

✠NIV Acts 3:17-26, 10:43; Isaiah 55:8; Ephesian 2:8-10  
 Now fellow Israelites, I know that you acted in ignorance, as did your leaders. But this is how God fulfilled what he had foretold through all the prophets, saying that his Messiah would suffer. Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, and that he may send the Messiah, who has been appointed for you – even Jesus. Heaven must receive him until the time comes for God to restore everything, as he promised long ago through his holy prophets. For Moses said, ‘The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own people; you must listen to everything he tells you. Anyone who does not listen to him will be completely cut off from their people. Indeed, beginning with Samuel, all the prophets who have spoken have foretold these days. And you are heirs of the prophets and of the covenant God made with your fathers. He said to Abraham, ‘Through your offspring all people on earth will be blessed. When God raised up his servant, he sent him first to you by turning each of you from your wicked ways. For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD. (Now, I say to you fellow new Israelites, come out of the land of Egypt once again and follow Yeshua.) All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name. (Don’t stay in darkness, Repent, from the ways of the world. Numb the voices of the self, and listen only to Yahweh and Yeshua. Mankind will lead you astray. Seek our only what is true and everlasting.) For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Amen
