Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of
the sum of Two hundred and thirty-five

(\$ 235-00), to

them duly paid, have sold, and
By these Presents, do grant and convey to the said parties of the
second part, their heirs and assigns,

All that Tract or Parcel of Land, situate in the town of
Grafton County of Rensselaer and
State of New York, bounded and described as fol-
lows to wit: Beginning at a stake and
stones standing at the north east corner
of the lot called and known as the "Elisha
Grandall" lot and runs thence easterly
along marked trees to a hemlock stake
in the swamp - thence south easterly to
the brook known as the "Round Pond brook"
thence southerly along the brook to ~~the~~ the Round Pond
- thence northerly along the east line of
the said Elisha Grandall lot to the place
of beginning, containing about six acres
be the same more or less.
