

Scenario Scavenger Hunt

Ask "How can I store up treasures in heaven" in each situation?

1. You're in class and a student is called on to answer a simple question. She answers it totally wrong and your classmates start to snicker and whisper, "Is she stupid?" The girl hears them and shrinks back in silence. What do you do?
