

Troy and Grafton Auto Line.

The Troy and Grafton Automobile Line for passengers and baggage, designed to run between Troy and Grafton twice daily, by way of Eagle Mills and Cropseyville, and continuing on beyond Grafton Centre about four and one-half miles to Lake Taconic, is one of the latest new enterprises in town. The car is a Rapid and has a capacity for twenty persons. It is a thirty-horsepower machine and will be able to make the run to Grafton in about an hour from Troy. It is proposed to make the initial trip Monday. During this week the machine will be at Burdick's garage on River Street. E. L. Snyder is the manager, and the office is at the Gifford House on Congress Street.

The establishment of this line is an innovation in this vicinity, and it will open a most beautiful section of the county to many persons who have not gone there because of inadequate facilities for transportation.
