### **Corvette Racing at Le Mans: Win No.9...At Long Last!**

Congratulations to Team Corvette! First in class at Le Mans.

Before this year's 100th running of the 24 Hours of Le Mans, Corvette Racing made no secret just how badly the team wanted to win its final GTE race there.

Not surprisingly, accomplishing that feat wasn't easy and took a dedicated effort from the entire team to pull it off.

First, the crew had only hours to repair serious damage to the car sustained Wednesday when Nico Varrone lost control at Tertre Rouge Corner with only minutes left in the first practice session.

With time ticking, the crew went to work and installed several new parts, including right side suspension, right side brakes, floor, fascia, rear wing, decklids, seat belts, right side front and rear fender, ride side door, right side rocker, and more.

Their hard work allowed Nicky Catsburg and Ben Keating to take class pole (position) by more than a second Thursday night and avoid having to start at the very back of the pack – a scenario that would likely have prevented Corvette from winning the race.



But the trouble was far from over for the Corvette Racing team. Two hours into the race, the car had to come back to the garage for a quick fix of a failed damper. While the crew worked fast, it still wasn't enough to keep the car from having fallen two laps behind once the repairs were done.

At that point, even the team wasn't optimistic about their chances of winning.

"We joked about going home," Catsburg said. "Thankfully the car was back to normal and felt good."

Varrone also thought it was "impossible" to rally from such a deficit, "but somehow we came back like crazy with great strategy and timing," he said. "The decisions we made paid off. The car was mega."

The strategy included being cautious in the wet conditions, with Keating explaining that more than half the class would eventually retire from the race (during the rain), "which was a big part of our fightback."

"Some of our biggest (WEC) competitors didn't make it; second, third, fourth place in the championship were all wrecked," Keating said. "I don't know if I've had a race like this with this many retirements."

After Keating's triple stint during the night, Varrone started the "day shift" with a triple stint of his own, including putting up the best GTE time of the event to make up more than half a lap on the field.

"I felt like I was in the right moment, at the right time on track," Varrone said. "The car was better through the high-speed corners and in the last sector when the track warmed up. I had clean laps and managed to do the fast lap. I am really happy because after Wednesday my confidence was down. I was so angry with myself. So gaining that confidence back, setting the fastest lap, was so satisfying."

Also satisfying was Corvette's return to the lead by the end of the 17th hour, and Catsburg was even able to continue to pull away during the closing moments.

From IMSA.com: "Now I have all the big ones," Catsburg said. "This is super awesome. Even yesterday afternoon, I didn't think this was possible."



But somehow, we made it back to the front. These two guys drove unbelievably fast, and all of a sudden, we were back in contention and won with a massive lead (of more than a lap). It's an unbelievable feeling.”

“Daybreak saw the Corvette (Racing team) come alive as the gap came down to one lap, then two minutes, then less than 60 seconds as the drivers, crew and engineers worked their magic. Critically, the No. 33 C8.R gained a full pit-stop advantage over the other GTE Am contenders inside the final hours to give Corvette Racing a lead they didn't relinquish the rest of the way.”<sup>44</sup>

## **Corvette Racing Will End its Factory-Backed Program Following Completion of the 2023 Racing Schedule**

The writing has been on the wall for [Corvette Racing](https://www.corvettesports.com) for some time now as we've seen the various racing series moving away from hosting factory-backed programs in the GT racing classes. Now with Chevrolet introducing its new Z06 GT3.R-spec racers in 2024, it was made official that Corvette Racing will end operations as support from GM Racing will flow to the individual teams.



Pratt Miller Motorsports has been the partner with GM for the last 25 years of the Corvette Racing program, and as was reported, they will transition to providing the customer support programs for IMSA, WEC, and the SRO America series.

But don't despair, Corvette Racing fans, as GM's motorsport competition engineering director Mark Stielow says that as many as four new GT3 Corvette Z06s could be racing at the start of the IMSA 2024 campaign with two GTD-Pro cars and two GTD cars racing in the series.

*“So we're going to launch with hopefully four cars at the Daytona 24-hour; we'll have two GTD Pros and two GTDs. That's the plan. We're trying to get all those things lined up right now.”*

*“We'll get the cars to our key partners, our key teams in the November timeframe. We've got two test cars built, so we're going to get some (of) the teams we're going to work with in those cars, get them up to speed.”*

*“When they take delivery of their real car, they'll be ready to go for IMSA in the Daytona 24-hour. We'll have some cars in the WEC also.”*



As GM moves to a customer-centric GT3 program, Stielow says there was an internal debate about having customers race against a factory-backed team, and he calls their current plans a “hybrid” as Pratt Miller Motorsports may still end up running the GTD-Pro team in IMSA, just not under the Corvette Racing banner.

A total of eight Corvette Z06 GT3.R racers are expected to make their global debut in 2024. They include the aforementioned four GT3s in IMSA WeatherTech, two in the FIA WEC's LMGTC class, and the final two will appear in the SRO America series.





Stielow says the move away from the factory effort to more of a supporting role will be a “big shift” for GM from a marketing perspective, adding that “people don’t like change.” But he concludes that it will (be) good “because we’ll have more high-level Corvettes racing in more places.”

GM’s Laura Wontrop Klauser says that the customer teams will be announced soon, saying “I think fans will be very happy with the organizations we have chosen.” Those team are expected to get their race cars later this fall.

Corvette Racing’s final race in IMSA will be Petit Le Mans at Road Atlanta on October 14th. The World Endurance Championship (WEC) will come to a close on November 4th in Bahrain.

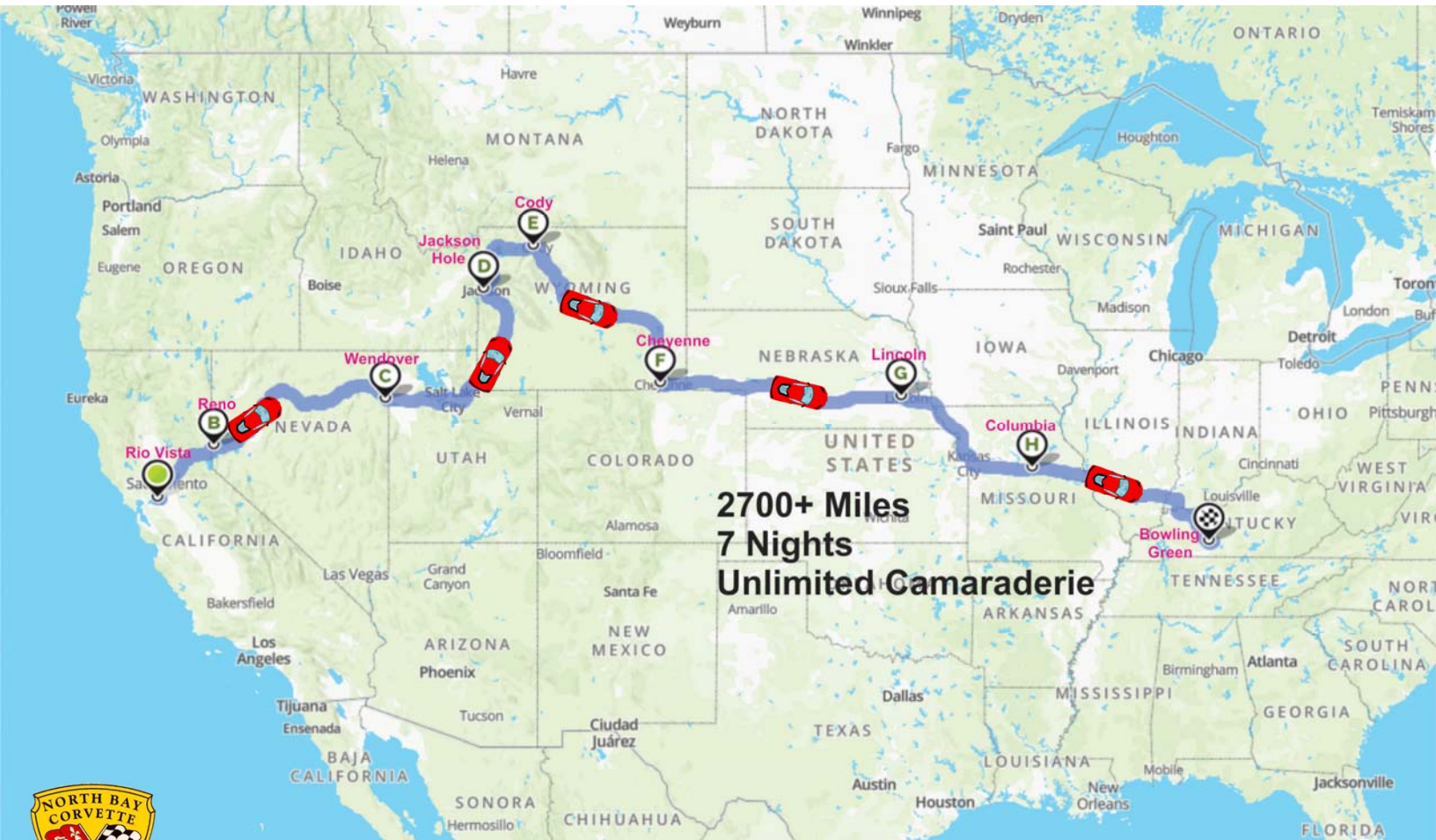

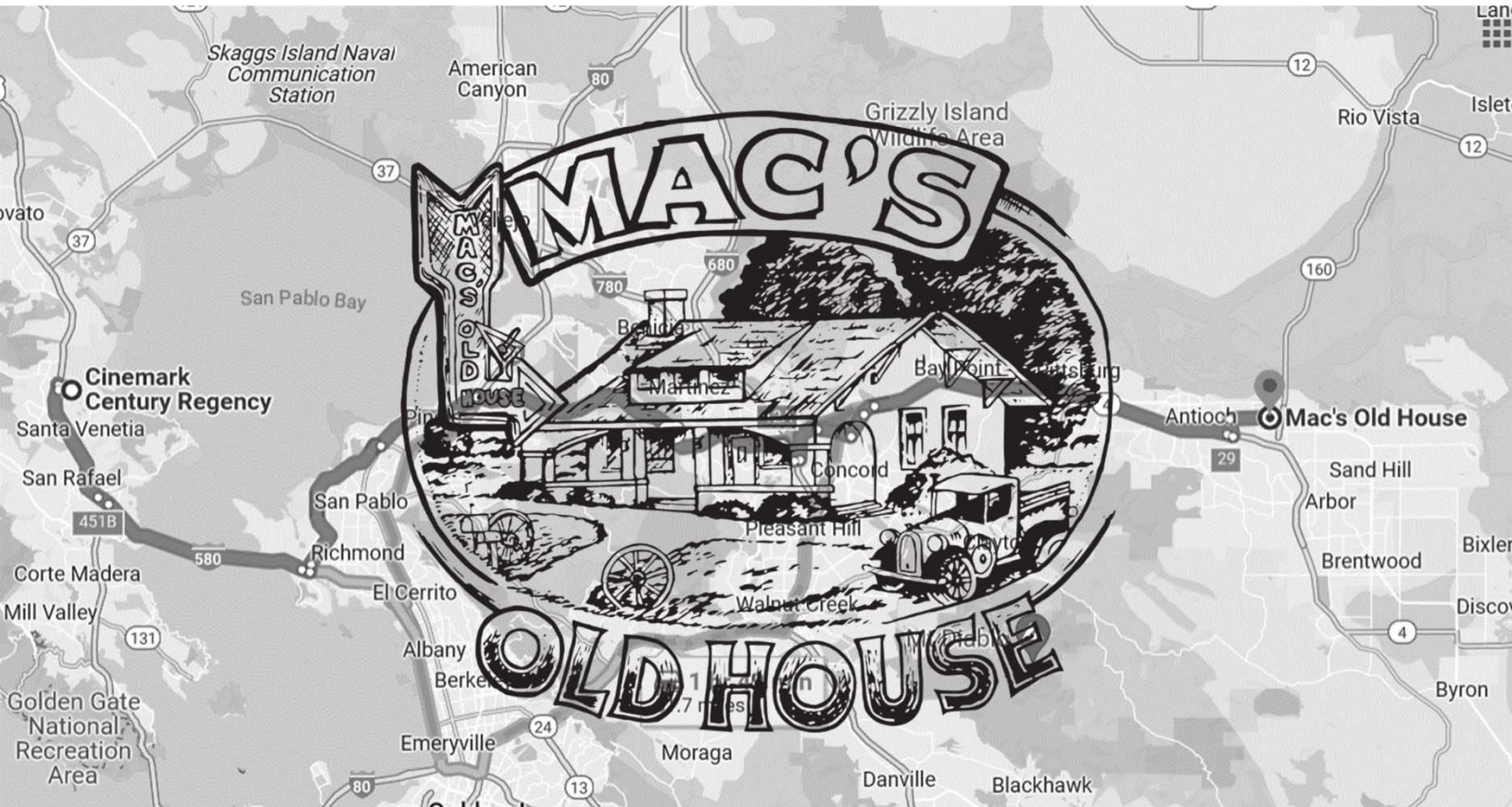

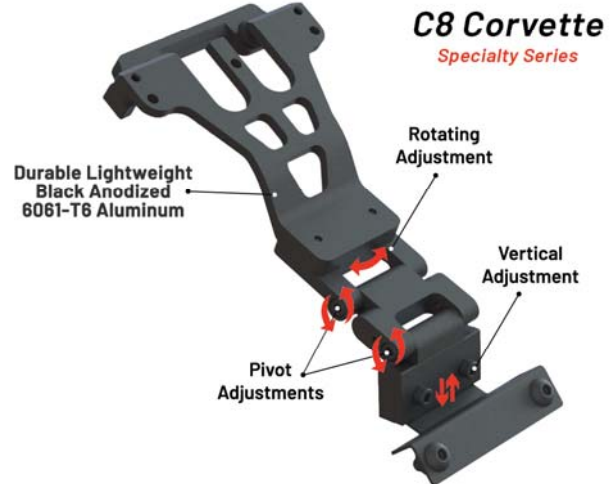

<b>Ingredients:</b> 20 lemons 1 quart vodka 3 cups sugar 3 ½ cups water		
<b>Preparation:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Wash lemons and peel or plane the zest, taking as little pith as possible (We only want the zest. Naked lemons may be reserved for other purposes.)</li><li>2. Place the zest and vodka in a steril container and seal airtight.</li><li>3. Allow zest to steep in vodka for 3 days.</li><li>4. In a saucepan, dissolve sugar in water and bring to a boil, 3 minutes to set, then allow to cool.</li><li>5. Strain lemon peels from vodka.</li><li>6. Combine sugar syrup and vodka in a bottle or other airtight container.</li></ol>		
<b>Notes:</b> We keep a bottle of Lemoncello in the freezer at all times. It makes a great after dinner drink.
