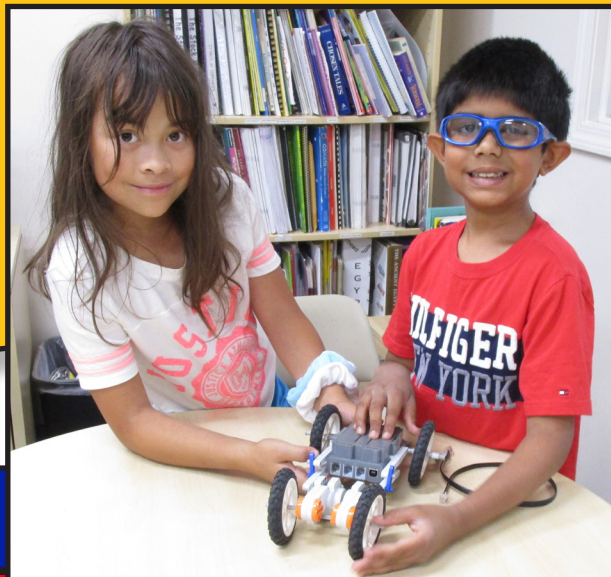

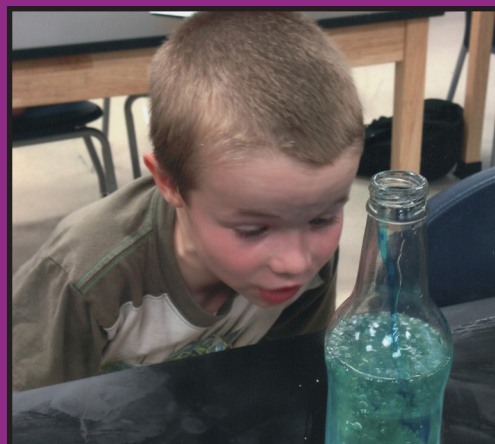
A Perspective by the Founder and Director
