

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE V - Officers and Their Election

Section 1. The officers of this Senate shall consist of:

- a. President c. Secretary e. Sergeant-at-Arms
- b. Vice President d. Treasurer f. Asst. Secretary

Section 2.

The President and Vice President shall be elected by ballot for a term of two (2) years. They may succeed themselves immediately for one (1) additional term of two (2) years. They shall take office on September 1st of the year they are elected, and they shall hold office until August 31st of the year, two (2) years following their elections, or until their successors are elected.

POLICY & PROCEDURES

ARTICLE IV - Officers and Their Election

Section 1. Vacancies occurring in office either by death, resignation or otherwise shall be filled by the President and such persons appointed shall hold office until the next election year. If the office of President becomes vacant the Vice President shall assume the duties of the President. No vacancy of an elected office can be filled unless written resignation is filed with the Secretary of this Senate if reason for the vacancy is due to resignation.

Section 2. Qualification for nominees for office:

- c. Must have attended a National Meeting within the past two years of an election period (President and Vice-President Nominees only).
- d. Must have attended a minimum of two-thirds general Senate meetings within each election term (all officer nominees).
- e. Must be sanctioned TNBA member for minimum of (2) years (all officer nominees).
