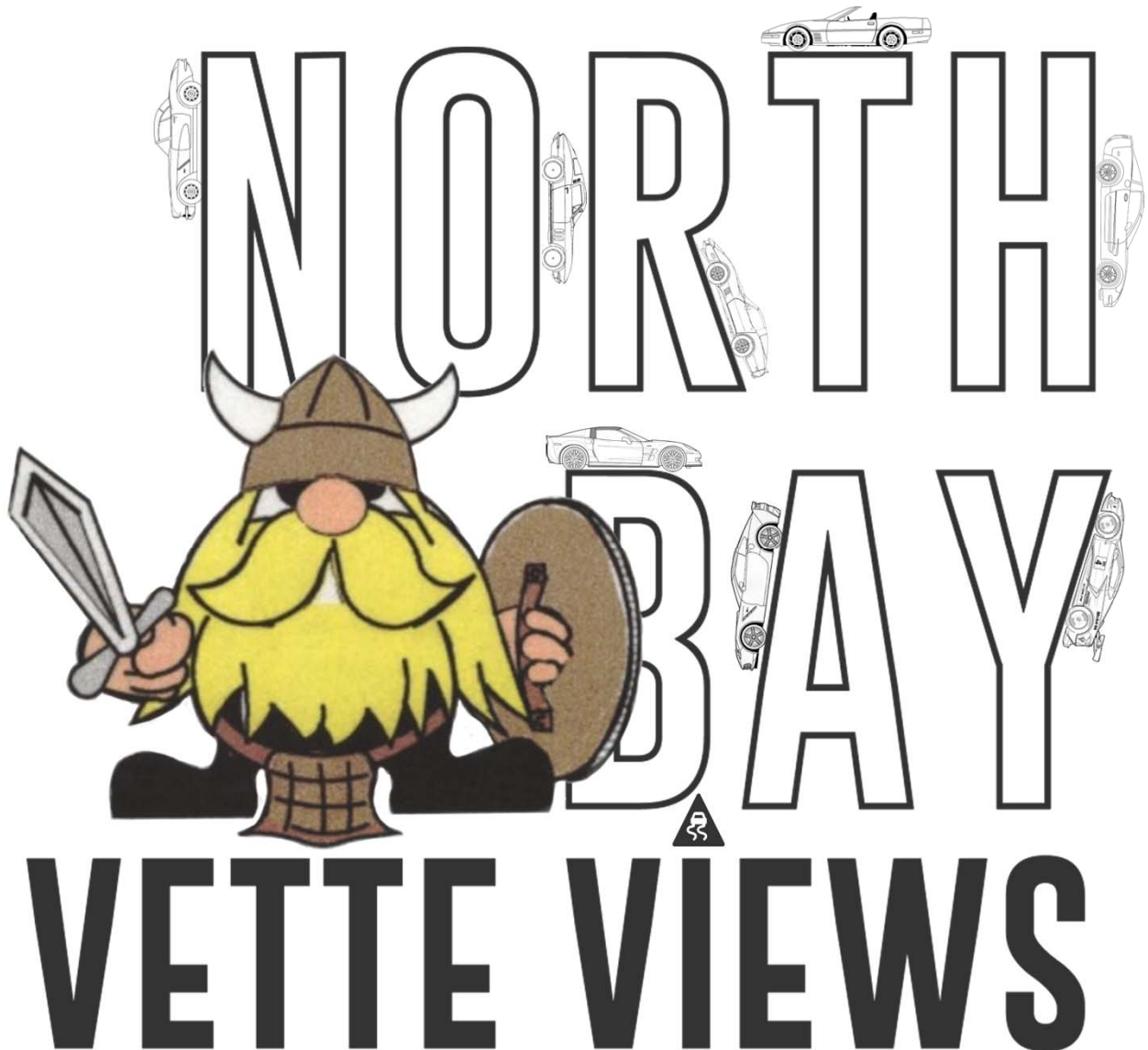

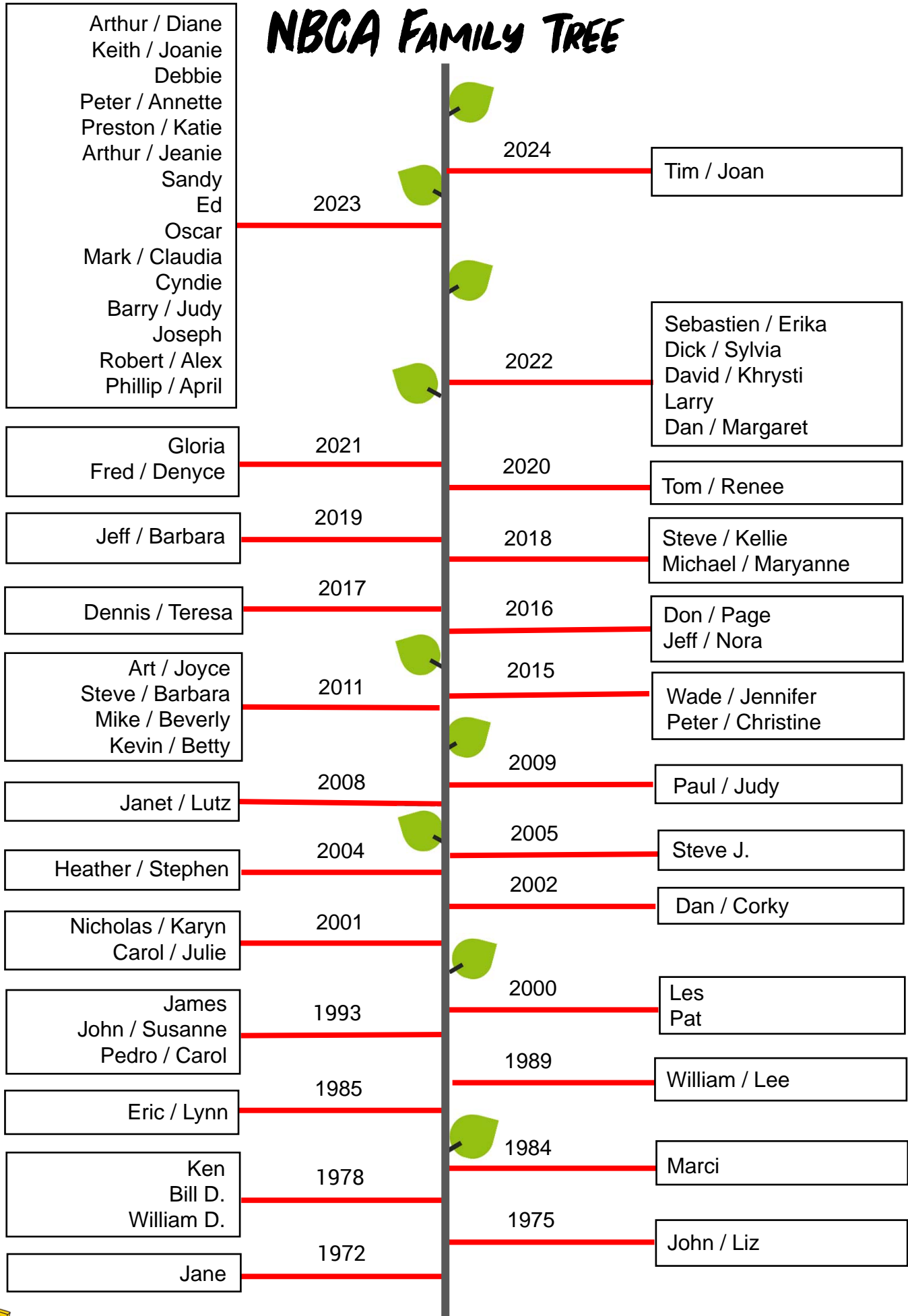

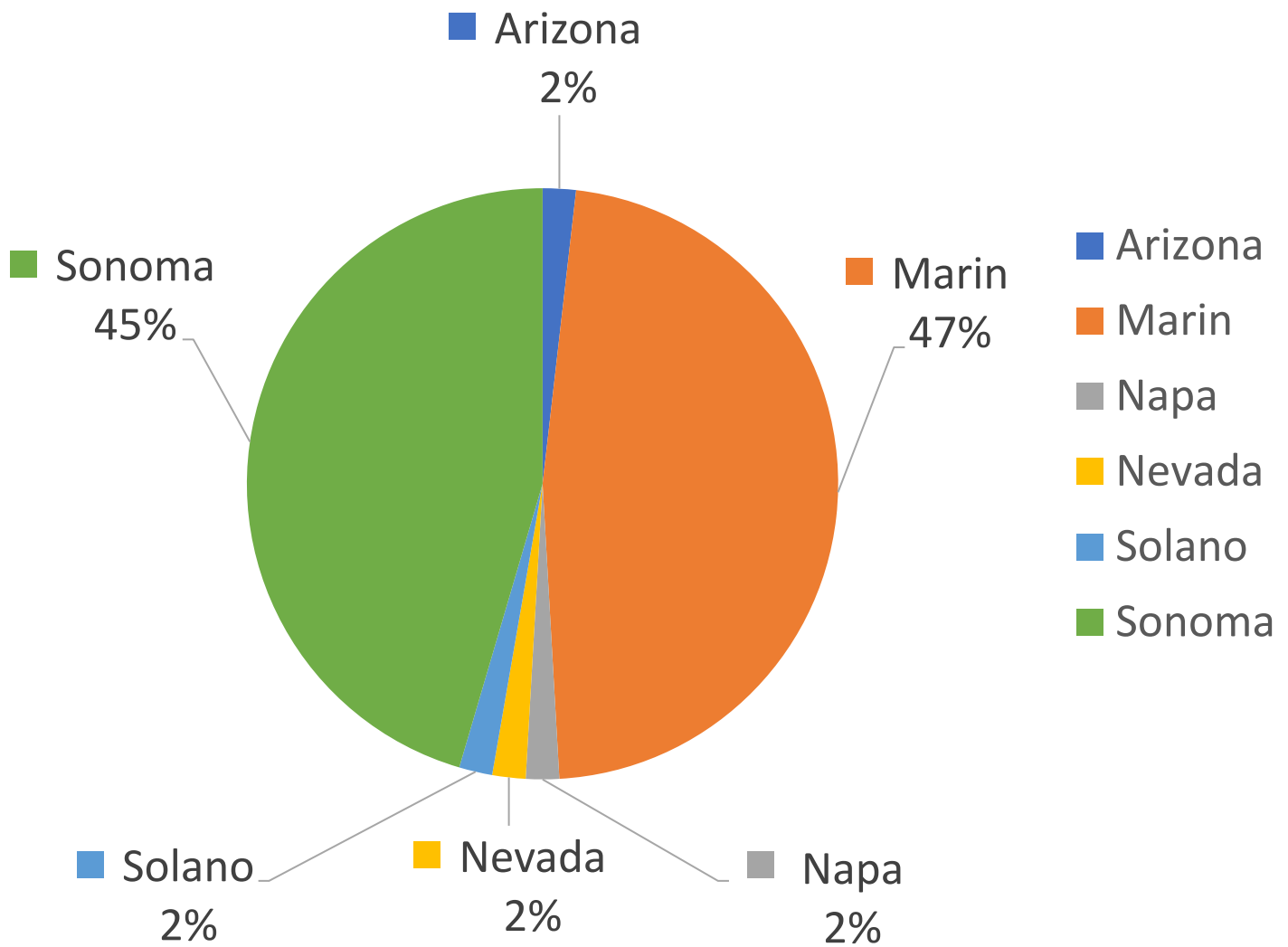


NBCA FAMILY TREE

NCCC:

Jeff is in contact with NCCC to get requirements 1. for hosting an Auto-X. Varying requirements depend on type of sanctioning desired. Both types of sanctioned events are covered under insurance.

Sanctioned events

- Create a flyer for event
- Post the event on NCCC website.
- Use NCCC defined car classes
- Un-Sanctioned event – Not all rules will have to be followed.

Currently no other Auto-X venues available for us to sponsor an Auto-X currently in 2024.

Insurance:

Insurance through NCCC will be available for all events whether sanctioned or unsanctioned events.

No additional fees are charged by event to initiate an “event rider”.

WSCC:

WSCC’s remaining clubs NBCA is probably largest and next largest is South Valley
Lawsuit:

No real news to report.

Lawsuit is in progress.

Court date still scheduled for October

Continuation:

Thoughts are that WSCC may not be able to recover to pre-lawsuit status.

Should they not be viable as an ongoing entity per IRS rules WSCC would have to distribute all remaining assets to other non-profits.

NBCA is staying involved to monitor the situation within WSCC, but does not have any board representation.

Ex WSCC Pres’s travel to NCM is paid by WSCC also in the By-Laws as WSSC is on the NCM Board.

Per Steve B. bylaws state that at least one trip to NCM is paid by WSCC.

WSCC board has 3 open positions, however no club members have moved to join the WSCC board currently Newsletter, Public Relations, and Events Coordinator.

Discussion:

We want to be able to provide guidance.

After discussion Paul Schofield suggested a letter should ask WSCC’s intentions

Steve B. did ask their intent at a meeting and they consider WSCC an ongoing concern.



WSSC is audited by an external entity.

A strong opinion will need to include understanding options based on the by-laws.

CORVETTE ENGINEERING

THE FOLLOWING IS A QUESTION AND ANSWER DISCUSSION BETWEEN
JEFF FARBER VP OF NBCA AND JOSH HOLDER, CHIEF CORVETTE
PRODUCT ENGINEER.....



Save the Brakes Question: Explain the design process of automatic removal of the E- Brake when the accelerator is applied. What GM vehicle was the first to feature it? Electronic parking brakes came on the Corvette in 2014 in the 7th generation. We used it to save valuable space on the console and simplify the construction of the tunnel on the C7 as all frames were made from Aluminum. Corvette was not the first GM vehicle to get it. I think it was first used on the 2009ish Cadillac CTS, but my attention is focused on Corvettes, so it may have been in another GM product before that. Corvette was not the first to get it. All electronic parking brakes came with the built-in “drive off” feature which would override the system if the transmission was not in park or neutral and enough throttle pedal was being applied by the driver.

Test car question: We drive for fun, we know you drive for work. Tell us about your existing company car, how long you've been driving it, how many miles you've put on it and any winter driving experience you'd care to share. I am currently in a 2024 E-Ray – it was built late last year just before we started regular production. It is a 2LT convertible in Riptide blue with polished wheels and a black interior. I've been driving it since the first week of January and I have almost 3000 miles on it.

Tell us an E-Ray feature story. As the E-Ray Is the first Corvette hybrid, tell us about a feature unique to the E-Ray from the other C8 models that you are very happy with. All wheel drive traction – that's really the reason it's the quickest Corvette ever. That level of traction and power is amazing. You might be thinking we could have done all wheel drive without the hybrid system. It would not have been at all practical with our drivetrain layout and much heavier by the time we packaged some kind of a transfer case and routed a drive shaft back up to the front somehow getting around the engine.



Engineering strength and traction Question: If a single E-Ray competed in a tug-of-war against two C8 Stingrays, with throttle being applied equally, which team would win?

That is a great question. I'm going to make some assumptions around this hypothetical situation...The first is that they are all on the same surface with the same tire compounds and tread patterns, which isn't quite possible, but close if all cars have either the Michelin PS4S or the All Season tires. I'm also going to assume that the Stingrays are connected in such a way that they both pull in exactly the same direction, opposite of the E-Ray. If they pull at some angle to each other, the E-Ray likely wins given their force vectors. Also we'll assume static friction, and that no tire is slipping. The first car to slip a tire loses whether that be the E-Ray or any one of the Stingrays, as the coefficient of kinetic friction is much lower than the coefficient of static friction. All of the cars have enough torque to spin the tires, so torque output doesn't really come into play here. I'll also assume that the tires are inflated to a pressure that maximizes their contact patch given the temperature of the tire. If you approximate the tractive capability of the tire with its width (which isn't completely accurate because it's not a linear relationship), then multiply it by the weight over each tire, the pair of Stingrays working together have a slight edge over the E-Ray.

Wind Tunnel Question: If a person weighing 150 pounds, wearing frictionless clothing, has laid down on the top of a C8 coupe and did not hold on, at what speed would the wind force him off? Please show your work. If the person was wearing frictionless clothing, you wouldn't have to move at all...they'd slide off the hood. I assume you want to know at what speed they'd be pushed over the windshield and by that point they'd get pushed off the roof and not get caught on a spoiler or a wing.

The force created by drag on an object moving through a fluid can be expressed in the following general equation: $F_d = 1/2 \times \text{the density of the fluid (air)} \times \text{the speed squared} \times \text{the coefficient of drag} \times \text{the area of the object projected along the direction of travel}$. $F_d = 1/2 \rho v^2 C_d A$.

This can be set up in a problem statement using vector mechanics to determine the speed needed to lift an object weighing 150 lbs. long the direction of the windshield which is at about 38 degrees from the direction of travel. The ratio of the horizontal force of drag to the vertical force needed to overcome 150 lbs. will be the tangent of 38 degrees from trigonometry. Rearranged using algebra to

solve for speed giving the following equation: $v = \sqrt{\frac{2W}{\rho C_d A \tan 38^\circ}}$ W= is the weight of the person, 150lbs. I like to convert to metric units to reduce the number of conversions later. 150lbs of force = 667 newtons. ρ = the density of air which I'll assume to be 1.2041 kg/m^3 at 70° and normal atmospheric pressures. C_d = the coefficient of drag on this foolish person. You did not give me any detail about their shape, and we don't do any testing on humans in the wind tunnel, so I'll assume this person is making themselves as streamlined as possible and their coefficient of drag is 0.7. You also did not give me the area of the person, but 150 lbs is pretty small, so I'll assume their area along the direction of travel to be 0.15 m^2 . Can you see how this ridiculous hypothetical calculation could be loaded with inaccuracy? Plugging those numbers into the speed equation I conjured gives 116 m/s, which converts to about 260 mph.....



Worst ski accident story: First I'll tell you mine. I was about 13 years old and was skiing at our local ski area, in Incline Village Nevada. The snow depth was very limited and every morning and afternoon we skied on ice and had only the middle of the day for something resembling soft ground. We did aerials over a kangaroo jump on the side of a run we built. The landing was hard due to the frozen snow. On one jump, I was going too fast and a ski caught a rut on the takeoff and I lost control and landed on my back. The worst part of the whole experience was my big brother laughed at me as I lay on the ground gasping for breath. I learned 20 years later that I whacked my spine enough to put a curve in it. Tell us about your worst ski accident. I've been in a ski patrol sled a couple of times. This first one was similar to your experience and at about the same age. I was the first to go off one of our favorite stump jumps this particular day, only on this day there was not enough snow covering the lip of the stump. Since I already gave you a friction lesson, you can relate to what happens on skis when suddenly friction goes way up. It threw me forward for what would have been a cool front flip if properly planned, but since this was unplanned I landed on my head/neck. Of course there was no helmet usage back then, so a concussion was the diagnosis, but I'm sure it didn't help my neck which is felt more as I age. My other sled ride was a few years later with a ski coming off on a mogul run. I didn't fall, but the ski flipped up and caught me in the forehead. The edge split my head wide open. Head wounds bleed a lot, and blood wicks through the snow to make a large amount seem even larger. I only needed some stitches, but the slope looked like a murder scene so that one got more attention.

Travel Question: Which work trip that you regularly travel to allows you to have some fun before or after the Event? Laguna Seca is one that I've extended my stay a few times. Daytona and Sebring are others as are pretty much any location outside of Michigan in the winter. I don't go to all the same events every year so the extended travel is not consistent, but I always have fun before, during and after race events – even if I don't extend my travel.

Music Questions: I was introduced to classical music by watching Looney Tunes as a child, and “humor” music by listening to Spike Jones and Allan Sherman albums with my Dad. What exposure did you have to music as a youngster with your family? I was exposed to a lot of rock/pop music of the early 60's growing up. That's the only music that was ever played in a Corvette with my father at the wheel, I'm guessing that's still the case.

Car Feature Request: Please put a plastic sound-proof cone in the passenger side of the car, similar to the Cone of Silence in Get Smart, so if the driver can get some quiet from the passenger. Can you work on that? We do have active noise cancelation. We've often joked about how nice it would be to cancel sounds coming from the other seat and I'm sure there are times when it would be appreciated by the driver and the passenger. Unfortunately, it hasn't been designed to cancel out speech – maybe someday.
