Day 31

- So, as a few of you may have noticed, I didn't post yesterday. Well, I need you to know that I spend 2 and 3 dedicated hours per daily devotional, so these are not just thrown together; these are not just some nice ideas I came up with. These come from hours of time with Holy Spirit, looking at scripture, pulling from all the places God has lead me, so I can formulate what I have learned in the best teaching way possible to present it here. I have realized that I may have to do this devotional Monday-Friday to give myself time to not only have family time but to also continue to accomplish all of the other things God is having me do in this season as well.
- My heart is full and passionate about all the things God wants us to see, know, and understand — SO, we can walk in total freedom! Freedom from health issues, freedom from all the mental tactics of the enemy — oppression, depression, doubt, fear, confusion — to name a few. Freedom from the ignorance that leads to destruction mentioned in Hosea 4:6.
- GOD IS ABSOLUTELY GOOD!! PERIOD! There is NO evil in Him!!
- I know there are things I have shared and will share that will rub up against our personal idols, our personal rebellions Well, GOOD! Don't we want to be totally free? Then we have to be willing to look at our lives and life choices with Holy Spirit and ask, "Okay, where have I come into agreement with the enemy? Where have I allowed him access to my life, my home, my family, my finances, my health? My children?
- We can be totally free! We can truly know God in His fullness, going deeper and deeper in relationship Now, even making that statement, I have to say, God is so vast and so amazing, that literally an eternity with Him, and we will still be learning new things each moment we walk with Him. No amount of time with Him could ever make us say, "Okay, now I know everything there is to know. I can hang out with someone else." No, God is deeper than we can even fathom. Each deep dive into Him gets better, sweeter, richer, and brings about more freedom The kind of freedom that leads us to know we can step out in faith and raise the dead step out in faith, lay hands on the sick, and see them become well faith to speak to any kind of mountain blocking our life, tell it to move, and it will faith to know there are no boundaries to God, and we aren't afraid to explore His vastness. Faith that heals broken relationships, broken families, broken lives. Faith that saves a nation in a day! Faith!
- I have been walking us down a path of beautiful, foundational truths showing the intricacy of our God showing the Way, and the Truth, and the Life that no one comes to the Father except through Jesus Christ. (John 14:6). In all things, everything real, free, and true has to start with Jesus Christ, Him crucified AND RISEN from the dead!!
- Everything we put into our foundation HAS to be rooted in scriptural truths, revealed through Holy Spirit, so we can see the incredible depths of those truths. We have to be fully aligned/ in agreement with God Himself to walk fully in His ways.
- Satan's goal has always been to distort our view of God, to make us believe that God is random and cruel, that He wishes evil on us, or only loves us conditionally. Satan IS A LIAR! And the father of lies!
- Satan fully understands the spiritual laws because they are his boundaries they hold him in place, even on this side of hell. He knows that we are held to all spiritual laws just as we are held to all natural, scientific, and mathematical laws. Satan's plan is to blind us to the truths of these laws, so he can LEGALLY use them against us. He wants us to believe we are subject (enslaved) to things we CANNOT understand. That is a lie. We are totally free in Jesus Christ, and who the Son sets free is free indeed.
- As we are given the incredible knowledge of the truths of the Law of Seed, Plant, Harvest, the Law of Agreement, the Law of Blessing, and more — we are EMPOWERED by this God given knowledge — our spiritual eyes are opened — we can see the truth, and that truth sets us free! Free from the devil being able to use any of those previous lies against us because

we now see, understand, and know how to easily navigate passed him by using those same spiritual laws. Remember, he is bound to those laws. His only chance to destroy us is to keep us ignorant, so he can manipulate those laws to harm us.

- The law of agreement is a huge tactic the devil uses against us. It's what he had used against Rahab her whole life, until she became aware of and believed in the One True God, the LORD God of Israel. The moment she turned her eyes to Israel's God, God turned His eyes to her. When she came into agreement with God, by first, protecting the Israelite spies, then by obeying their commands for her safety through the destruction of the city of Jericho, and then marrying a man in the Tribe of Judah, Rahab sealed her life within God Most High.
- As we look at Ruth, a Moabite woman like Rahab, a Canaanite prostitute both women were considered the lowest of the low — The moment they turned from their life of destruction and aligned/came into agreement with God Most High, everything changed for them.
- Ruth's moment of agreement with God was when she first refused to leave her mother-inlaw, and then further sealed her covenant with God Most High when she said, "For wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; your people shall be my people, and your God, my God." Ruth 1:16.
- Now, whether either woman realized they were walking within the construct of the Law of Agreement, what they chose to do with their actions and their words, aligned them within God's Chosen Family. Aligned them so perfectly, that they are privileged to be in the line of our Savior and Lord, Jesus Christ.
- Don't ever tell me God didn't show us over and over and over again that He is a redeeming God, always showing us that He plans doors, windows, ladders, people, and events to come into our lives to give us ways back to Him. He never stops calling us, never stops loving us, never stops desiring amazing relationship with us.
- For we desire rich relationship with people because we are created in God's image and made in His likeness. We want relationship because God is relationship. His DNA is our DNA. The more we realize it, the more amazing God relationship becomes, the more amazing our freedom in Him becomes.
- Rahab and Ruth both recognized this, and their courage and faith aligned them to be a part of the family line of the Savior of the world, Jesus Christ!! Wow! That is Powerful!
- So, we pick up our account of Ruth as she begins gleaning (which means picking the heads of grain or fruit off the vine or bush that is left after the harvesters have come through)— She "happens" to pick the very field of one of Naomi's husband's Kinsman Redeemers Well, we know there are no coincidences; its part of our foundational truths from the beginning of this devotional. God in His perfect, intricate love, called Ruth to that field.
- Why could she hear Him call her? Because Ruth had chosen to come into agreement with God by aligning herself with Naomi and God. Ruth begins to glean in one of Boaz' fields. Now, the Bible doesn't state if Ruth was beautiful — yet, something about her immediately caught Boaz' attention.
- "Now behold, Boaz came from Bethlehem, and said to the reapers, "The LORD be with you!" And they answered, "The LORD bless you!" Then Boaz said to his servant who was in charge of the reapers, "Whose young woman is this?" Ruth 2:4-5.
- Okay, first, where was Boaz coming from? Bethlehem where was Jesus born? Bethlehem. Now, we could look passed this and miss something God is nearly shouting at us as we read this passage. He is saying, Boaz, a Kinsman Redeemer, who arrived from Bethlehem is a foreshadowing of JESUS who is the Redeemer, who would be born in Bethlehem. How do I know this? Well, God is very intentional with His words; that's one; and there are no coincidences, that's two; and God is always showing us His great and mighty plan if we will open our eyes to see. Why do you think prophets throughout the whole Bible, including Jesus, the greatest prophet, kept saying, "those with eyes to see, let them see; those with ears to hear, let them hear."

- Second, we see that immediately Boaz notices Ruth. Boaz, the Kinsman Redeemer, noticed Ruth before Ruth, who needed redemption, noticed him. Again, God always initiates the relationship and call to redemption with us. "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him." John 6:44.
- Remember, everything about God is intentional; He does everything for a reason; He does everything on purpose. Nothing with God is coincidence nor random.
- Okay, so tomorrow, we will pick up with Boaz and Ruth's first encounter with each other; From the moment Boaz notices her, he displays how powerful the foreshadowing of redemption is.
- Be blessed and encouraged for our God is an all consuming fire pure and holy in all His ways — everything He does is to show us how great and vast His love for us is — Call to Him, and ask Him to show you His love — get ready, because you will never be the same again!
