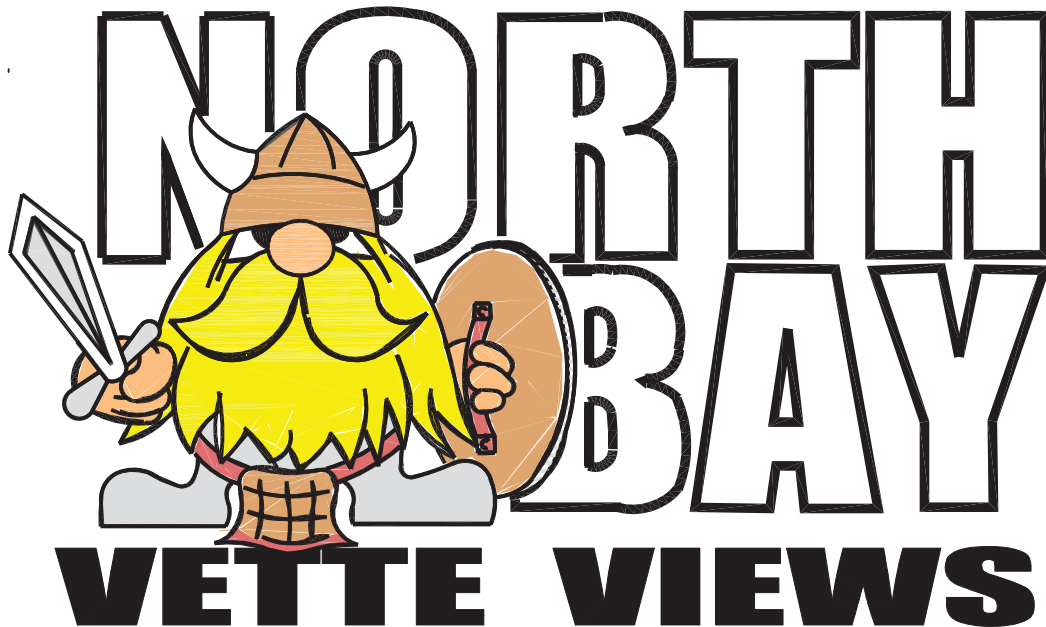

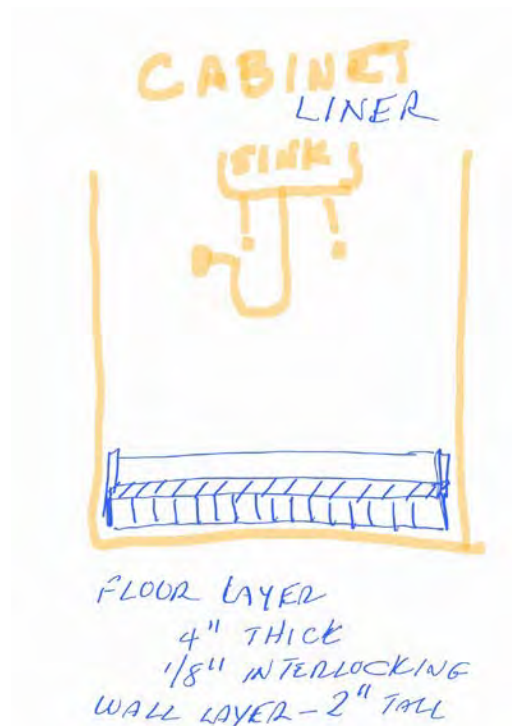

President's Message - Hair-Brained Ideas

Okay. I guess the best hair-brained idea I've had in the last few years was entering the Nevada Open Road Challenge race. And although it is dangerous to drive at fast speeds, the race rules and safety with Seat Belt harnesses, Run Flat tires, Hans Device and arm straps provides me with significant confidence. That I'm safe.

Besides the Nevada Open Road Challenge race and participating in the planning of our trip to Oregon this month, most of my hair-brained ideas are inventions. I've got tons of mental inventions, but not one has been turned into a product. I'm going to mention a few here, so if you'd like to partner with me by paying the patent attorney and the machining costs, let me know. I've got a little more than 30 inventions.



Hair Brained Idea #1 - **Cabinet Liner** - Stop Water leaks from causing significant damage inside cabinets and under refrigerators. This idea came when our refrigerator water line got a small pinleak and warped our hardwood floor under it. The water did not seep out in front of the fridge where we would notice it for two days. The solution is a hard plastic liner that would be slightly sloped to force water to the front. And there would be a 2 inch section that would attach to the walls similarly to carpet base. I would sell this material to Do-it-yourselfer and it would be trimmed to fit.

Hair Brained Idea #2 - **Sprinkler Head**

Saw - Grass grows around sprinkler heads and if not trimmed, will grow over the sprinkler getting stuck when the sprinkler recedes. My saw would be shaped like a doorknob saw and trim the grass (and earth) around each sprinkler head. This tool replaces the weedwacker trimmer which is too large to delicately trim around sprinkler heads. It is common to break the sprinkler head insert when weed whacking.



Hair Brained idea #3 - **Adjusting Door**

Hinge - allows anyone to adjust doors that are out of alignment due to settling. Once a residence ages, the doors will get out of alignment and rub against the trim. An adjustable hinge would replace the existing practice of shimming and trimming.

Lastly, I've mentioned before about the Sudoku game I've been playing for the last few years. I've now finished 2070 games. I have 430 Easy puzzles left before I move on to the Moderate puzzles. I'm more than 20% completed with the entire game. There are 10,000 total puzzles.

Pan Seared Tilapia with Cherry Tomatoes

From: Delish.com

2 (4 oz. each) tilapia fillets
Kosher or sea salt, to taste
Fresh cracked black pepper to taste
2 tbsp. unsalted butter, divided
2 cloves of garlic, minced

½ cup dry white wine
½ lb. cherry tomatoes, halved
½ cup chopped fresh basil

1. Rinse and pat dry the tilapia fillets. Season with salt and pepper.
2. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Melt 1 tbsp. butter and then add the tilapia fillets. Cook 1 to 2 minutes on each side or until golden brown and cooked through. Remove the fillets from the pan and set aside.
3. In the same pan over medium heat, add the remaining tbsp. butter and then stir in the garlic. Cook for 1 minute or until soft.
4. Pour in the wine and salt. Increase the heat to high. Cook for 1 to 2 minutes, or until the wine is reduced in half. Stir in the tomatoes and cook for 1 minute more.
5. Plate the tilapia and spoon the tomato/wine mixture over the fillets. Garnish with the basil.

For the past few years, I have been attending a Barrett-Jackson Auction (BJA) in either Las Vegas, NV or Scottsdale, AZ. Las Vegas is a satellite show to the one in Arizona. 663 vehicles crossed the block in Vegas bringing in \$48.2 million dollars. This compares to \$266.7M in Scottsdale. I only spend one day at the shows just looking at the cars; it's a car show for me. Weather was HOT with temperatures 100 plus.

Six of the top ten Chevrolets that crossed the block in Las Vegas this July were Corvettes.

1. Lot #733 – 1963 Chevrolet Corvette 327/360 Z06 Split-window Coupe \$566,500
2. Lot #748 – 1958 Chevrolet Corvette Custom Topless Roadster \$550,000
3. Lot #738 – 1958 Chevrolet Corvette Custom Topless Roadster \$330,000
7. Lot #754 – 1964 Chevrolet Corvette Custom Coupe \$242,000
8. Lot #767.1 – 1967 Chevrolet Corvette 427/435 Convertible \$211,200
9. Lot #742 – 2022 Paul Stanley's Factory Custom Chevrolet Corvette Convertible VIN 001 \$198,000 (Rock Group KISS)

The first three above were in the top 10 non-charity vehicles, with the 63 Split-window second behind the 1970 Plymouth HEMI Superbird that sold for \$1.65 million.

Of note is that 4 of the 6 are "Custom" cars with modifications. Another is that 2 of the top 10 are pickup trucks and the other 2 1969 Camaro and 1956 Bel Air; both customized cars. Following is a link to the BJA article where you can read more about each car.

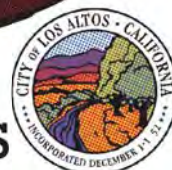

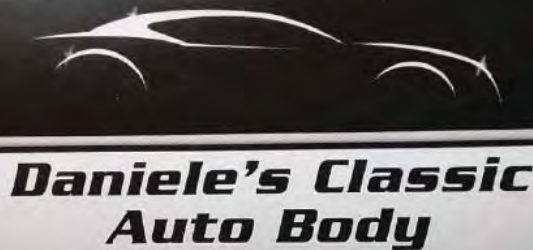

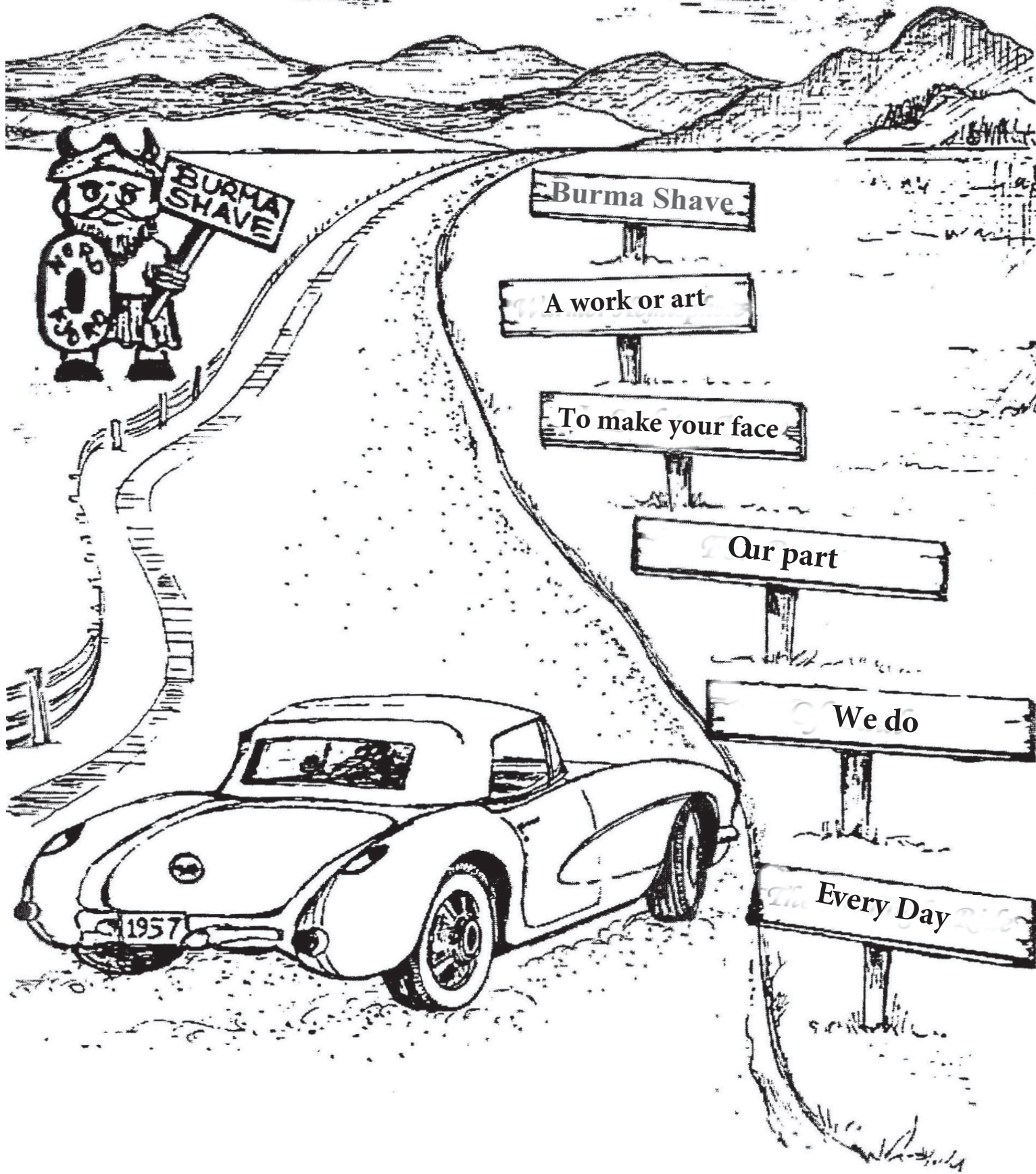
