**Social Director Jeff Farber:** Jeff mentioned that the Social Calendar on the website needs to be updated. He displayed the calendar on the screen. The next social will be this Saturday, Sept. 16, at the "Wheels and Wings" show benefitting the Pacific Coast Air Museum in Santa Rosa. The quorum issue was thereby satisfied.

Jeff asked the members if they approved of this transaction. The majority approved.

Individuals may retain their individual membership with WSCC if they so choose.

Ken Albers has accepted Jeff's request to act as our Nominating Committee Chairperson to identify potential officers for the 2024 Calendar Year.

**Treasurer Mike McLucas:** advised the club of our financial status, including our current account balance, as well as deposits and disbursements that occurred during the preceding month. The club treasury is in a positive and excellent condition. Ken Albers moved that the Treasurer's Report be approved, which was seconded by Maryanne McLucas. Motion approved.

**Old Business:** Marci Albers had her first National Corvette Museum Ambassador's report.
