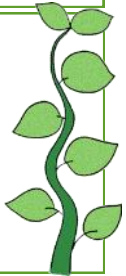

Holy Cross Day Said Eucharist

Thursday 14 September, 11am

In the Christian liturgical calendar, there are several different Feasts of the Cross, all of which commemorate the cross used in the crucifixion of Jesus. These days celebrate the cross itself, as the instrument of salvation. In some parts of the Anglican Communion the feast is called Holy Cross Day. The celebration is also sometimes called Holy Rood Day.
