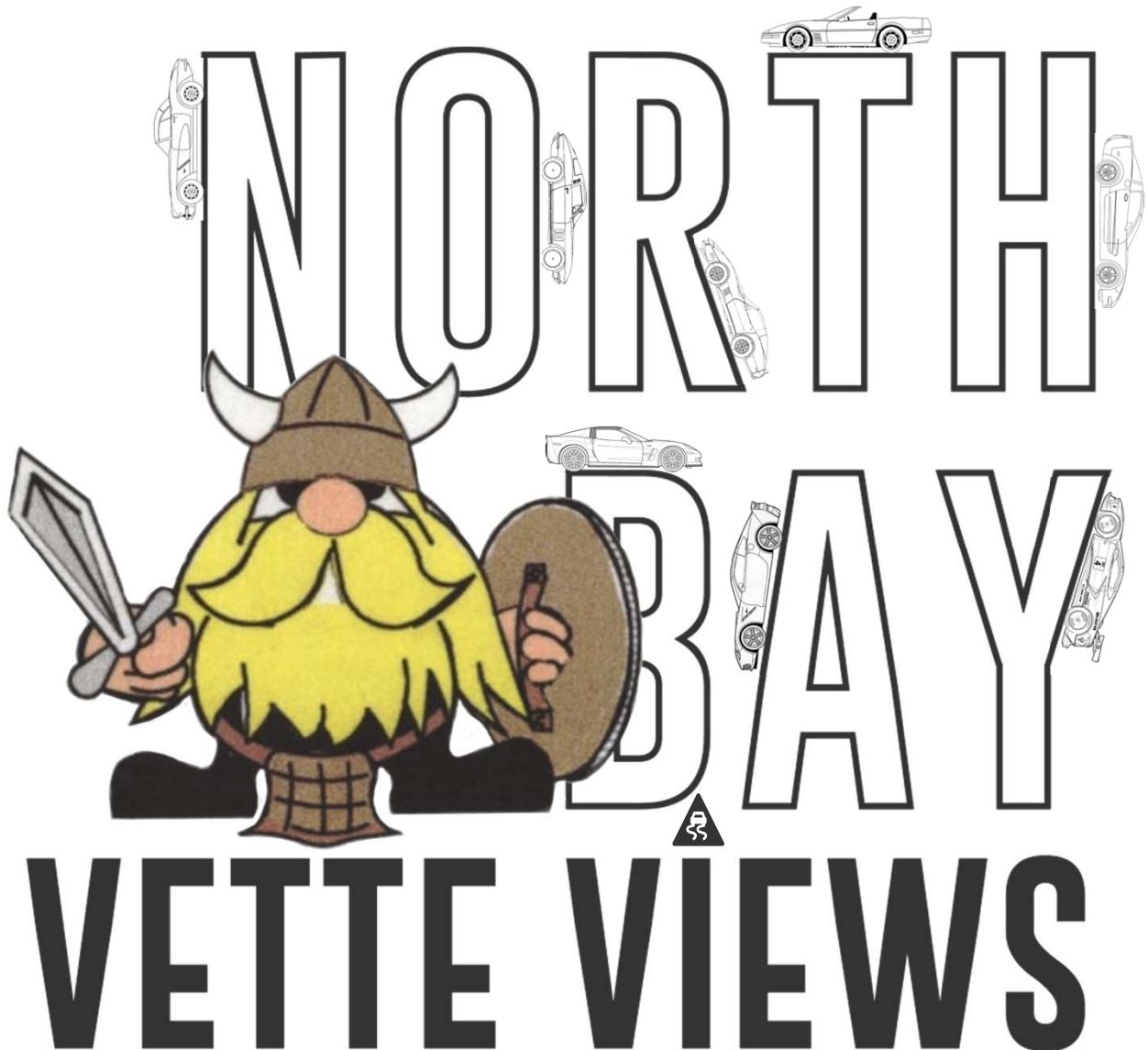

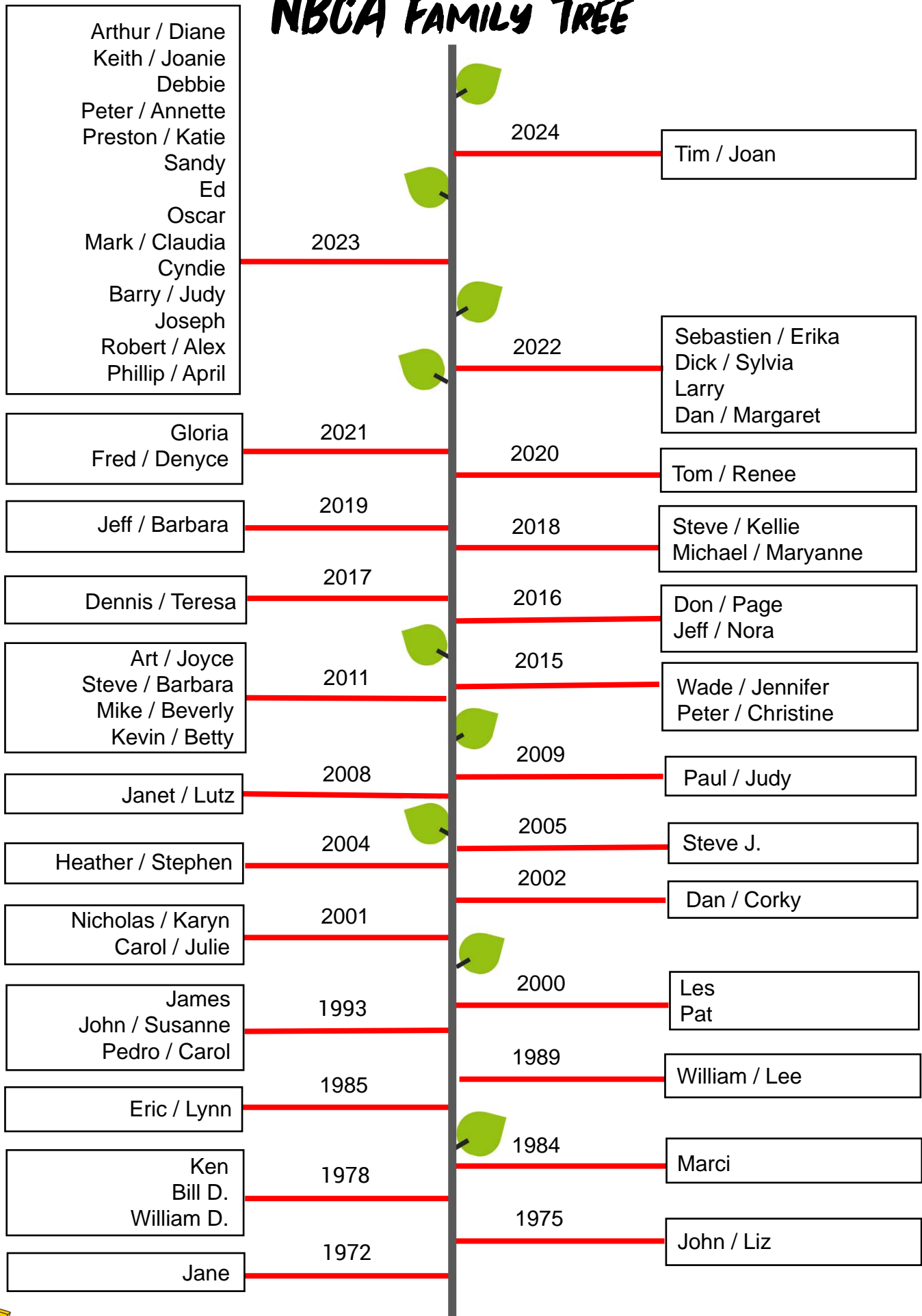

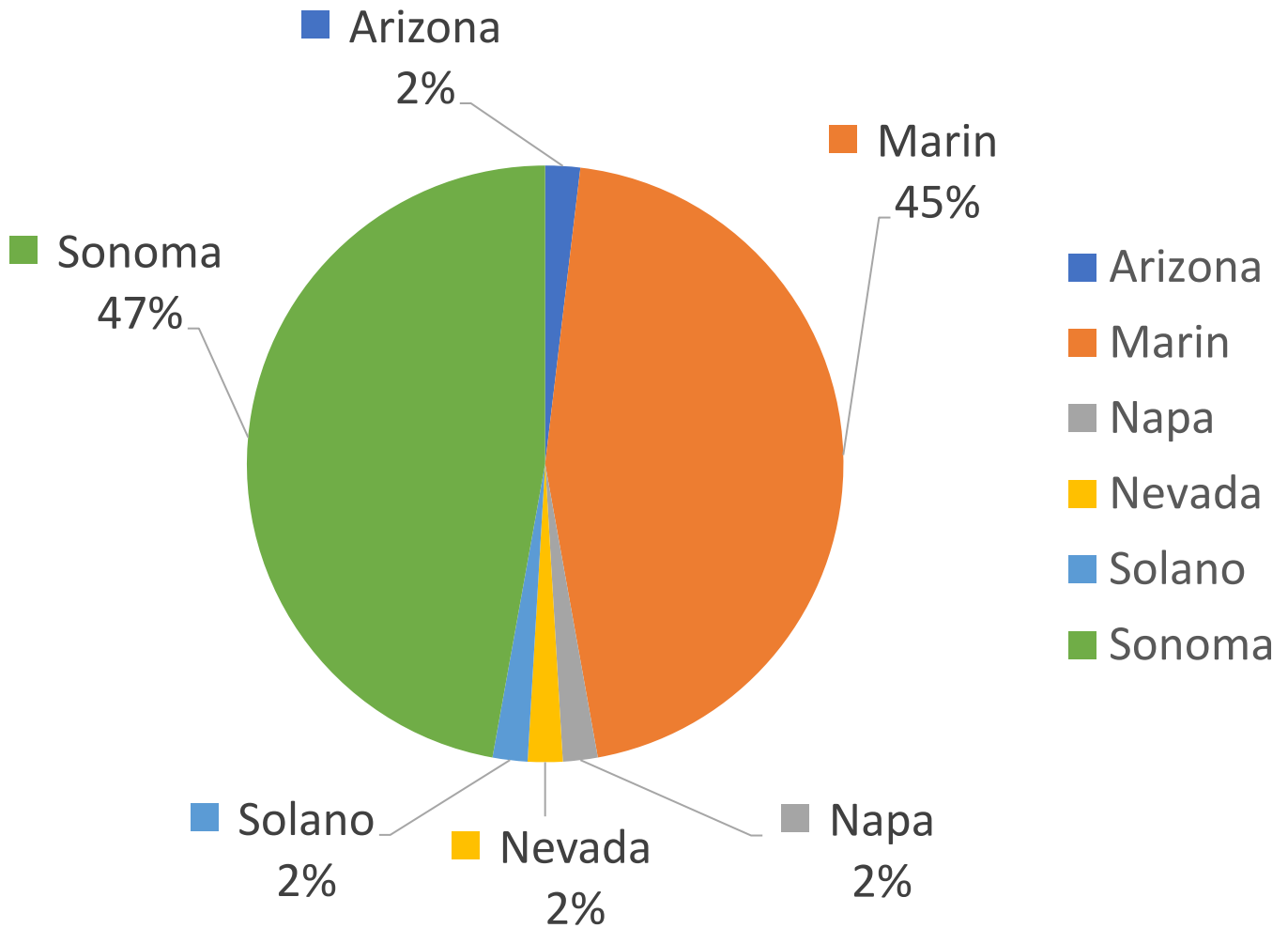

excessive speed and braking information. There is some ability at purchase to opt-out.

Jeff was in Spain for a wedding and previous was gone as his wife Nora's brother-in-law passed.

Questions were asked about the Francis Scott Key Bridge collapse in Baltimore.

We are fortunate to have a member with training, certifications and practical experience in a
career in which he never had an incident as a Chief Engineer. He enlightened us on control
systems.

Why was there a total loss of power? And did not see attempts to restore power.



A total loss would lead to suspecting a fuel delivery issue.

Were the auxiliary generators on the same fuel source? Thus, no power there either.

There are separate power systems to critical components like the rudder.

There is a “trick wheel” that sends steering commands directly from bridge to rudder but still need power to the rudder motors.

Why were tug boats not called to redirect the path of the ship?

The ship was doing about 9 knots and most tugs max out at 9 knots so can't catch up plus, redirecting hundreds of tons does not happen quickly and not a recommend option.

SF Bay has addition requirements after the ship glanced off the Bay Bridge

Ships of over 1000ft have Certificates that document required number of people to operate.

CORVETTE ENGINEERING

THE FOLLOWING IS A QUESTION AND ANSWER DISCUSSION BETWEEN JEFF FARBER VP OF NBCA AND JOSH HOLDEN, CHIEF CORVETTE PRODUCT ENGINEER.....



Josh was interviewed and asked questions regarding C8 Corvette model features, general car-related issues, and a few personal questions too.

Q: Engineers in team building question: Is there anyone new that has recently joined your team that you'd like to speak about and share what role he/she has?

A: I could go on and on about our team - we have a lot of great people working on the Corvette. A car with so much storied history and excitement also generates a lot of enthusiasm from employees that get the chance to work on it. Most of us would say that we have our dream job, or something close to that. We had a lot of retirements last year. Lane Rezek replaced Jeff Strausser as our Corvette Brand Quality Manager, and Austin Fisher has taken over Program Quality Manager duties after Tim Campbell retired. Austin was able to work for Tim briefly before he retired to help make the transition as smooth as possible. Many customers will see Austin or Lane at events this year. As their titles suggest, they play a huge role in making Corvette quality the best it has ever been. Keith Badgley took over for the legendary Mike Kutcher as one of our lead development engineers and we are very happy to have him.

Q: What the heck question: I see white vehicles from all manufacturers peeling, but rarely ever see it with cars painted other than white. Could it be that there is not enough Pig in the white paint pigment? Can you explain a possible reason for this phenomenon?

A: As there are many factors that could cause paint to peel, I could only speculate - so I Won't.



Q: Trick car question: I was at some vintage racing this past weekend and saw some cool racers from the 1970 and 1980s. If I put some 185s on a C8 Stingray and ran in Winter mode so the nannies protected me, how do you think I'd fare against those cars?

Do you think I could go a few fast laps without crashing?

A: If you could find a wheel that cleared the brake, allowed for the fitment of a 185 series tire, and made sure the front to rear diameter ratio was kept close so as not to fault the chassis control system, I think the car could hold its own with the vintage racers. I'm confident you could go a few "fast" laps without crashing.

Q: Car Feature Request: To make the C8 a better daily driver, could you come up with a rear bumper-hatch option? I'm picturing the bumper-section folding down like the GM truck multiPro tailgate and allowing for a passthrough above the engine through a sliding window to the windshield. I'd like to place 2x4 boards that I'd pickup at the lumberyard in my C8. I'm sure the market for this option would be huge. Can you envision engineering this?

A: I can envision engineering this which is why I hope we never do it. There is an accessory mat that includes a flap which folds over the fascia to protect it from damage when loading luggage. That might be the closest we get to a multi-pro tailgate. I think we'll keep the Corvette a sports car with excellent grand touring utility. If we tried to make it more like a truck, chances are it would be a bad truck and a bad sports car.

Q: Summer BBQ question: Is there any special food you barbecue that would be a hit at a country fair if you ran a food truck in your spare time?

A: I'm not sure it's ready for the country fair, but I do like to smoke a brisket once in a while.

Q: Upcoming Race Question: I believe you mentioned you've got the IMSA races at Laguna Seca in May on your calendar? Please share if you are traveling to California for IMSA (and you want the public to know) and will Angela travel with you, and will you be able to briefly vacation on that trip? I've heard the best race C7 Z06 is not able to be in attendance. Does that disappointment make you consider not coming?
