



Summer 2022 Program Details Elmhurst, Lincolnshire, Long Grove

Elmhurst: The Center for Gifted, 533 W North Avenue, Suite 30

Lincolnshire: Daniel Wright Junior High School, 1370 Riverwoods Road

Program Structure

Lincolnshire: (For students entering 7th-8th grades) One 3½ week (17 days) session, June 6-28, meets on weekdays, 12:30-3:00. Students enjoy in-depth, hands-on exploration every afternoon. An innovative “immersion” approach enables for every student the privilege of mastering the course content.

Elmhurst and Long Grove: (For students entering 1st-10th grades) Eleven independent one-week sessions, May 31 – August 12, meet on weekdays. Students may enroll in as many or few sessions as they wish, for either the full day (9:00-3:00), for morning half-day (9:00-11:40), or for afternoon half-day (12:20-3:00). For each session in which they enroll, they choose two courses from the selections on the flyer if enrolling for the full day, or one course if enrolling for the half day; and enjoy an in-depth, 160-minute class period with their chosen topic each morning and/or afternoon. Before beginning their afternoon course, students enrolled for the full day join their peers and teachers for lunch (sack lunches brought from home) and recreation, which will include outdoor activity whenever weather permits. Programs will not run on the Memorial Day holiday (Monday, May 30) and on the Independence Day holiday (Monday, July 4).

Also at Long Grove, we offer single-day options during Session XI, a short three-day session just before most nearby school districts begin their academic year. On August 15, 16 and 17, students may enroll for one, two, or all three days, either full day or half day.

Eligibility

Proof of student eligibility is not required for our 2022 summer programs. It is our privilege to serve bright, motivated children seeking new challenges and fresh inspiration. Grade level requirements for the various courses are as of fall, 2022, and are flexible. We respect that all students deserve to be appropriately challenged. Feel free to contact us if you wish to discuss a grade-level exception for your child for any session or course.

Other Details

- **Application/Enrollment:** Apply online [here](#) or from our website at www.thecenterforgifted.org. There are no application deadlines; applications are accepted for each session either until it is full or until the evening before it begins. Applications submitted before May 1, 2022 must include the required \$100 deposit, which will be credited to tuition. Applications submitted after that date must include payment in full. Parents receive email confirmation of enrollment upon submitting their application. A few days before the start date of each session in which their child is enrolled, parents receive an enrollment email with details regarding drop-off, pick-up, lunches, and etc. Parents may transfer their child's enrollment from one class or session to another at any time before their session begins.
- **Course selection:** Each course is designed to challenge and inspire its students for the entire length of the session in which it is offered. (Course descriptions are available on a separate PDF which can be downloaded from our website.) When reviewing course selections, be sure to note the grade levels for each course (per the individual program flyers, also downloadable from our website.) For courses spanning several grade levels, students are placed in classrooms with their age peers, usually with no more than two or three grade levels per classroom. Parents may phone or email us to change their child's course choice(s) at any time before each session begins, or to request a grade level exception for their child.
- **Tuition: Elmhurst and Long Grove** - Tuition for each five-day session is \$500 for full day and \$250 for half day. Tuition for Sessions I and VI with Monday holidays (May 31-June 2 and July 5-8) is \$400 for full day and \$200 for half day. Tuition for Long Grove Session XI (August 15-17) with the single-day option is \$100/day for full day and \$50/day for half day.
Lincolnshire – Tuition is \$850. There is also a \$20 lab fee.
- **Payments:** A tuition deposit of \$100 per session per child is required with enrollment and will be credited to tuition. Payment of the balance due will be processed automatically on May 1, 2022, on the bank card the family used to pay its deposit. Parents who prefer to use a different bank card to pay their balance may log in to their account (using the link at the bottom of the confirmation email they received when they enrolled) at any time before May 1 and process their own payment. Families enrolling after May 1 will be required to pay in full at time of enrollment. The online payment methods we accept are Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover.
- **Refunds:** Tuition is fully refunded, minus a \$10 processing fee, for withdrawals requested by the day before the session from which withdrawal is requested begins, via voicemail or phone call to 847-901-0173, or email to info@centerforgifted.org. There are no refunds, credits, or discounts for absences of any length or for any reason, for late or partial enrollments, for siblings, or for enrolling in multiple programs. There is no fee for transferring a student from one session to another at any time before the session from which they are transferring begins.
- **Financial assistance:** Need-based financial assistance may be available. If you would like to apply, please call or email The Center for Gifted to request an application form.
- **Safety measures:** The Center for Gifted offers inspiring learning experiences in small peer-group classes, in controlled, safe, nurturing environments. Programs and activities of The Center for Gifted are modified to meet Illinois guidelines in effect at the time they run.
