Shilo and Jessica both want to compete for their school's rodeo title - but there is only budget for one. Finding out who it will be might cost them their relationship, friendships, family, and beloved horses.

Separatist Diet | TV Fantasy Drama Pilot | 10×60 | When a 5000-year-old vampire is cursed to leave her lesbian-separatist commune and illegally feed on men or die, she must set out on a cross-country road trip to find who cursed her. Along the way she faces old lovers, frenemies, and new foes while rediscovering empathy, human connection, and love.

The (Mis)adventures of Corrie & Finnegan McShambles | TV Animated Children's Pilot | 20 x 20 | 10-year-old Corrie must cowboy-up and adventure into the mycelial network through lands unknown to save her best friend -Finnegan McShambles the cat – from the dark forces of climate change (and make it back to Dartmoor by the end of half-term or else her Nan will be fumin').
