Grades 6-8

Session I (Select one course)

From Algebra to Zero:

From algebra, binary numbers, and cubes, to origami and pi, to y-axis and zero, each day is organized as lab explorations of mathematics from algebra, geometry, and statistics through problem solving, communication, and connections.

Persuasive Speaking & Creative Writing:

Learn how to speak effectively, whether trying to persuade one person or a roomful. Write stories and/or poems in response to various catalysts, then edit your work, design your page(s), and publish the writing of your choice in a class book.



Session II (Select one course)

Algebra in Chemistry & Geometry of Movement:

Use chemistry to study algebraic equations. From chemical reactions to neutralizing substances, find ways algebraic logic can mix with science. Then for the second week, study in the most fun ways with physics! Apply the ideas behind Newton's laws, reactions, and angles to make inventions go higher and further. Utilize a mix of geometry and data analysis through fun, hands-on projects.

Intro to Law & Creative Writing:

Learn what attorneys and courts do, while you participate in mock trials, taking on the different roles. Write stories and/or poems in response to various catalysts, then edit your work, design your page(s), and publish the writing of your choice in a class book.
