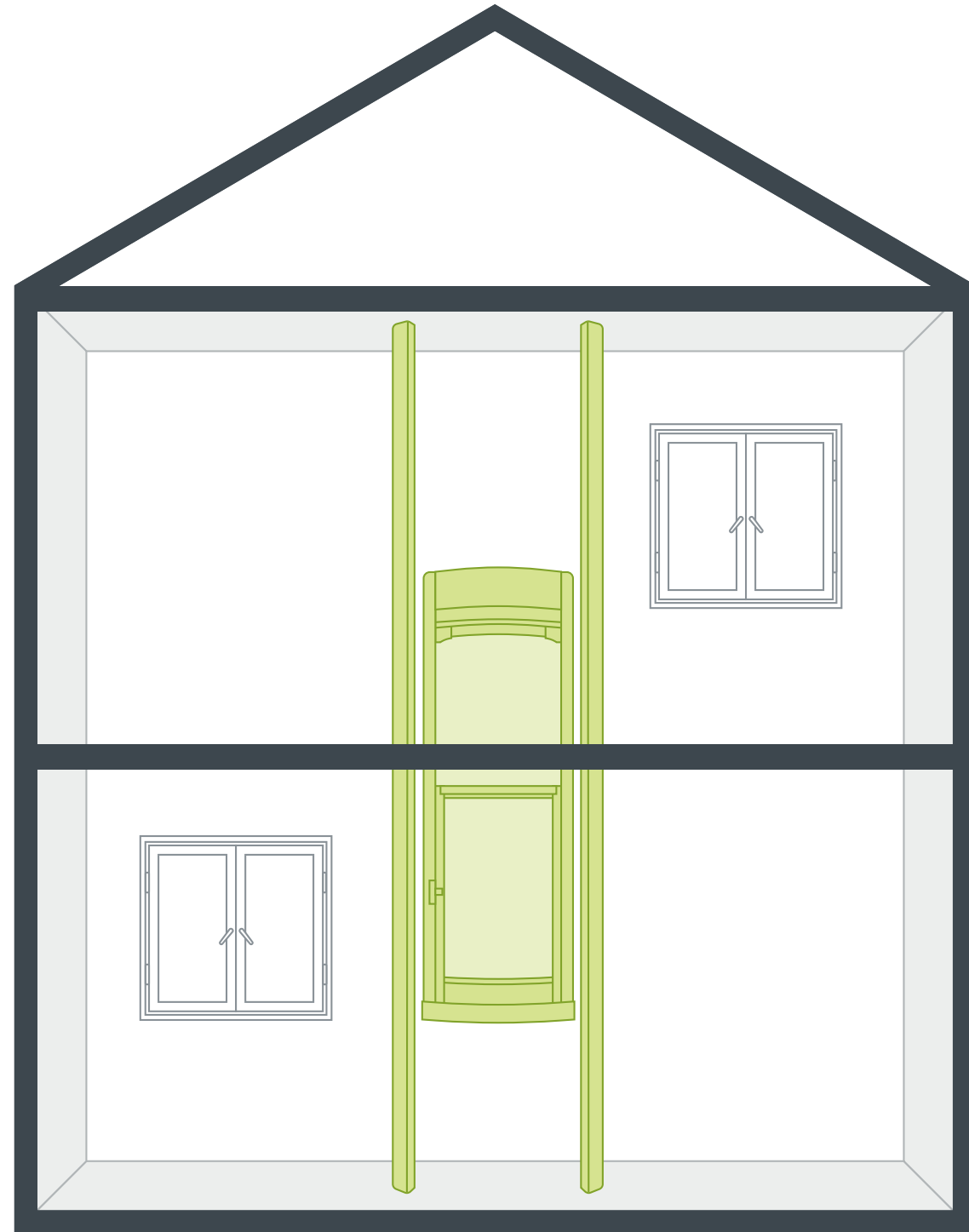


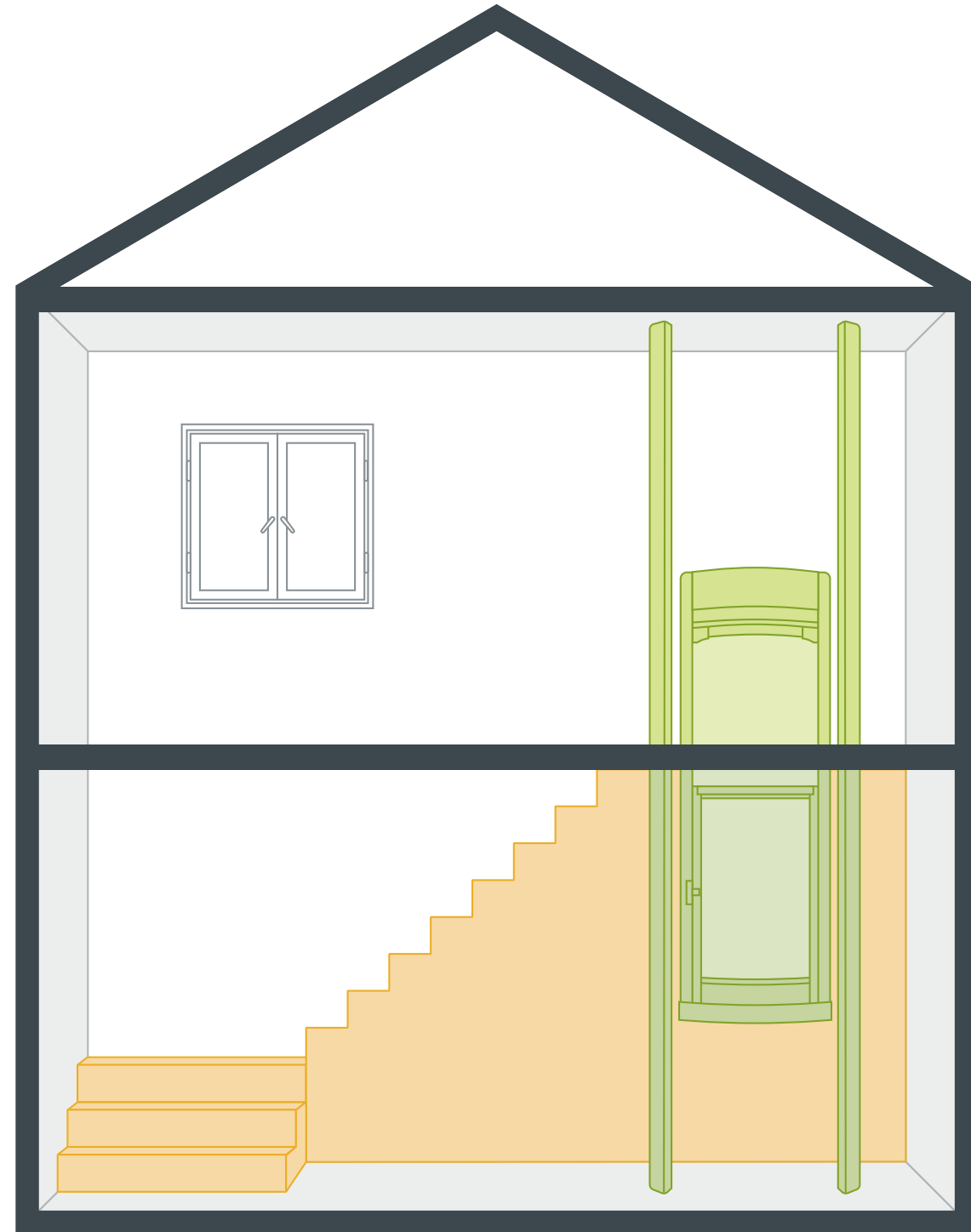
STANDARD

This is the most common location. The elevator travels through a floor opening from a downstairs room, arriving upstairs (typically in a bedroom).



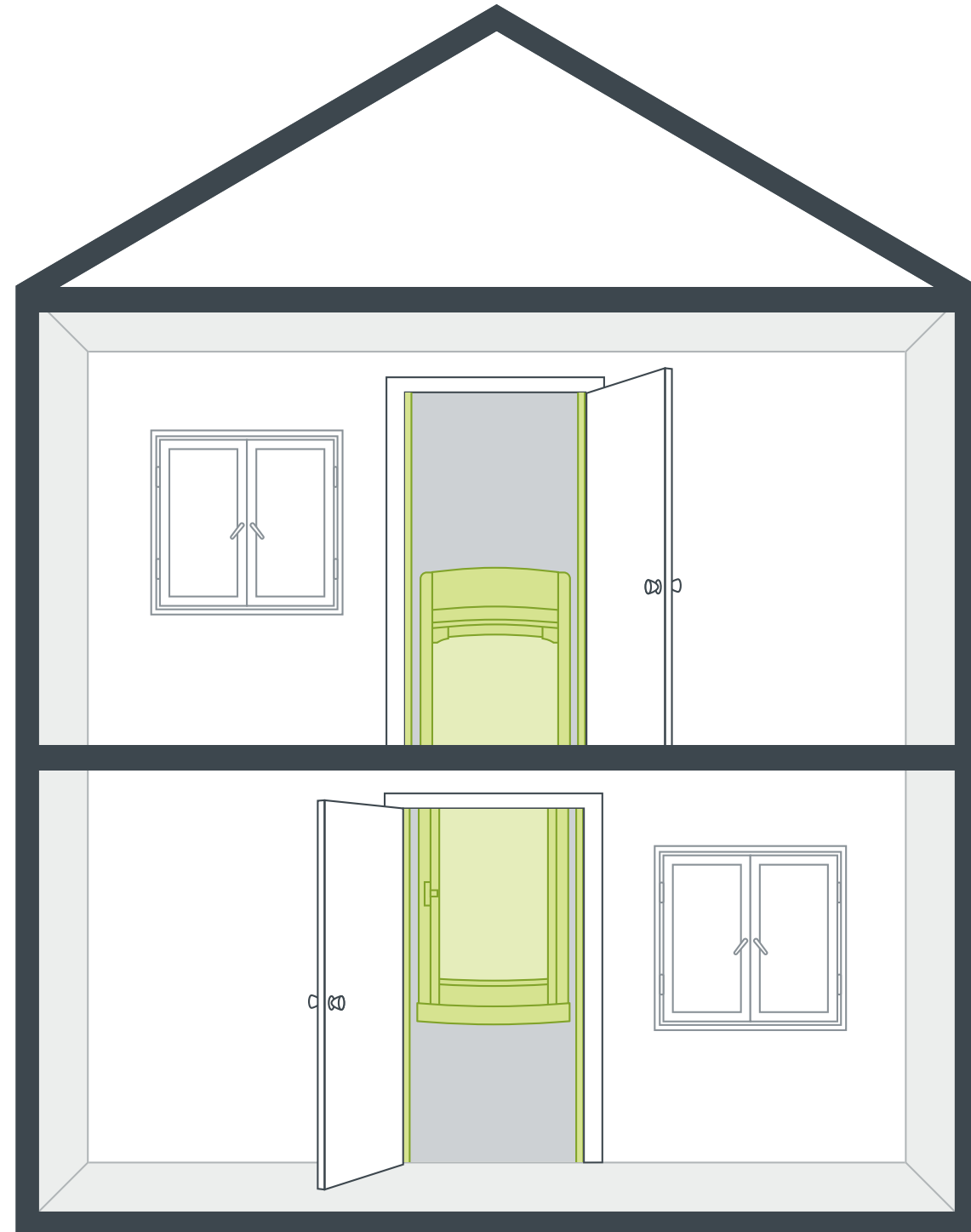
STAIRWELL TO LANDING

If there is enough room in the turn of a staircase, this location makes use of the “dead space” in a stairwell void. The lift will arrive at an upstairs landing through a safety gate.



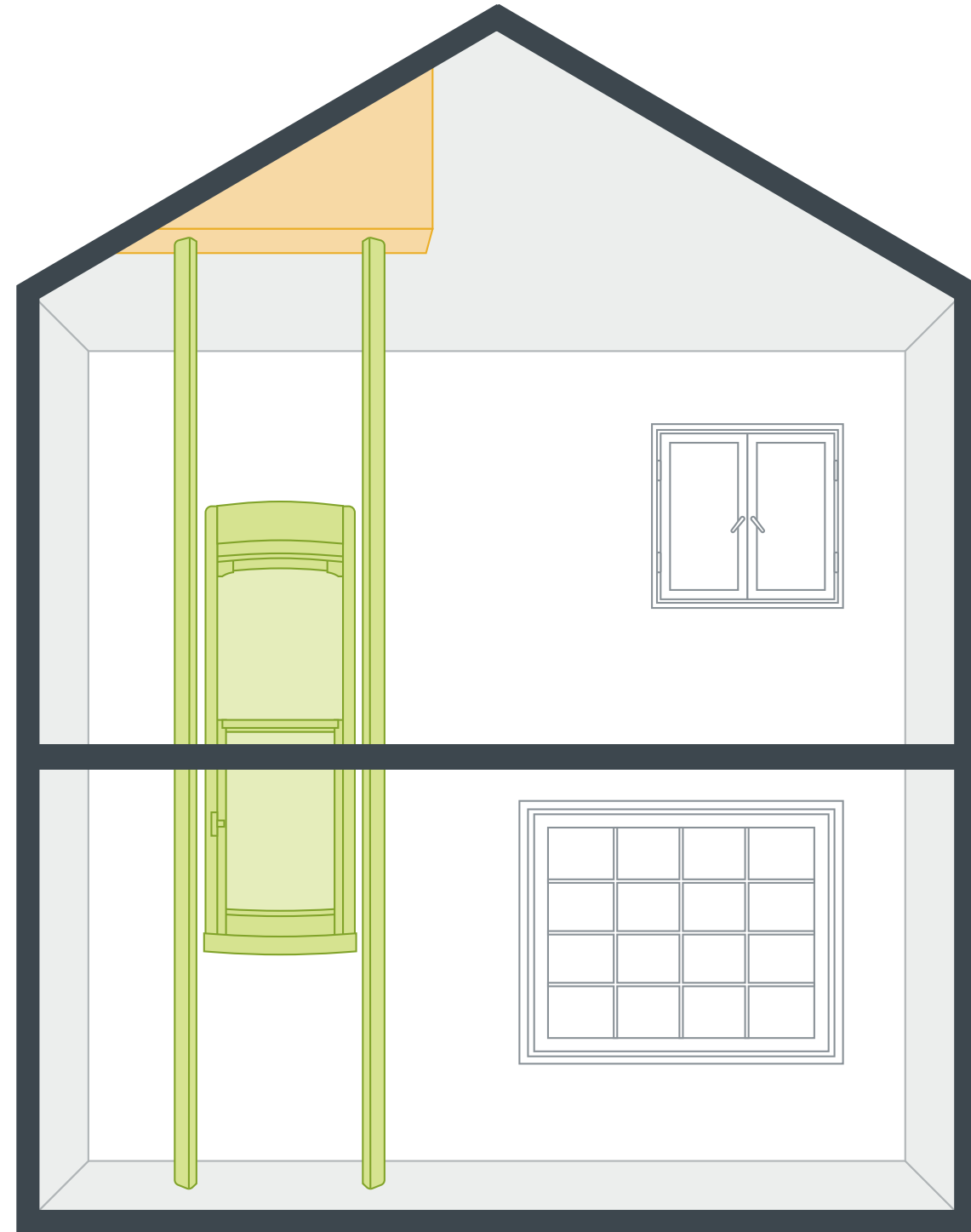
CLOSET

The Stiltz HomeLift is so compact, you can choose to have your lift completely hidden by installing it inside a closet on one or both floors, as layout permits.



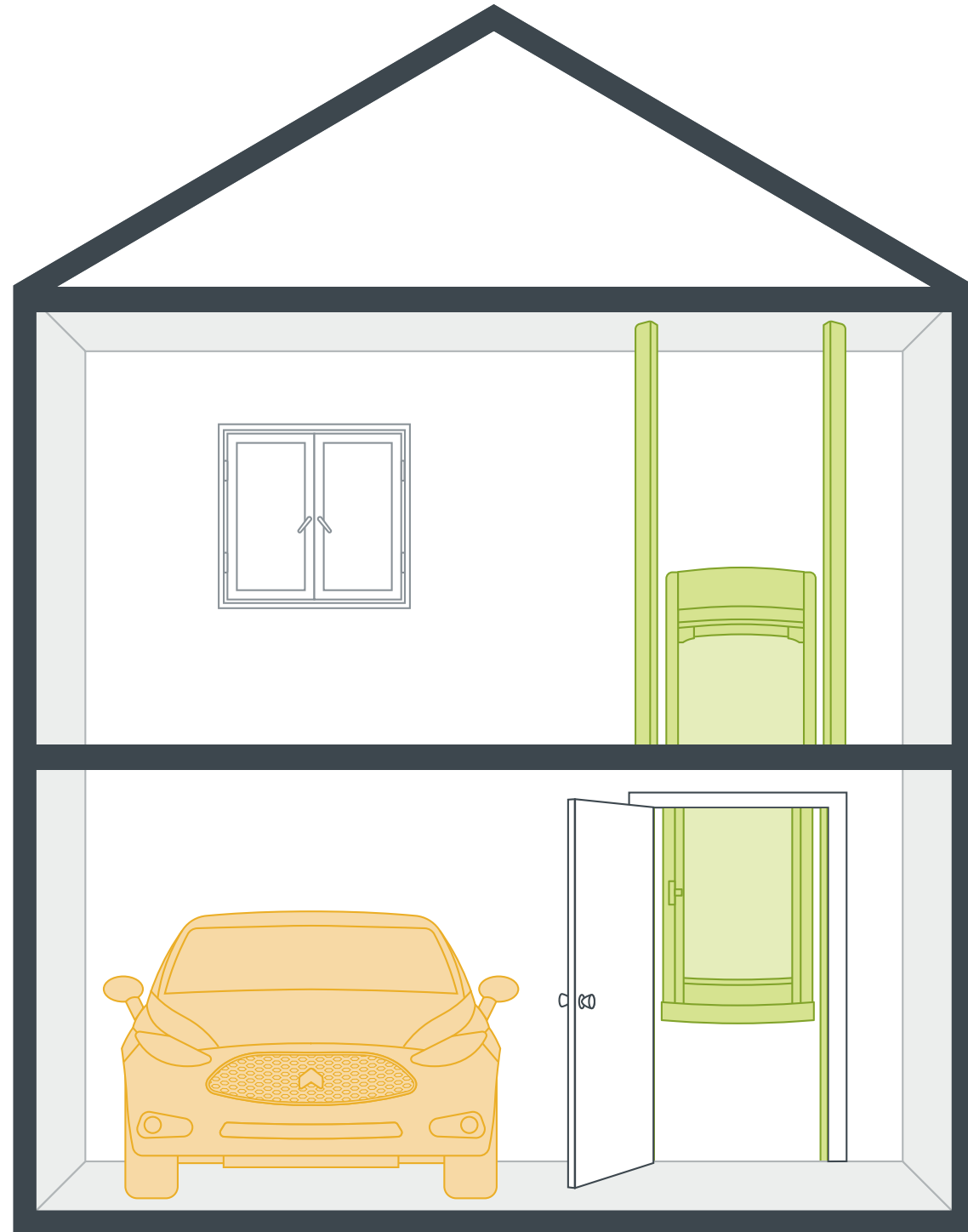
SLOPED CEILINGS

The lift's support rails attach to a horizontal surface. But if you have a vaulted ceiling, a contractor will provide a solution for angled surfaces.



GARAGE

Get quick and safe access from the garage into your home — great for carrying groceries. (This requires the construction of a simple shaft in the garage.)



THROUGH

The Thru-Car, which is unique to Stiltz, lets you enter and exit through opposite sides of the car — ideal for balcony or three-stop lift applications.
