This month new Treasurer is getting up to speed transitional report should be ready in 2 months. A brief summary of my qualifications (prepared initially for election nomination) Graduated from UNV '69 with a Bachelor's and a Major in Accounting

Started with Arthur Andersen in SF and became a partner, 10 years later. Seven years later began leading the group supporting Financial Institutions and retired after an additional 3 years. Joined a startup for about 16 years retiring from Bank of Marin in 2006 as President and CEO.

Dan Divita seconded.





Janet and Lutz are planning a great trip, leaving from Cotati (spot to be determined), up the coast, with stops at Goat Rock, Fort Ross, lunch at Fort Ross Deli, Point Arena Lighthouse, Mendocino Headlands State Park and Point Cabrillo Lighthouse.

We have selected as our first choice for motel the Surf and Sand in Ft. Bragg. It is relatively new, bright and clean, with a great location and nice views. Janet and Lutz have reserved the owner's "suite" so that we can have a spot to gather together for cocktails, etc. (Corvette racing, Bill?) (Moose Milk, Jane or Steve?) It has a full kitchen, a bbq on the balcony, etc. It's not huge, but will work. Anyone want to make breakfast?

Janet plans on picking up pastries to share each morning. They only have 30 rooms, so please make a reservation asap if you are interested. The cancellation is 72 hours.

Right next door is a "sister" motel, the Beachcomber. Very similar to above, and just a two-minute walk between the two. This motel has a lovely outdoor gathering area with fire pits and seating areas. We can use this even if we are staying at the Surf and Sand.

Across the street and up the hill is a Best Western. It is less expensive, a bit old and dated, but some rooms do have a nice view. And it is a 2-minute drive to the Surf and Sand.

We are planning a group dinner for each evening. We are doing research on choices for our daytime Saturday. There is the Botanical Garden, in it's prime time with the Rhododendrons, etc., in full bloom. There are wonderful places to hike and/or walk, most quite easy on paved surfaces. One lovely state park has a wooden boardwalk out to a point, a wooden staircase down to the tidepools (depending on the tides.) There are some museums with lots of history from the area, lovely homes to explore, etc.

If you like to ride bikes, there is a 10-mile paved path along the bluff with amazing views. All flat. This is one of the most beautiful bike trails I have ever seen. You can rent bicycles right at the motel or nicer bikes at the bike shop down the road.

If you like little theater, the Mendocino Playhouse will be doing Tennessee Williams' play The Glass Menagerie in May.

We will be taking Highway 128 to go home. It is a lovely inland route. The first few miles are curvy through beautiful forest. There are many pull-outs for the slower vehicles, making it more fun for us. Then it is through vineyards, pasture lands, etc. for many miles. The last 10 miles are perfect for us, a bit hilly and curvy. We come out on Highway 101 in Cloverdale, then an easy ride home. Along the way are Navarro, Scharffenberg Cellars (bubbles), Husch and tons of other wineries in Philo and Boonville if interested.

Janet, Lutz and Gloria hope that most, if not all, of you can join you for this fun adventure.
