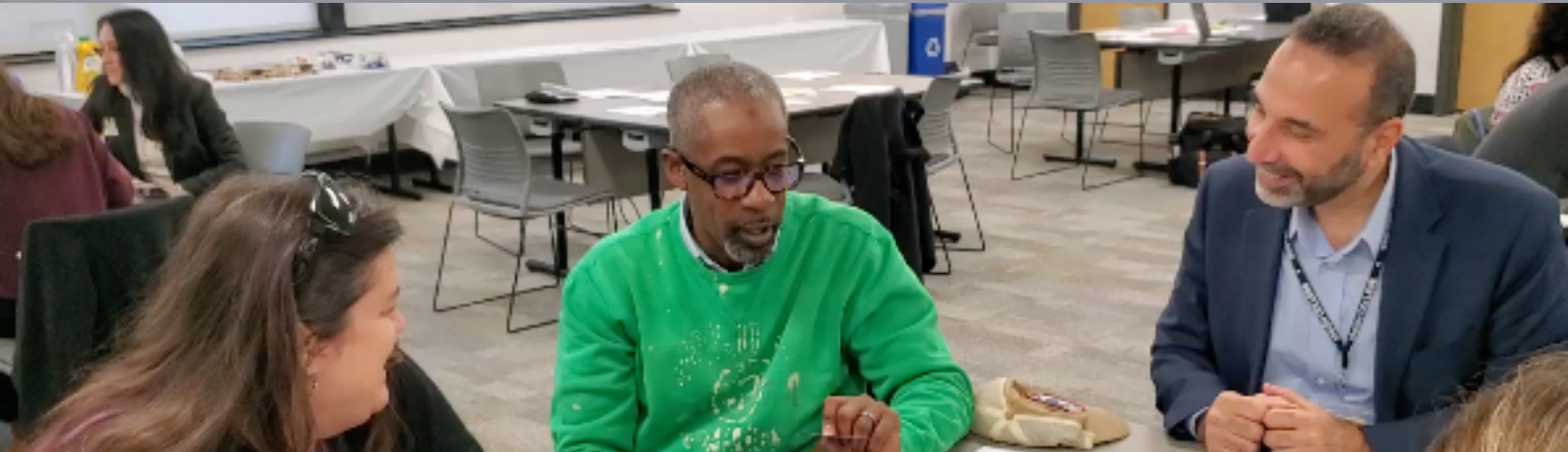




Greater Newark STEM Ecosystem (GSNE)
