CORVETTE ENGINEERING

THE FOLLOWING IS A Q & A BETWEEN JEFF FARBER VP AND JOSH HOLDER, CHIEF CORVETTE PRODUCT ENGINEER......



Christmas Question: Did you decorate your house for Christmas? I did some lights on the outside, Angela did the hard work on the inside. We host a Christmas part in early December, so there was incentive to get it done early.

Computer-related Question: Approximately how many features are shut down when placing the C8 in Track Mode? None directly in just Track mode. In Performance Traction Management, we can scale back the Traction Control System and Electronic Stability Control to the point of shutting both of them off.

Engineers playing around Question: Since you live in Michigan snow country, what kind of snowrelated driving do you do with your pre-production test car? Have you tied a rope to it and pulled anyone in a sled behind the car during a snow storm? I've not tried pulling anyone in a sled, but have been in pretty deep snow, including some steep grades, and on glare ice. C8 Corvettes are remarkably capable with an all season or snow tire – especially the ERay.

Fuel Question: What does Corvette do with all the Gas Caps that they don't put on their cars? More importantly, what stops the gas from sloshing out? Fortunately we stopped ordering gas caps at about the time we designed them out of vehicles. There are 2 different valves inside of a capless system to keep any fuel and vapors from sloshing out. They must be pushed open by the pump nozzle to fill the tank.



Josh has a fun side Questions: What undergraduate school did you attend? Were you in a fraternity? I started at GMI (now Kettering University) in Flint, Michigan and accepted a bid at the Theta Xi fraternity. I transferred to Weber State University in Ogden, Utah before finishing my pledge work, so I never became a brother, but still have many friends I keep in touch with from that experience.

Travel Question: Can a trailer hitch be put on a C8 and if yes, what would it's towing capacity be? No. The rear bumper is made from carbon fiber, so an adequate hitch attachment will be very difficult. I hope no one tries it. Corvettes aren't rated to carry much of a rear axle load, so even if one could be attached, it really couldn't handle any tongue weight. Corvettes do have plenty of power and torque capacity and well as brake capacity so they would be good at pulling and stopping, but please don't attempt to pull a trailer.

Question: What kind of music do you favor? Have you ever played an instrument or sung in a choir? I'll listen to many genres, but prefer hard rock of the 80's (hair bands). I played drums in junior high and a guitar in a garage band for a while in my early high school years. I still have some guitars, but rarely play them anymore.

Shop Question: What is the tool you are the happiest you purchased for your garage? A lift – great for maintenance and storage.




