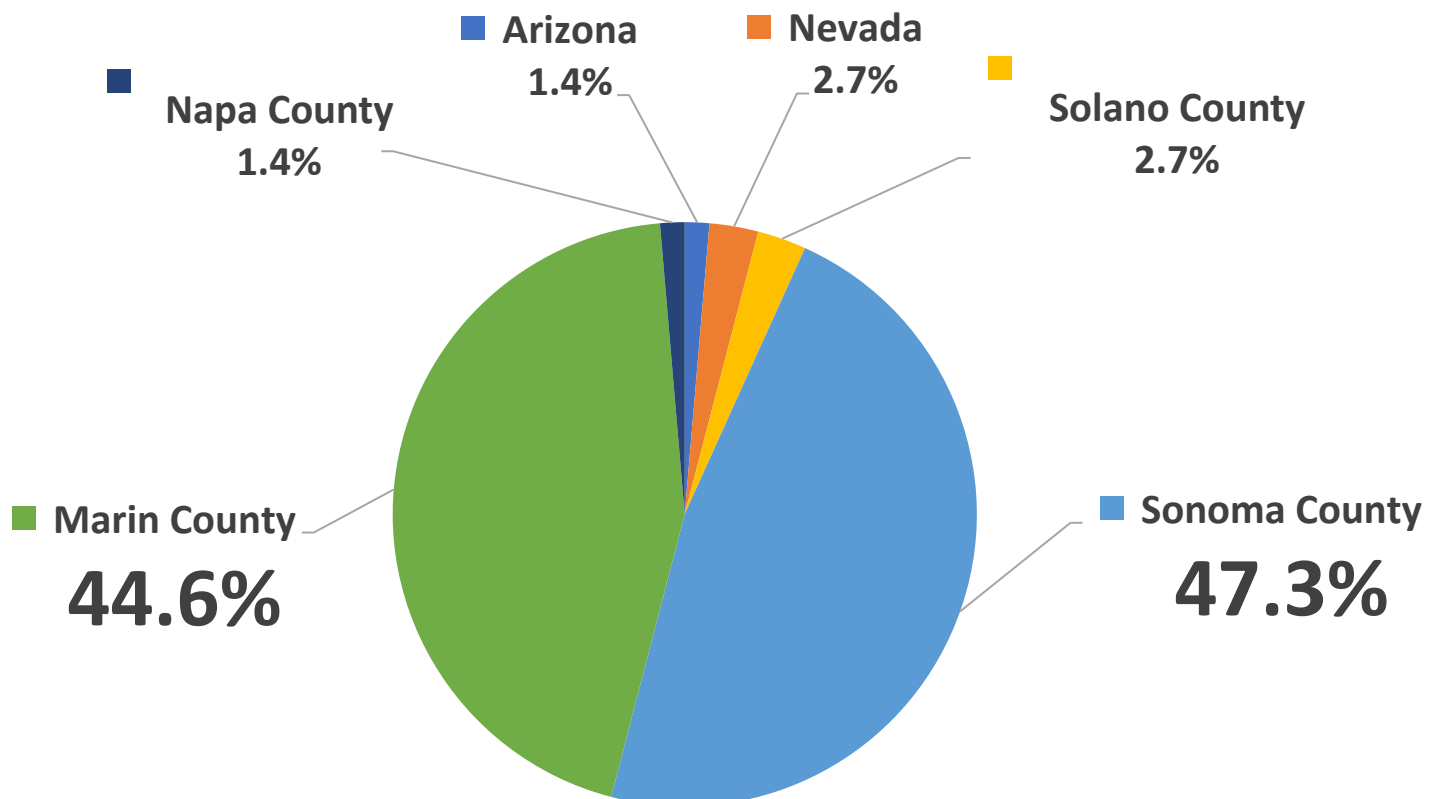

The IMSA WeatherTech Championship races are full of action. There are 4 classes of cars all racing at the same time. Two classes of prototype (not production) cars and two classes of GT (street based) one with pro drivers and the other with “amateur” drivers. There are many different manufactures in the GT classes. There were two Corvettes in each GT class. There is a lot of passing, but generally little contact, unlike NASCAR.

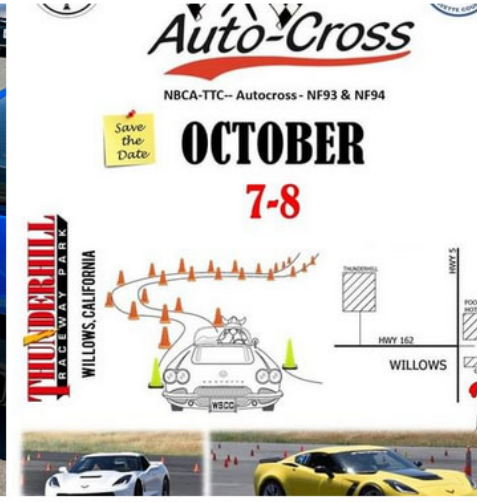

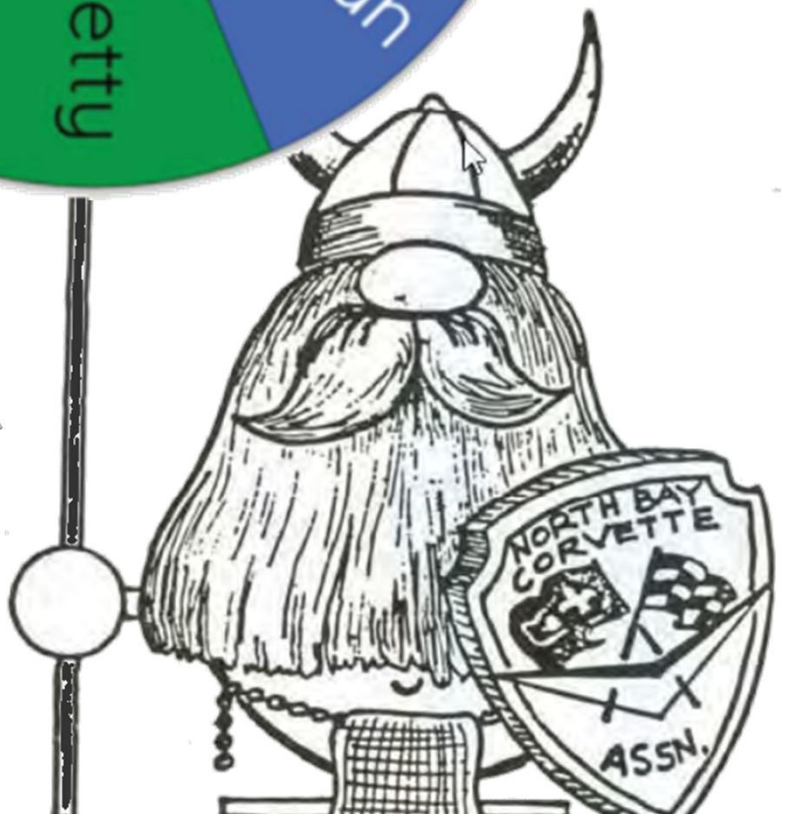

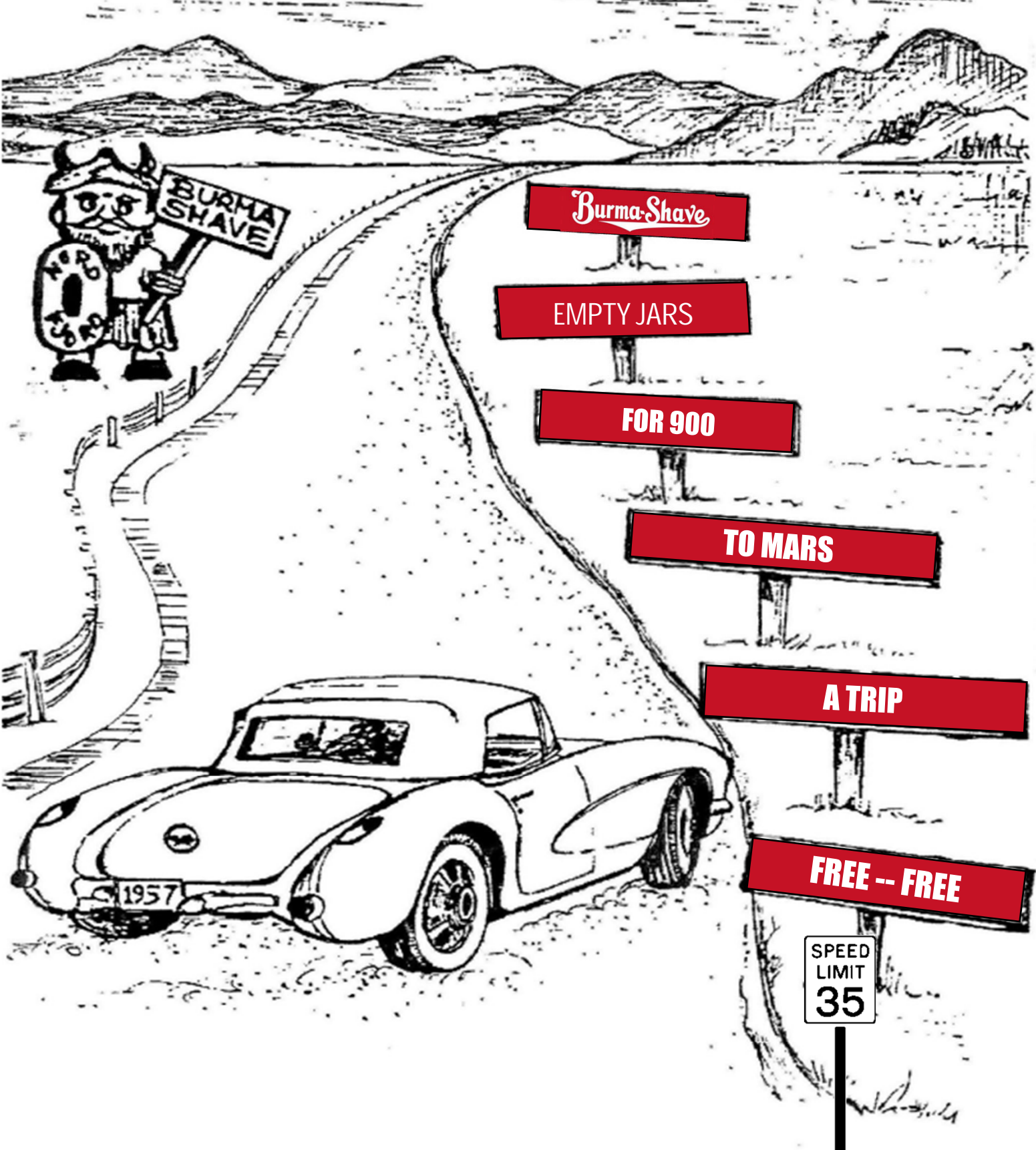
