California Highway Patrol Officer Tickets 5 Chevy Corvettes in One Shot for Speeding

The quintet of Corvettes was traveling on Highway 1 over the Memorial Day weekend when the CHP pulled them over.

It's not an uncommon occurrence for a Chevrolet Corvette's driver to receive a speeding violation. Seeing five Corvettes getting ticketed at once by a single officer, though? That's bit more rare.

Yet that's exactly what happened over Memorial Day Weekend along the California coast, when a <u>California Highway Patrol</u> officer pulled over a quintet of Corvettes



and slapped their drivers with tickets for traveling well above the speed limit, according to the Santa Cruz division of the California Highway Patrol, or CHP.

According to a post on the CHP – Santa Cruz Facebook page, the five Corvettes – which appear to have included at least one C7-generation Corvette Stingray and at least two C8-gen Corvettes – were speeding on Highway 1 near Davenport, California. (Coincidentally, that's roughly 30 minutes away from the location where another CHP – Santa Cruz officer had to <u>push an upside-down Lamborghini</u> off Highway 9 earlier this month.)

The holiday weekend saw the department on high alert for moving infractions, <u>announing on social media</u> ahead of time that they would be ramping up patrols from Friday, May 23 at 6:01pm until Monday, May 25 at 11:59pm. Considering what happened, it would seem the drivers of the five <u>Corvettes</u> in question don't follow the CHP on social media.


A photo posted by the CHP officer shows him holding a stack of citations. On the one citation that's most visible, we can see the officer lists the approximate speed as "65+ mph" and the radar speed listed as "70+ mph." The posted speed limit on that section of Highway 1 is 55 mph.

The Corvettes were technically speeding, but without a specific speed noted, we don't know by how much exactly. Still, the CHP used the unusual traffic stop to reinforce a stern message: "Remember: SPEED KILLS. Let's keep our roads safe for everyone. Slow down, enjoy the journey, and drive to arrive. Your loved ones are counting on you," CHP wrote on Facebook.

Comments on the CHP social media post range from praise for keeping the roads safe to accusations that this was simply a money grab. One thing that doesn't need to be debated, though: when the police tell you they're going to strictly enforce the traffic laws, you should heed their warning.







This afternoon, during the HOLIDAY ENFORCEMENT PERIOD, a CHP officer spotted not one, not two, but FIVE Corvettes zooming well above the speed limit on HWY 1 near Davenport.


