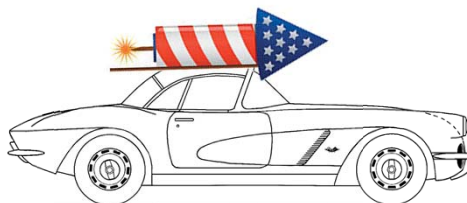

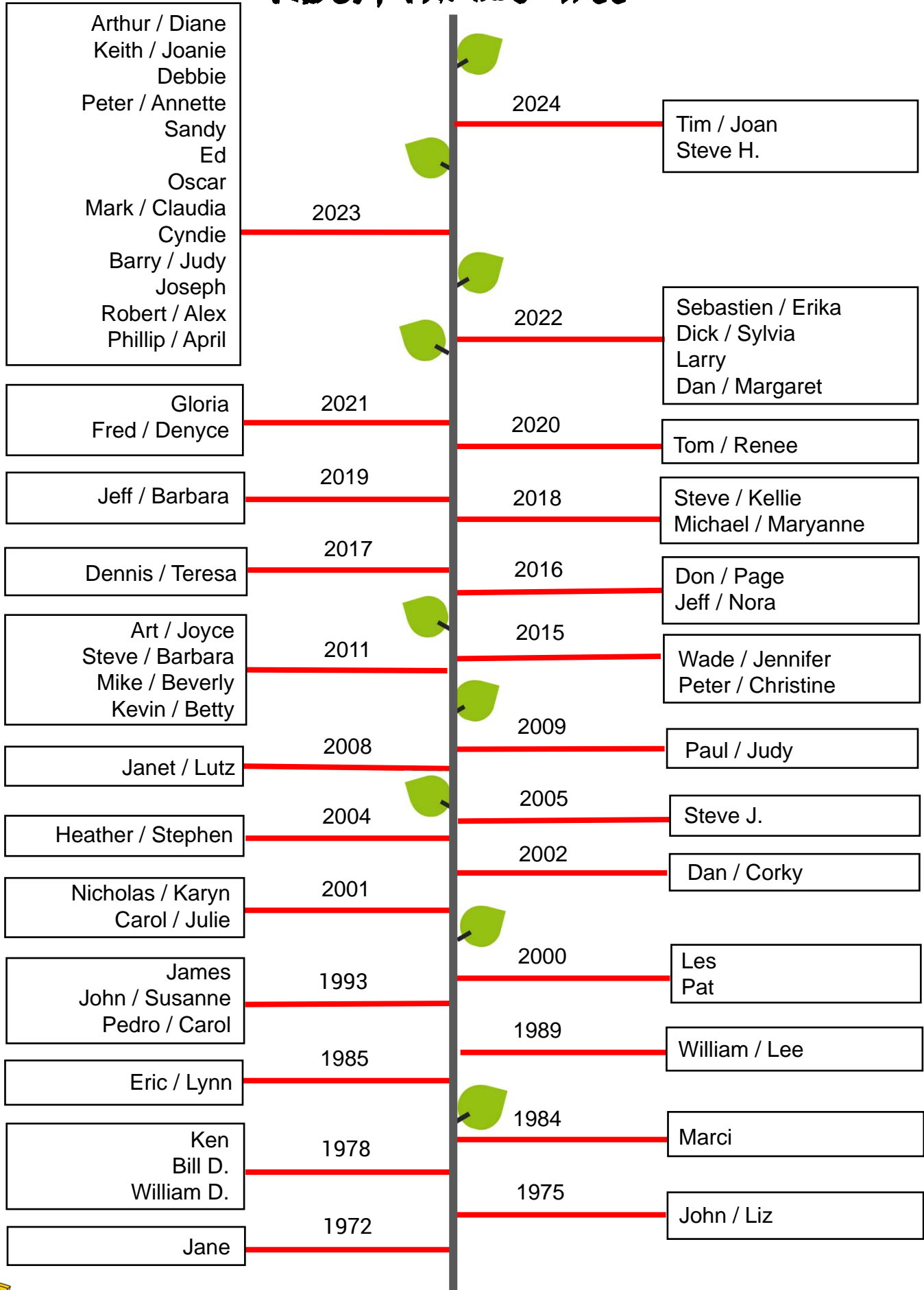

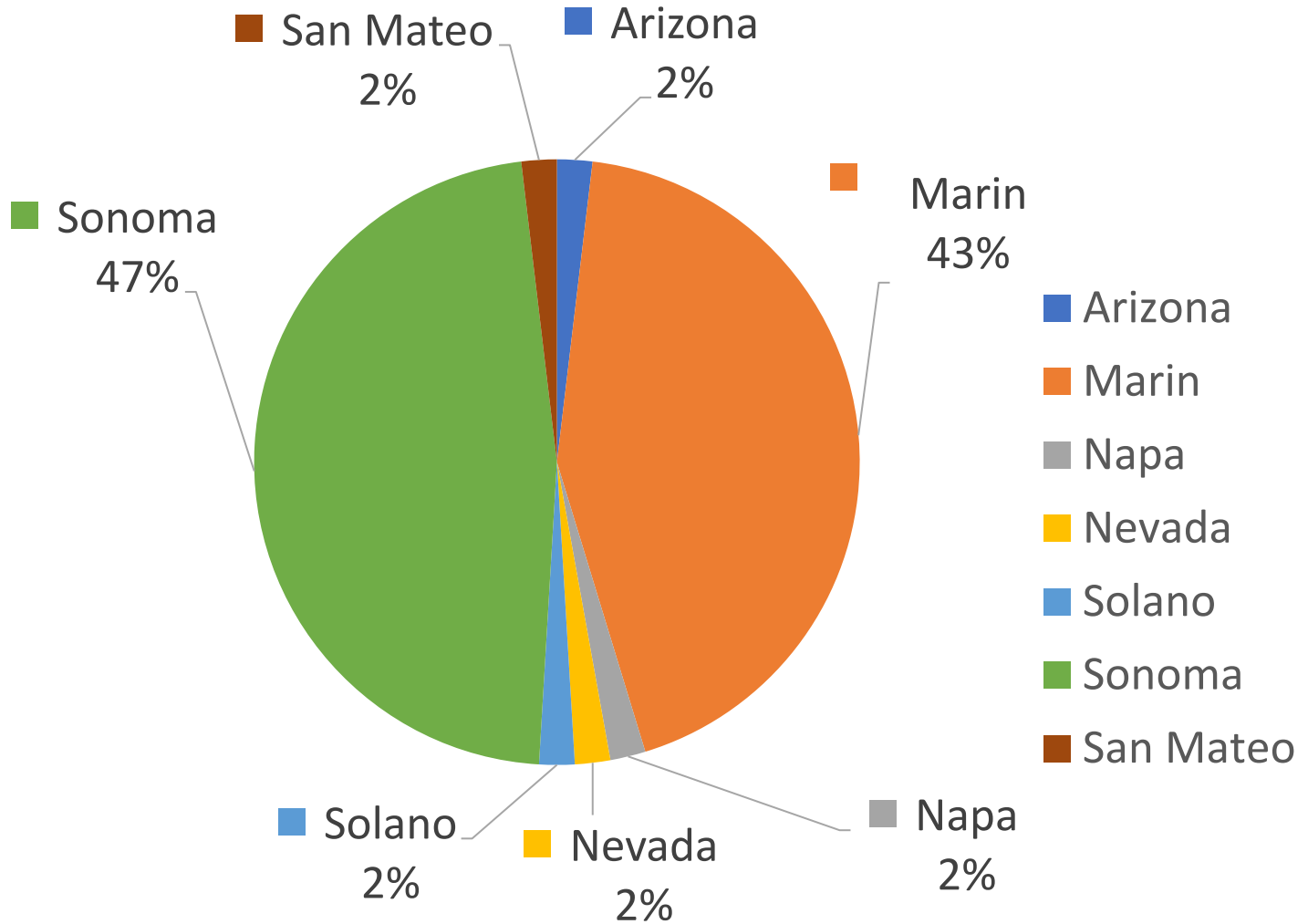

The chapel, decommissioned when the Navy closed the base, is now run by a historical society.



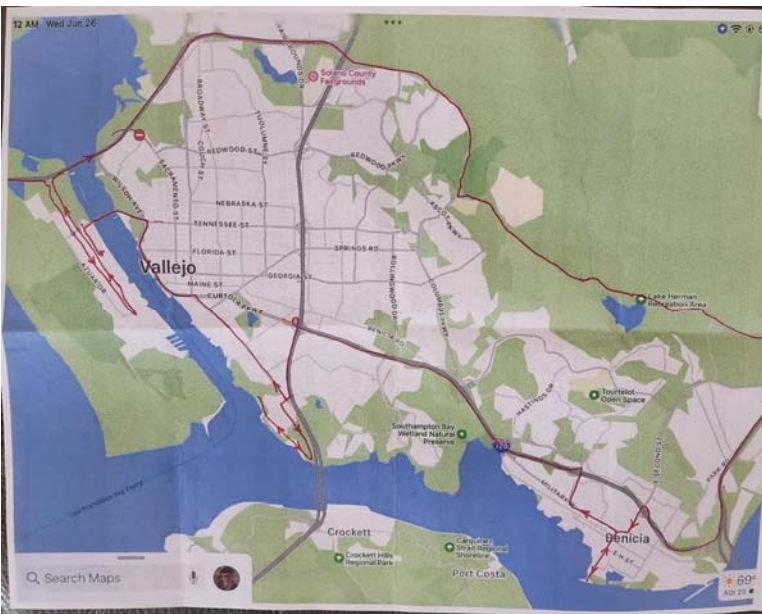
