Betty as Governor representing NBCA at NCCC contacted Jeff with all the Auto-X and Competition communiques and forwarded to him. So Betty as documented Governor would forward competition related emails etc. to VP who is working with Jeff.

Ken Albers suggested that the continue to follow the NBCA defined responsibilities where the VP follows Activities and Competition and the Membership follows dues and membership related items. Because the VP has always been the representative for the club at governing body meetings (NCCC now).

It was mentioned that the Membership functions are the most important in our club as the Competition is not really used. At one point Barbara had spent 45 hours in a week.




NBCA FEBRUARY BREAKFAST @ TWO NINER DINNER

Astronaut Alan Shepard had driven Corvettes prior to becoming a part of the Mercury 7 team. Shepard purchased a used 1953 and a used 1957 Corvette to celebrate becoming part of the space program. He was given clearance to race down the Langley Air Force Base runway, where he hit speeds of 100 mph.




Three of the other Mercury 7 astronauts, Gus Grissom, Gordon Cooper, and Deke Slayton, were also given Corvettes as part of a deal with NASA. Each Corvette was leased for one dollar a year. They were given the nickname "Astro-Vettes," and the astronauts would race each other at Cape Canaveral! Chevrolet and NASA began a partnership where any astronaut could get a Corvette.

Drivers John Finch and Bob Grossman, with leaderships from Biggs Cunningham, competed at the Le Man race and established Corvette as a serious race competitor. The car beat out the famed racing cars of Jaguar, Ferrari, and Porsche!



John Powell ran a racing school at Canada's Mosport track, following the ban of Corvettes at SCCA racing. Powell created this race for Corvette drivers, with a million-dollar prize. Fifty-six identical Corvettes were created for the competition.
