

## Day 27

- I truly hope, each of us has been able to have the Law of Seed, Plant, Harvest take careful root in the soil of our lives. And that we are much more aware that everything we say, do, and come into agreement with, does truly plant seeds for a coming harvest.
- I want all of us to realize the power in our words and actions as they are planting seeds — whether we see it initially, they are setting a harvest in motion.
- Jesus made us kings and priests unto His God and Father (Revelation 1:6). If we are kings, then what we decree (speak out of our mouths) or do (seal with our actions of agreement), we are literally setting in motion law. Just as we witnessed with King Ahasuerus in the book of Esther.
- What we speak over ourselves, our children, and over people has power, and we can cause harm to ourselves, our children, and other people by what we say. “Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so.” James 3:10.
- We speak seeds into people’s soil, seeds that will either bless them or curse them. When we speak cursing or death (bad words) over people’s lives, those words can do one of two things: 1. They can cause that person a bad harvest of any evil we have spoken over them, unless they are made aware of it through Holy Spirit and break it — or we are made aware of what we have spoken and break it. Or 2. We can reap a harvest of cursing for what we have spoken over other people’s lives — “Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.” Luke 6:37.
- Our words and actions have consequences — a coming harvest — Now, God is incredibly patient with us, and He always gives us many opportunities to hear His voice regarding our words and actions, many opportunities to repent before Him, and to be free of any bad harvest. Why? Because God is absolutely good!
- Remember when I kept driving home Romans 8:5? “For those who live according to the flesh SET their MINDS on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.” Now, let’s look at the next verse, “For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.” Romans 8:6.
- I have had many people say to me, “I just don’t understand why everything seems to fall apart around me, or I get hurt all the time, or I never seem to have peace...” And often, when I share the words of God’s amazing revelation He has taught me through scripture with them, they don’t want to hold fast to it; they don’t want to see the truth before them.
- Unfortunately, we have, in the past, been a people who want to do the same thing over and over again, but expect a different result. We have wanted to do everything in our own way, yet we have wanted God to bless it.
- We want to be healthy, yet, in the past, we have said things like, “I always get sick every winter.” And amazingly, sickness has come every winter.
- I realize that the idea that our words having that much power is foreign to most of us, yet doesn’t Jesus say, “Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.” Matthew 11:29-30. In other words, if we fall in step with Jesus, learning from Him, believing scripture as perfect truth and walking in the ways of it, we will find rest and peace for our souls.
- We have learned about our words and actions bringing a harvest, and we have learned how what we see and hear can actually open doors in our life for the enemy to come in and torment us. Now, we can choose to continue in our own ways expecting a different result, or we can accept that God’s ways are not our ways, and we can choose to follow His ways to life and peace. Again, our relationship with God is a relationship of perfect freedom; we all have a choice.

- The other morning, God awakened me with a beautiful truth running through my whole being. And I knew I needed to write it down. He said, “the power of suggestion is really the power of agreement.
  - We have all probably heard people mention the power of suggestion; if we continue to suggest something to someone over and over again, pretty soon what we have suggested in their life comes to pass.
  - God revealed to me, that is satan lying to manipulate the power in the Law of Agreement. Satan is the suggester; he wants us to believe the “power” resides with him, BUT the power has always been in the agreement, and agreement starts with us.
  - He can suggest anything he wants. If we come into agreement with his suggestion, then the power is transferred to what we have now come into agreement with.
  - BUT, if we, “therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee...” James 4:7.
  - The more we know the voice of God; the more we know how He would speak to us, the quicker we will recognize the deceiver when we hear him.
  - When we use James 4:7, we are choosing to keep the power of agreement in our Freedom Giver, in God, and we are denying the liar, our adversary.
  - In that, we are proving that suggestion is powerless — The Power is in AGREEMENT!
  - Agreement is a law we set in motion. If we continually come into agreement with the Truths of scripture, then the Law of Seed, Plant, Harvest that is seeded in our life through that, will ALWAYS give us an amazing harvest of Blessing!
  - Learning this is part of the Truth that sets us free and the knowledge that keeps God’s people from destruction!
  
- Satan only has power over us if we choose to deny the truths of God’s spiritual laws and choose not to set our lives in step with God. Satan only has power if we open doors to him and allow him access to us. The power he takes over us is the power given to us by God — through choice and through ignorance, we relinquish our power and authority over to satan.
- If we want peace and blessing flowing in our lives, we have to choose to make Jesus LORD of our lives, choose to come instep with Him and His ways, and choose to deny our fleshly, carnal desires. We must choose LIFE, by “living according to the Spirit.” (Romans 8:5).
- Instep with all we have learned, satan trembles before us because when our IDENTITY is firmly set in Jesus Christ, who gave us our IDENTITY in the first place, all truth begins to manifest in our lives. Satan’s suggestions, manipulations, deceit, and lies fall at our feet, and we can trample him under them!
- Be blessed, be encouraged as you open your spiritual eyes wider to see and follow the Truths of God, and always know that our KING is firmly on the throne, and there is nothing happening in the world today that He doesn’t see and know about.
- What is He asking you to do in this hour? How is He asking you to stand? If you haven’t asked those questions of Him, I encourage you to do so. For just like Esther, each one of us has been born in this time in history, for such a time as this! Rise up mighty warrior and take your stand with the King of kings and the LORD of lords!! The battle is His; we just have to show up on the battlefield in our armor, ready to do all He asks us to do.
