Hi everyone.

Hope you have enjoyed your summer. We are now off to the Fall season and changing from Drive-N-Dines to Morning Coffees. I have several people in the process of becoming new members of NBCA.

At the September 20th NCCC Reginal meeting, NCCC announced that the dues for 2026 will be increasing. The initial dues for the Primary Member have been increased by \$15, to \$50. The dues for the Spouse Member were increased by \$5, to \$15. This increase is for the initial joining of NCCC, not renewals. Renewal fees for the Primary Member will be \$40, and the Spouse Member's dues will be \$15, both up by \$5. NBCA's dues will remain the same at \$10. Another change for this year is that dues are due by November 15 instead of December 15. That is a month earlier than previous years. The reason for this change is that the NCCC Regional Membership Director has resigned, and all communications and payments must be sent to the National Membership Director's address in Illinois. She wants more time to process all the 2,313 memberships from the Regional West Coast/Northwest section that we are part of. Who would blame her. So, I'm asking all of you to get your renewal dues to me as soon as possible so that I also have time to register the renewals on the NCCC's website. The old Regional Membership Director used to do this portion of the process.




Kevin asked about the Raffle Ticket Confirmation, and Eric did receive confirmation of tickets.
