DUTIES OF THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS

The Sergeant-at-Arms shall:

- a. Maintain and preserve order and security at senate meeting.
- b. Perform such other duties as may be required by the President.

Qualification for nominees for office:

- 1. Must have attended a National Meeting within the past two years of an election period (<u>President and Vice-President Nominees only</u>).
- 2. Any member in good standing is eligible to run for office provided that during the year immediately preceding the election year he/she meets at least three of the following qualifications:
 - a. Been a Senate or National Director or Committee Chairperson.
 - b. Been a National Convention delegate.
 - c. Been a Senate Member for at least one year.
 - **d.** Have attended a <u>minimum of two-thirds</u> of the regularly scheduled Senate meetings.
 - e. Been active in Senate activities.
