## Symbols in Chapter 17

Chapter 17 in Revelations is very detailed in letting us know what things are. See below for a reference.

**7 heads** =  $\frac{7 \text{ kings}}{1 \text{ kings}}$  (1<sup>st</sup> -5<sup>th</sup>) kings have fallen, 1 (6<sup>th</sup>) king is now, 1 (7<sup>th</sup>) king hasn't come yet, (8<sup>th</sup>) is the beast who was and now is not

**This beast** (above  $\uparrow$ ) = is the devil

Lamb = Jesus

**Lord of Lords & King of Kings** = Jesus (Question 24)

The waters where the prostitute sits = are peoples, multitudes, nations, and languages = These are the people who wore white robes, they are the other believers that had not reached full potential; they also were the ones to make it through the tribulation, and those that were slain (Question 11)

The called, chosen, and faithful followers = 144,000 (Question 7, 40)

**Woman/great prostitute** = great city the rules over the kings of the earth (Vatican City)

### Some Chain of Events

By God's will, God had the beast and 10 kings destroy Vatican City; and allowed the 10 kings to hand over their authority to the beast. Later in Rev. 19 the kings are eaten by birds with their armies, along with anybody who isn't saved. The beast and false prophet were thrown into the lake of fire. Satan is then put into the Abyss for 1,000 years. Jesus's followers (who were already judged by Jesus, and does not need to go before God's judgement) reigned with him for 1,000 years on earth. Satan let loose after the 1,000 years for a short time. Satan and anyone he deceives will be thrown in to the lake of fire. Death and Hades were also thrown into the lake of fire. All the rest of the dead will be judged by God. Anyone whose name is not found in the Book of Life, will automatically go to the lake of fire. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> death. After all this the New Heaven and New Earth with the New Jerusalem will come down after the old ones has burned up. There will be no sea, but there will be rivers of the water of life flowing from the throne of God and the Lamb. We will live with the Lamb and God the Father in the new Eden.

### **Book of Life**

Names can however be blotted out of the Book of Life. If one's name is blotted out, they will be put with the rest of the unbelievers. See these verses: (ones in blue, are names that won't be blotted out.) When it is talked about this much, one should listen.
