RE: Memorial Hall Loyalty Pricing

Plymouth Recreation in conjunction with Memorial Hall is recommending a loyalty pricing plan that would benefit organizations frequently renting Memorial Hall for their events. Memorial Hall wants to recognize these organizations and show our appreciation for choosing to do business with the facility and the Town of Plymouth.

Organizations renting Memorial Hall 29 dates or less during a calendar year would not qualify for Loyalty pricing and would pay the full rental amount and all fees associated with those rental dates.

- 30-35 dates booked by the same organization during a calendar year would save the group the manager fee
- 36-40 shows booked by the same organization during a calendar year would save the group \$200 off the full rental fee plus the manager fee
- 41-45 shows booked by the same organization during a calendar year would save the group \$300 off the full rental fee plus the manager fee
- 46-50 shows booked by the same organization during a calendar year would save the group \$450 off the full rental fee plus the manager fee
- 51+ shows booked by the same organization during a calendar year would save the group \$600 off the full rental fee plus the manager fee

Loyalty pricing applies only to full rental days and cannot be combined with other discounts (e.g., second-day rental savings). This pricing plan does not apply to deposited show dates, only completed shows. Organizations will save on final invoices for dates 30 and beyond. When completing the contract for dates 36 and beyond, the rental savings and manager fee savings will be applied. Final invoices are only issued after the completion of each show.

The Town of Plymouth reserves the right to review and modify the Loyalty pricing plan at any time and will give organizations 6 months' notice of any changes being made.
