

## Day 34

- When Ruth got home from her long day of gleaning in Boaz' fields, Naomi, her mother-in-law, was astonished by how much grain she had collected.
- She said to Ruth, "Where have you gleaned today? And where did you work? Blessed be the one who took notice of you." Ruth 2:19. There is that "took notice of you" again. I love how God is always threading into scripture how He sees us; it doesn't matter how big the crowd is, and the world is a big crowd — God sees each and everyone of us, and it isn't with a heart of condemnation that He sees us — No, it is with a heart of great love, and a desire to fully redeem us unto Himself. So beautiful!
- And how do we know it isn't a heart of condemnation in which He notices us? "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved." John 3:17.
- And how do we know He notices us with a heart of love? "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16.
- I love the TRUTHS of scripture! Those are both absolute promises!
- Okay, so when Ruth tells Naomi it was Boaz who had blessed her, Naomi responds, "Blessed be he of the LORD, who has not forsaken His kindness to the living and the dead!"...This man is a relation of ours, one of our close relatives." Ruth 2:20
- The "he" in "Blessed be he of the LORD" is referring to Boaz. As a Kinsman Redeemer, Naomi recognized that Boaz was acting on the command of the LORD, all capitals. Whether she understood God's system of government of the Law of Seed, Plant, Harvest, I am not certain, but God is showing us that He never forgets. And the "His" in "who has not forsaken His kindness to the living and the dead!" Is referring to the LORD, who brings harvest to the living and the dead. Naomi recognized that the LORD through Boaz is honoring the family line of Elimelech by bringing a covering of blessing for herself and Ruth.
- So, the deeper thread we should see in here is that blessings of those who have gone before us within our family line bring blessings upon us that they sowed for before they died. When we are in heaven, we no longer need the harvest of blessing we seeded into from when we were alive. For we are with our Redeemer!
- So, that seeded harvest of blessing is passed down through our family line, (Deuteronomy 7:9; 1 Chronicles 16:15-22) and it blesses those who come after us. Now, conversely, if we have seeded bad seed, our family line that follows us can harvest that as well. That is why, many of you, may have heard of breaking family curses off of your family line.
- In the natural, science, whether medical or psychological, will say things like, "alcoholism runs in the family," or "Alzheimer's runs in the family," or "Cancer runs in the family," or anger, marital infidelity, lying, etc. We have all probably said something to that effect about our family line before, WHICH if we have, we need to ask God to remove those seeds and plants, because we confirmed the existence of that harvest in our family line WITH OUR WORDS. Those things are curses that have been seeded into the family line. Just as we can reap (take in) the harvest of blessing from our family that has gone before; we can also reap a harvest of cursing that has gone before. BUT, we can break family curses!!
- How do we do that? So glad you asked!!
- By prayer, out loud — "Father God, in Jesus' Name, I break all family curses off my life, off the lives of all my family that is still living, off of all my children and the whole line that will continue from them. I ask for the blood of Jesus to cover my family line, and that all seeds and plants of cursing be completely destroyed, in Jesus' Name. I also ask, Father, in Jesus' Name for You to fill those now clean places with Yourself; Holy Spirit, I invite you into all those places, and I sow seeds of blessing in that now clean soil, seeds of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self control — seeds of grace, wisdom, mercy, faith, and hope, that my ground and the ground of my whole family line will

be full of Your blessings, LORD, in Jesus' Mighty Name, Amen. And Thank You, LORD for all Your blessings!

- It is very important to cover that soil with Jesus blood, because His blood cleanses us from all unrighteousness. (1John 1:9). It is also very important to fill that now clean soil with God's blessings — We learn this from Jesus in Luke 11 when He is talking about unclean spirits. Remember, God is Absolutely Good, so anything that is not good, like curses, bad words, bad actions, bad thoughts, DO NOT come from God; they originate with the enemy of our soul, satan. He drops all those things into our minds, in hopes that we will come into agreement with them — agreement is the seed, and from there the seed becomes a plant, and then a harvest.
- “When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ And when he comes, he finds it swept and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first.” Luke 11:24-26.
- Notice that the unclean spirit calls that man, “MY HOUSE.” This is why we must fill ourselves with first, Jesus, through asking Him to save us and be our Lord, and then we want to ask Jesus to give us the gift of His Father, the gift of Holy Spirit, so the house, us, can no longer be a place where the enemy of our soul has rights to. When we ask Jesus and Holy Spirit to fill us, they rip up the deed that satan once had over our house, our life. They take residence and then satan can no longer claim us as his house — he will still try to torment us, because that's who he is, but he no longer has ownership of us. He can only have a place of influence in us if we give it to him through agreement — through our words, actions, and thoughts, which are the seed of agreement with him.
- Remember, everything God says is multi-dimensional. He is always trying to reveal spiritual laws, and satan is always trying to hide and distort them, so we cannot see and know the truth and be free.
- But Jesus said, “I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.” John 10:10 (10 meaning perfect order). And “Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.” John 8:36.
- Remember, words are powerful — Because Jesus is the Word — Words can destroy our lives just as easily as a tormenting spirit can. God wants us free in every area of our lives. He wants us to have all His knowledge, so that we won't be destroyed (Hosea 4:6). Keep speaking good words over your life and the lives of your family and others.
- “By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted, but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.” Proverbs 11:11. Remember that 11 is a double edged sword, meaning either heroes rising (where God recognizes the faithfulness of people) or it means disorder (judgment where things fall apart). So, by marking that scripture in Proverbs with double 11's, God is emphasizing the power behind those words. “By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted, but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.” We can see in this scripture, that because we are part of God's government, His Ekklesia, what we say has not only familial effects, but governmental effects as well. And the greater our position of authority, the more power those words have over people and territory.
- How do we know we are part of God's government, His Ekklesia? Well, we are a part of Him. “I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.” John 15:5, and Jesus is the Head of the Ekklesia “For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, [His is capitalized, so we know it is referring to Jesus kingdom] to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.” Isaiah 9:6 We know he is referring to earthly kingdoms because he mentions the throne of David, and we know he is also referring to Godly Kingdoms because His is capitalized when it says, “over His kingdom.”

- This is why we should never take places of authority for granted; for we are all held accountable to the LORD (God in His system of government) for every word, every action, and every thought — Example: if I only have authority over myself, I am still held accountable to the LORD for what I speak over myself, what I do, and what I think. It will directly effect my life, with either blessings or cursings. We are all children of God, saved and unsaved alike, made in His image and in His likeness (Genesis 1:26). When we are cursing ourselves, we are speaking cursings to not only God's creation, us, but to God Himself, for we are in His image and in His likeness.
- On a larger scale, if I have a job, and my responsibilities effect people I work with, then I am held accountable to the LORD for every word, every action, and every thought. If I have a spouse, family, children, friends — I think you can see the progression.
- Now, if I am the head of a small or major corporation, then every word, every action, and every thought will effect all the people I am in authority over.
- If I am a pastor or church leader over God's people, I am held accountable for every word, every action, every thought in regard to all the people under my care. (See Matthew 18:6-7).
- If I am in any rank in government, whatever my territory of authority, whether it be a town, city, region, state, or nation, I am directly held accountable to the LORD (God in His system of government), and not only will I be held accountable for my words, actions, and thoughts in that place of authority, it will DIRECTLY effect every single person under my authority.
- Having said that, let me take it a step further. In the United States of America, citizens have a Constitutional right to vote. In voting (an action), WE ARE HELD ACCOUNTABLE to the LORD (God in His system of government) for how we vote — meaning, if who we vote for is a person of great character, and all their actions are good toward the country and toward the people, we will receive blessing for the seed of our vote for that person or persons, or act of law. Conversely, if we cast a vote for a person, persons, or act of law that has bad intentions or evil intentions toward the people and the nation, we will ALSO reap a harvest of that seed vote we cast. (Side note: not voting still holds us accountable to the LORD (God in His system of government) for He birthed us into a nation that gives the people a right to vote — so He has placed us in a position of authority to cast a vote.)
- We cannot get around it or away from it. We cannot just say, "Oh, I don't believe that." Well, I can say, "I don't believe in gravity." But my saying, I don't believe in gravity, doesn't make it not exist.
- The whole system with all its laws was put into place at the beginning of all creation, all natural, scientific, mathematical, and spiritual laws. If we don't deny the truth and accuracy of natural, scientific, and mathematical laws, we cannot deny the truth and accuracy of the spiritual laws.
- Wow! That was a lot of information. Who would have thought that God had woven all those truths through the book of Ruth. Of course, He weaved a thread of all of that through book of Ruth, and I gave you scriptures that are also a part of that same thread. But, do you see now, even more, how multi-dimensional scripture is.
- I just had a thought, and I believe God has been speaking to us through it the whole time — the internet is made up of circuits, threads. We even call our communication on the internet, threads. We even say that once it is out there, it is out there forever. Hmmm, Who do you think has been trying to speak to us through all of that rhetoric. God is ALWAYS talking to us; He is always trying to draw us back to His words He wrote down for us in scripture, His incredible banquet feast.
- We will pick up in the book of Ruth tomorrow, and see what journey God takes us on in the next part of that amazing account in history!
- Until then, I speak blessings over your lives, that God will speak to you and comfort you, bring you His peace, and fill you with a desire to know Him more. Be encouraged because scripture just gets better and better.

- “Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.” Jeremiah 33:3 (3 is fullness and being complete.) Blessings to being complete in the fullness of all that God has for each of us!
