Saints' Days Eucharist
Luke the Evangelist

Wednesday 18 October, 11am

Luke the Evangelist is one of the Four Evangelists—the four traditionally ascribed authors of the canonical Gospels. The early church fathers ascribed to him authorship of both the Gospel according to Luke and the book of Acts of the Apostles, which would mean Luke contributed over a quarter of the text of the New Testament, more than any other author. He is believed to have been a martyr, reportedly as having been hanged from an olive tree, though some believe otherwise. We venerate him as Saint Luke the Evangelist and as a patron saint of artists, physicians, bachelors, surgeons, students and butchers.
