- Have you ever noticed that what we think we need is often not what we need at all? You may be asking yourself or me out loud in your car or wherever you are listening or reading this, where are you going with this, Heidi?
- Well, let's just talk about the huge elephant in the room; actually, there could be a small herd of elephants in the room, depending on the room you are in, but for this moment, I am going to talk about the elephant in the room that is visual in the whole world. There is a lot of fear and even panic flying around, and many Christians and those who are not are feeling it and possibly partaking in it.
- There is a huge divide that has occurred in this world, and it is shaking every family, every place of business, every government, every church body, every relationship, and every person.
- We often think that shaking or disrupting is a bad thing; we see, feel, hear, and fully experience the shaking (in many cases), and we think, it's the end of the world as we know it. The enemy is aware of our unsettling during the shaking, and in some, near panic, and he pounces on that with fear and doubt and unbelief. He vomits into our brains that this is God's judgment, and God hates us.
- Now, do I believe that the shaking is "from" God — well, yes and no. I hear you saying, "Wait, what? How can it be both, Heidi?" Well, I have been learning, as well as have been sharing with all of you that God set everything in motion from the beginning of time, all laws, spiritual, natural, scientific, and mathematical. We have learned that God breathed Himself into the governmental system that holds all creation together through those laws, and we have come to know that the governmental system is Yahweh or Jehovah, and we see that in our Bibles as all capitals LORD, found in the Old Testament.
- So, having said that, I do believe we, the whole world, are experiencing a harvest being reaped throughout every land. The iniquity of the evil that people have sown into the earth has come to a fullness, as well as all of the intercession of the saints of God over the years has come to a fullness. So, through the LORD, God's system of government, a harvest is being reaped throughout the earth, but did God, Himself, (personal God, Elohim) through anger cause this shaking all around us? No — the shaking has come because those who have coupled with evil have seeded for this harvest. Now, I am not saying that you have coupled with evil, or I have coupled with evil. I'm just saying that any evil that we have done has brought this harvest. Any evil that we have done that has not been covered by the blood of Jesus.
- BUT, shaking isn't all bad. Shaking wakes people up; it exposes all that has been hidden, so that truth will abound; it takes those of us who have relationship with Jesus Christ right down to our foundation in Him. It reveals to each Christian just how firm the foundation we stand on is. And it is now showing the world, especially those who have believed there is no God, or God is dead, that there is indeed a God in heaven; He is mighty, just, and powerful, full of love, mercy, grace, and forgiveness, and although longsuffering, so that everyone would have an opportunity to turn to Him, to find life, and have it more abundantly, He does not tarry forever.
- "Whose voice then shook the earth; but now He has promised, saying, "Yet once more I shake not only the earth, but also heaven." Now this, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire." Hebrews 12:26-29.
- So, what remains after the shaking, we will all know is foundational. Many of us who know Jesus Christ have put things in our own personal foundations that were never meant to be there. We have built with inferior material on that foundation, which most likely came from a

religious spirit or lack of true studying of the Word of God. And I'm not condemning anybody out there. I did this myself for many years.

- God's perfect plan is never for us to learn how to hold onto Him only in a storm; God's perfect plan is that in all seasons and situations, we are so grafted into the vine, so at rest in Him and our relationship with Him, that when any shaking comes, we may see it with our eyes, but we are unaffected by it because our foundation is firm, and what we have built on that foundation can withstand any shaking. That is the true heart of God.
- "For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ." 1 Corinthians 3:11. Let's pause here. Jesus Christ as our foundation means way more than just accepting Him as Savior. The name Jesus Christ as our foundation encompasses every single truth and meaning connected to His name.
- Jesus Christ is the way (the only path to the Father), and the truth (anything spoken, lived, or believed that is contrary to Jesus Christ is not truth), and Jesus is the life (the only way to life is through Him; anything apart from Him is death, and if we partake in it, it will lead us to death). Jesus Christ established His Ekklesia (which we call the church, but really it is His governing body of believers); Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, Teacher. The Word of God says, "you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple of the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit." Ephesians 2:19-22.
- Now, if apostles and prophets are a part of our foundation, then why does most of the church not "recognize" those within the body today, who God has called to be apostles and prophets? Because everything in the house of God, which also includes the Word of God is said to be living and breathing. If we are only basing our foundation on the prophets who died in the Bible and the apostles from the New Testament, then we are standing on a dead foundation. All of those prophets and apostles of old are with God; their words are living still, and as we build our foundation as the Word of God states, then we will have a firm foundation, but if we deny apostles and prophets, who the Bible says are part of our foundation, then we will not be able to stand when shaking comes.
- The enemy of our souls, satan, has worked very hard to keep the TRUTH of apostles and prophets out of the main church today. Because satan does not want us to be corrected in our misunderstanding of the truths of scripture (through the apostles today), and he doesn't want us to hear from the LORD through the prophets, and he doesn't want us to get fresh revelation from the Word through the prophets either. He wants us weak, so that we will never rise up and be who God destined us to be, a mighty, beautiful, sanctified, consecrated, unified, holy, and powerful Bride of Christ, full of authority, wisdom, faith, hope, grace, mercy, forgiveness, and most of all the Love of God.
- So, this shaking that is happening now, yes it is a harvest for the iniquity that has seeded for it through the law of Seed, Plant, Harvest, but it is not anger or hate for God's children because God only wants good for us. "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11.
- And we also need to realize that this harvest is not only a harvest for the iniquity sown; it is a harvest for all of the faithful prayers of intercession that have gone up as well. "Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest, I will say to the reapers [Angels], "First gather together the tares [the wicked harvest] and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat [the good harvest] into My barn." Matthew 13:30.
- So, let me encourage you to turn your eyes to the LORD of the harvest, and ask Him to burn or remove all the bad harvest from your life with the blood of Jesus, and to show you all of the areas of your life where the foundation has not been laid well; ask Him to remove the bad foundation and to help you lay a true foundation in Him, and when the foundation is laid, ask Him to help you build on it, only using material that cannot be burned, destroyed, nor

shaken. He will help you do it. How do I know? Because He has been helping me to do it now for sometime.

- Remember, this is an accelerated time because the LORD of the harvest is so near, so I encourage you, beseech you actually, to kneel before Him, surrender everything you have and everything you are to Jesus Christ our Lord, Savior, and King. It will be the greatest sacrifice of your life, and when I say “greatest sacrifice,” I do not mean that in the negative. Because a real, holy sacrifice before the LORD has to be given willingly, like Jesus did, or it isn’t pleasing to the LORD. We are free to choose, not slaves to be forced. Our free willing sacrifice of ourselves to the LORD is the key to the door of heaven, and when we use it, it unlocks an amazing place of relationship with God, that those who haven’t yet began to tap into it, never knew was possible. I know it has been that way for me. I have known Jesus relationship for 46 years, and these last two have been the most powerful and thrilling of my whole time with Him! And all because I listened, yielded, and haven’t held anything back from Him — finally.
- I bless you with the grace, which is God’s power to overcome, to turn to God in fullness. I bless you with the passion to seek Him, and I bless you with a hunger for His Word, which will feed you, sustain you, and fill you with every possible thing you will need to be mighty in Him!
- Be greatly encouraged because God has GREAT and GLORIOUS plans for each us, just ahead, and we need to take each step in faith, in full trust, and know that greater is He who is in me, than he who is in the world! Rise up mighty warrior! It’s your time to shine, for we are God’s incredible reflection to the whole world!
