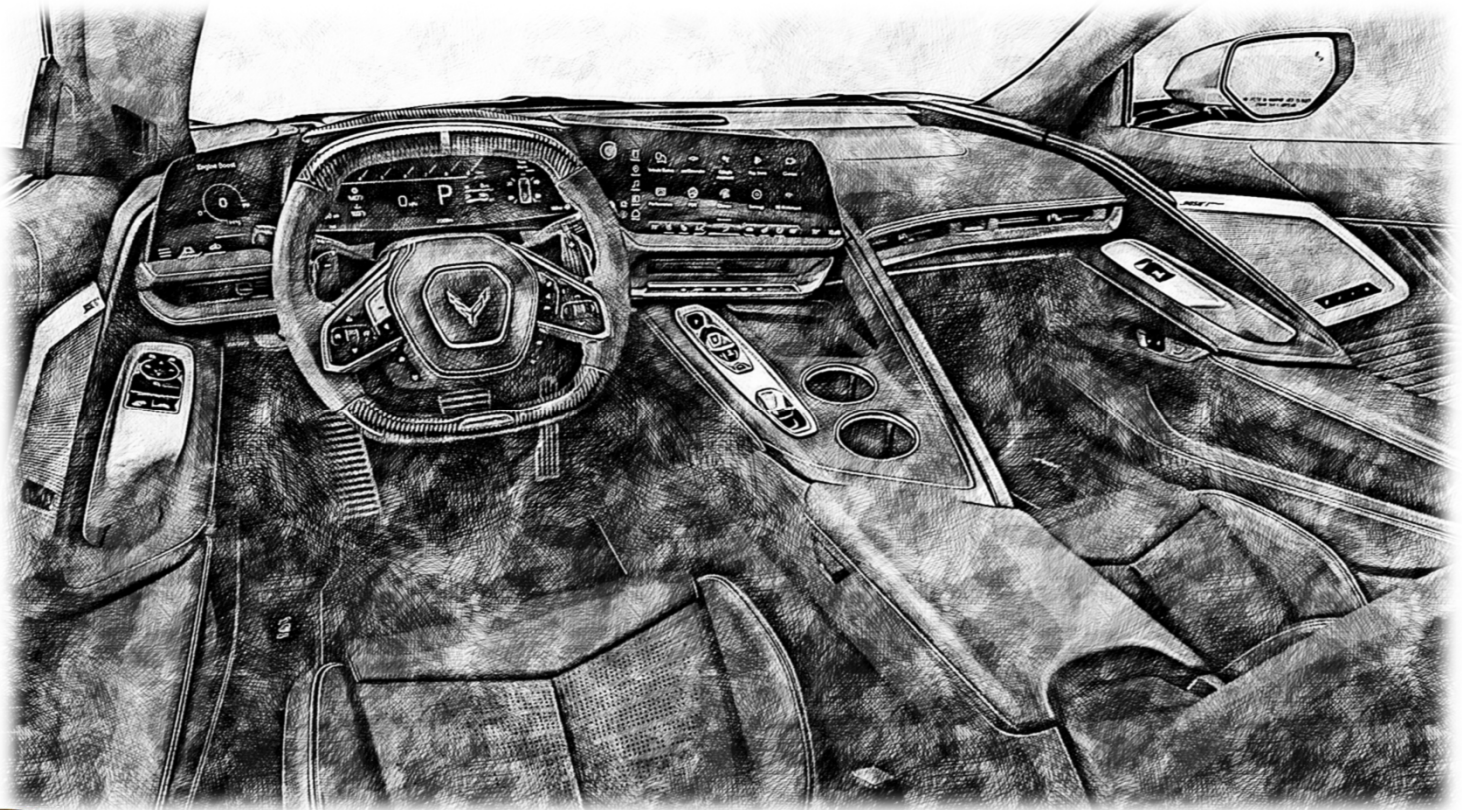
I am currently finalizing the approval with the Board of Directors for our 4 new members! They are:

Hugs goodbye and now we're looking forward to our first of the year D & D on April 1<sup>st</sup>.



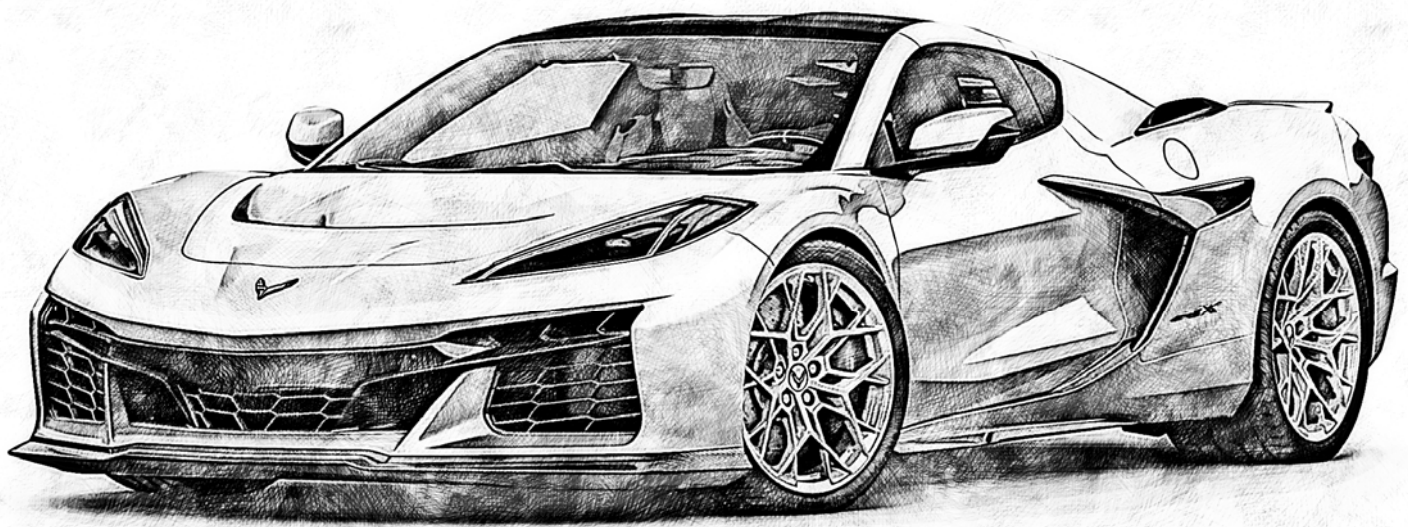
