





Make sure you get to our activities this summer. We have a lot to choose from. Check them out. When you're not at one of our activities, you might want to spice up your grilled chicken with corn on the cobb and green onions:



Grilled Spicy Chicken Thighs

With corn on the cob & green onions

Serves 8

From: Bon Appetite, August 2006

Ingredients:

1 cup fresh lime juice
2/3 cup fresh orange juice
1/2 cup olive oil
1/2 cup chopped fresh cilantro
4 garlic cloves, thinly sliced
2 tsp. hot pepper sauce
2 tsp. dried crushed red pepper

16 large chicken thighs with skin and bones (about 6 lbs.) 16 green onions 8 ears of corn, husked

Preparation:

- Whisk the first 7 ingredients in a medium bowl. Season marinade with salt and pepper.
- Place chicken thighs in a large resealable plastic bag. Place green onions and corn in an extra-large resealable plastic bag. Divide marinade equally between bags; seal bags, turning to coat. Chill chicken, corn, and green onions for 4 hours, turning bags occasionally.
- Prepare barbecue (medium heat). Remove chicken and vegetables from marinade; discard marinade. Grill chicken until charred and juices run clear when pierced with knife, turning occasionally and rearranging on grill for even cooking, about 25 minutes.
- Grill green onions and corn until charred on all sides, about 6 minutes for green onions and 13 minutes for corn.
- Transfer chicken, green onions, and corn to a platter and serve.














NORTH BAY CORVETTE ASSOCIATION SOCIAL DIRECTOR REPORT JULY 26, 2024

THE JOSH HOLDER, CHIEF CORVETTE PRODUCT ENGINEER TALKS TO JEFF FARBER ABOUT NEW CORVETTES, ABOUT PREVIOUS CORVETTES, AND AT TIMES, BRAINSTORMING ABOUT A FEATURE.



Corvette in the Movies - Building a new Spy Car.


We're making an action movie that is about an American Superspy. We want a Corvette to be the new tricked out car that the hero drives in chase scenes, like the Aston Martin in James Bond movies. We need to trick out our Corvette.

First things first, what Corvette should we use that looks the most cool? A new Stingray of course – maybe Sea Wolf Grey – very cool, but doesn't draw unnecessary attention.



An action hero has to have a car that can shoot. I'd like to closely replicate a James Bond movie scene where he did 360 spins while shooting from the headlight mounted machine guns. I'm avoiding CGI so this car will be "almost real." PS - We'll avoid the armor plating and bullet-proof glass for now...


What bumper or fender location has the most space to hide the machine guns? *I'd hate for the AM radio antenna to get in the way.* I'd use the frunk. We now have a cinching latch, we could op the hood for the gun barrel and have room- to store ammunition. It's one thing to find room for a gun. The ammunition storage for a machine gun that can shoot for more than a couple of seconds would be much larger...an often overlooked detail in movies.



Then, in order to do 360 degree spins so we can shoot all the bad guys surrounding the car, we need to make sure the car won't shut down the spins. What mode does the car need to be placed in, so that it can spin freely? It can be in any mode, but traction control should be disabled to allow for the rear tires to spin.

Also, do you think the standard battery will support powering a machine gun (there's got to be a compressor, doesn't there?) or do we need a supplemental power source? There are some very efficient and powerful actuators that can run on 12V power. No compressor needed. This could be used to raise and lower the gun, and well as aim it through the HUD. James Bond's old car needed to be pointed directly at the target – we would have more agility than that.
