



His name badge is on order with Hall Executive Gifts and Awards.





Joseph Newgarden won the Indy 500 last weekend driving the Team Penske Chevrolet. He was able to beat Pato O'Ward by 0.3417 seconds in his Arrow McLaren Chevrolet. Scott Dixon came in third in his Chip Ganassi Racing Honda.

Corvettes have now been the Pace Car for the Indy 500 Race 21 times. Since 1972, GM cars have paced the Indy 500 every year except 4 when the pace car was either a Ford Mustang (1979 & 1994), or a Dodge Viper (1991 & 1996). Yeah, Corvettes pretty much set the pace.

It's getting to be that time of year when a nice rack of BBQ ribs hits the spot. Try these baby-back ribs for a finger licking good time:

Steve's BBQ Ribs From: Jim Schaffer, Novato, CA, 2005				
Ingredients: 2 packages Baby Back Pork Ribs (6racks)from Costco 1 large jar Montreal Steak Seasoning	1 large bottle Bulls Eye Original BBQ Sauce Cooking spray			
 Preparation: Clean, rinse and pat dry ribs. Sprinkle liberally with steak seasoning on both sides and place 2 or 3 racks of ribs on each baking sheet sprayed with cooking spray. Cover with aluminum foil and refrigerate overnight. In the morning, preheat the convection oven to 250 degrees Fahrenheit. Bake ribs covered for 3 hours. Remove ribs from the oven and let rest for half an hour. Preheat the gas grill on medium heat. With a baster, suck drippings from the baking sheet and discard. Grill ribs on both sides with a generous slathering of BBQ sauce. Notes: Each package of ribs is about 10-12 lbs. Plan on about a half-pound per person. This recipe can easily be multiplied or divided depending on your guest list. ENJOY!!!



Corvette revealed that a formal Reveal of the C8 ZR1 will be made soon. This car is the final car that Tadge Juechter, Corvette Chief Engineer, will promote and be his final accomplishment. Tadge will be inducted into the National Corvette Museum Hall of Fame on Saturday night, August 31, 2024.

Umbrella Organization News

WSCC has a drive to Murphys in July that NBCA was interested in making a social event on our calendar. But it turns out that no one on the board decided to go so we removed it from our calendar.

NCCC has very little activity on their West Coast calendar. Our club has decided against participation in any of the Southern California events.

Autocross

Last board meeting, Mike Giordano asked the board if there was any motivation to continue hosting autocrosses? He stated that our club has materially older timing equipment than all of the other clubs and if we continue, we'd need to spend several thousands of dollars on updating the equipment. The lack of scheduled autocross dates this year was accidental, and while the volunteers enjoy the weekends together, there barely is enough volunteers (and racers) to run our autocrosses. A decision has not been made yet on scheduling for 2025.

Personal Race Result

I raced in the annual Nevada Open Road Challenge May 19, 2024 on Nevada Route 318. I benefited from some scoring technical difficulties as my initial 62 mile time was the best in my 11 car 135 MPH class. I was awarded the winner ro my class at the awards show. On May 28, 2024 the final results were distributed to all racers and my combined results for the full 124 mile race would not have placed me in first place. While I was honored to have won at the awards ceremony, the fact that I really did not win means I actually won a participation trophy award. This year marked my fourth year of racing and my second year of racing alone without the benefit of a navigator/timer. Now back home I am rebuilding my spreadsheet that I use to judge my times, and the second leg sheet had incorrect time. I'll be back for year number five in May 2025 with confidence I will really win my class (again for the first time.)


