Arnold E. Cook, a well known resident of Petersburg, was drowned in Lake Taconic Friday morning. In company with Alonzo Weeden, he was rafting lumber across the lake. The two men occupied a boat, which began to fill with water. Cook became frightened and grasped his companion, and the two were thrown into the lake. Weeden managed to swim ashore, but the other was drowned. Mr. Cook, who was a farmer, was fifty years of age. He is survived by his wife, one son and one daughter. Coroner Hutton was called.
