Design Ideas Follow the basic steps from "How to Paint" to create these designs or your own ideas!



POUR background color. • PULL pick thru paint. • Finished design! Follow arrows (A-B).

Pull pick in one continuous stroke (A).

Before you Start

SAFETY INFORMATION:

Ages 8+ Keep out of reach of children under 4 years of age. Contains functional sharp point. Product does not contain food or drink and should not be put in mouth or ingested. Non-toxic.

CLEANUP TIPS AND STAIN ADVISEMENT:

Acrylic pouring paints are made to create permanent artworks when dry. These paints may stain clothing and surfaces. Wear a smock and old clothes. Cover your work surface and any nearby furnishings with scrap paper, wax paper, or other protective material. Keep paint away from walls, carpet, vinyl, finished and unfinished wood, and other materials that cannot be laundered. Clean immediately with soap and water while paint is still wet. Wash hands with soap & water after use.

USAGE TIPS:

Before painting, gently roll the capped paint bottles on a flat surface to mix the paint. Do not shake the bottles. Unscrew the bottle cap and remove the seal ring before use. Recap bottles when not in use. To prevent color mixing, avoid touching the bottle tip to other colors while painting & always recap with the same cap-look inside the cap to see the paint color. If bottles become clogged, DO NOT SQUEEZE THE BOTTLES FORCEFULLY. Doing so may cause splattering. Poke a toothpick or paperclip into the bottle tip to unclog. Then recap and gently tap the upright bottle on a flat surface. Repeat if needed.

DRYING TIME:

Paintings need 24-26 hours to dry to the touch. For best results, do not touch or move your painting until completely dry. Drying time may vary due to temp. and humidity.

How to Paint

Remember: Wear a smock, Roll up sleeves, Cover work surface, Wipe pick w/ paper towel



POUR paint in a spiral. Then, TILT & ROTATE gently (GENTLY squeeze only.) until paint covers surface.



2 PAINT lines, rings, or dots with other colors to make a pattern.


REPEAT around the pattern, pulling in direction shown. **PULL** the pick thru the paint.



PULL pick thru the paint as shown. Let dry at least 24 hours. Display!

Hearts Start with a dot of paint, Pull pick from



Flowers Make a ring with a dot in the center. Pull pick nward to make netals







Waves

Start with stripes.

PAINTING TIPS • If bubbles appear in your painting, gently poke them with the pick to pop before paint dries. • Use steady, gentle pressure to squeeze paint from pottles. • Keep the bottle tip lifted above the paint surface while applying paint to avoid color mixing. • Wipe the pick with paper towel between each stroke direction. If using one continuous stroke, wipe the pick before your next stroke. AFTER YOU'RE DONE . Display your painting on top of the cup or hang it on a hook or tack on the wall. • Use leftover paint to create more designs on discarded lids from home or on mini canvases purchased from a craft store. • You can use the cup to store leftover paints, other art supplies, or your own small items.
