# **Tournament Rules:** Karl Downs' Doubles Scholarship Tournament!

## **Register Early for the Best Price!**

This Tournament is TNBA and USBC Certified. \* Awards to IES-TNBA Junior Bowlers are via USBC SMART. Participants will bowl three (3) singles games, and two (2) baker-double games, consecutively. The tournament primarily supports TNBA-IES youth bowlers under 18, as of 8/1/2024. Must be a youth or adult member of TNBA and USBC for participation and awards eligibility. Join with your entry. Memberships must be settled by the registration closing date. This event is a **Mixed Baker Doubles, Handicap** event with 2 Youth "OR" 1 Adult & 1 Youth Bowling Together, per entering pair, consisting of five (5) divisions:

#### HANDICAP DIVISION ENTERINGAVERAGES:

Youth and Adult entrants must use their highest 2022/2023 USBC league average (USBC Book), based on a minimum of seven (7) league sessions. (a) If no 2022/2023 USBC Book, then the current Summer 2024 average will be used, based on a minimum of seven (7) league sessions. (b) Youth and Adult entrants who have not bowled the required minimum sessions and have no 2022/2023 USBC Book or Summer 2024 average will bowl scratch. (c) "Sports Only" averages will be converted to determine division, using the USBC conversion table, located at <u>https://www.bowl.com/Sport Bowling/Sport Bowling Home/Average Conversion Chart</u>. (d) Entries must include league sheets for any certified USBC league not listed on bowl.com for the current season. Bowlers with averages which cannot be verified will bowl scratch – no exceptions. (e) All averages submitted are subject to verification. (f) No refunds. (g) Walk-in entries must pay in cash. Entries without correct league sheets will be assigned scratch averages.

A participant who has not bowled the required minimum sessions will bowl using an assigned scratch average. Scratch is defined as follows:

No refunds, unless approved by the Junior Program Director or Acting Tournament Director. Entries must include payment payable to TNBA Inland Empire Senate. Returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$25 penalty fee. **Do not mail entries after the** "mail date" **listed. Call our office for entry approval. Returned check penalty = \$25; if unpaid, entry and bowling scores are disqualified.** 

Substitutes will be allowed; as a result, the Tournament Division is subject to change. Check in at least one (1) hour prior to scheduled time to bowl. Proof of sanction (TNBA & USBC cards) must be provided prior to check-in. Tardy bowlers must begin the event in the frame being bowled. No blind scores will be allowed. All missed frames will receive zero (0). Disqualification for the following reasons will be the decision of Junior Program Director or Acting Tournament Director, which will be final: A) Falsifying scores; B) In appropriate conduct not becoming of a TNBA bowler; C) Changing from right hand to left hand or visa-versa during the tournament; D) Delaying tournament play; E) Using tobacco products and/or drinking alcoholic beverages; F) abuse of bowling center property. No Electronic devices of any sort in the settee area.

**DRESS CODE**: All bowlers must check-in wearing proper bowling attire. **Bowlers are highly encouraged to wear a TNBA Shirt or Jersey**. No alcohol, tobacco, sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. NO tank tops, halter-tops, sweats, spandex, cut-offs or hats of any kind allowed. Walking shorts, "skorts" and skirts cannot be more than 3-1/2 above the knee. The Junior Program Director or Acting Tournament Director shall determine the validity of any complaints. Bowlers must stay in the settee area while bowling, unless excused by scorekeeper or tournament monitor. There will be no food or drinks in the settee area.

Disputes and complaints must be filed by participants only. Decisions by Junior Program Director or Acting Tournament Director will be final. Protest must be made in writing within twenty-four (24) hours to the Junior Program Director or Acting Tournament Director. Protests must specify the rule violated. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.

**AWARDS:** Scholarships will be awarded, per division. The prize amount will be dependent upon bowler participation level, per division. Additional or bonus scholarships will be awarded as determined by the Tournament Committee. Scholarship allocation shall be returned 100% to the bowlers. Scholarships will be held with the USBC SMART program, (800) 514-2695 x3343; \$43 lineage, expenses, and awards; \$42 scholarships.
