

Day 51

- Good Morning!! Wasn't yesterday's revelation AMAZING?!! I hope you listened to it again and also printed off the PDF from my website and read through it. This is a massive revelation God wants us to grasp, consecrate to, and walk in faith with. I can feel it to the core of me!
- I'm going to take us back to Matthew 9, so we can see how powerful the law of FAITH is!
- So as we learned yesterday, the ruler worshiped Jesus by saying, "My daughter has just died, but come and lay Your hand on her and she will live." (Matthew 9:18). Why did Jesus turn to him in the first place? Because He felt the man's faith, and the law of faith turns God's face to us. And when the man worshiped Jesus through activating Jesus' purpose here on earth, His Luke 4:18-19 purpose, Jesus rose up and followed after him and so did His disciples.
- "And suddenly, a woman who had a flow of blood for twelve years came from behind and touched the hem of His garment. For she said to herself, "If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well." Matthew 9:20-21.
- Now, to really grasp the magnitude of this, we have to look at this same account in Luke 8:42-45. "But as He went, the multitudes thronged Him. Now a woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on PHYSICIANS and COULD NOT BE HEALED BY ANY, came from behind and touched the border of His garment. And IMMEDIATELY her flow of blood stopped."
- Okay, there are some really big things we have to point out here before we go on. First, we know that Jesus was on his way with the ruler, following the man's faith. Second, we see in this account in Luke, that he was thronged by the multitudes of people. Now, anyone who has left a theatre in Times Square in New York City when all the other shows are letting out, knows exactly what a throng of a multitude of people looks like. Think, so close to you that you can barely move. As a matter of fact, you hope the crowd is moving in the direction you want to go, so you can actually get to where you are going, because to move through that kind of crowd is nearly impossible.
- Of course, Jesus was the reason for the massive crowd of people, so they were moving with Him. Everyone was reaching out to touch Him, holding onto Him, begging Him for healing, for deliverance, for something. But Jesus kept His eyes on the ruler who was leading Him by the man's faith.
- Until, the woman with the issuing of blood touched Him.
- "And Jesus said, "Who touched me?" Luke 8:45.
- Now, I just showed you what it looked like around Jesus. EVERYONE was touching Him, or trying to. What was the difference?
- We have to go back to Matthew 9:21, "For she said to herself, "If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well." Two major things happened here. First, she had faith; she believed/knew that He could heal her. Second, she acted on her faith, by pushing her way through the throng of people to touch the hem of His garment.
- Now, it was illegal for this woman to be among the people. Why? Because according to Levitical law, a woman with an issuing of blood was unclean, so she could not be among the people until the bleeding had stopped, and she had gone through the cleansing process and had been declared clean by the priest from her synagogue, which would include offering a sacrifice for the cleansing.
- And because she had been bleeding for 12 years, she had most likely been completely shut away from all human contact the whole time (because if she came in contact with other people, they would be made unclean by her), the only people she probably talked to at all were the physicians she paid to try to heal her, which they could not. Talk about being a captive, or being oppressed.

- She had to have heard the stories spoken of about this Man, Jesus, even locked away in her captivity. Maybe she heard about Him from one of the physicians who was taking all of her money but giving her nothing in return. Maybe they said it to her flippantly, as if Jesus was her last hope.
- Somehow, hope was stirred up in her, and it awakened her faith. The stories of healings He had done began to feed that stirred up faith. How do I know this? "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Romans 10:17. And we know that Jesus is the Word.
- With her faith raised up, she did the unthinkable. She left her prison, risked the punishment that would come if she were discovered among the people unclean, and she activated her faith.
- To touch the hem of Jesus' garment in a massive throng of people, meant she had to, most likely, get on her hands and knees and crawl passed the feet of each person trying to grab hold of Him. She had to have been stepped on, halted multiple times in her pursuit, but her faith had been activated by her action to leave her captivity and go for the Jubilee Giver. And even if it took her all day, she was going to touch this Man's garment. Because her faith had told her, if she just touched His garment, she would be healed.
- All those people bagging Him, touching Him, and He never took His eyes off the ruler with the daughter — nothing stopped Jesus' faith walk until, faith touched Him again — and turned His head.
- "Who touched Me?" He said, then Peter and those with Him said, "Master, the multitudes throng and press You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?'" Luke 8:45. "But Jesus said, "Somebody touched Me, for I perceived power going out from Me." Luke 8:46.
- Now, why did Jesus make a point to call her out? Did He want to embarrass her? Of course not! He wanted everyone in the crowd to understand an incredible principle an incredible law being played out before their very eyes.
- "Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and she was healed immediately. And He said to her [in only the amazing way He can], "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace." Luke 8:47-48.
- Now, I have to interject an amazing, beautiful thing Jesus actually said to her. "Go in peace." Jesus pronounced over her peace, His peace. "The peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:7. He was declaring that nothing would steal her healing from her, for He declared that her heart and her mind were guard by Him. He declared her healing complete and secure!! He literally denied the enemy access to torment her by trying to steal way her healing by satan's lies. Jesus guarded her heart and her mind by saying, "Go in Peace." Oh, the power of declaring the Words of Christ Jesus!! Let's grab a firm hold of this amazing truth.
- So, when Jesus said, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well."
- He was actually saying to her and all who were listening (including us), "Daughter, your Faith is the key that unlocks the door to every aspect of My purpose, My destiny in bringing Isaiah 61:1-2, and Luke 4:18-19 to you and every person in this world and to those who are to come. When you set out in faith, you activated that faith, which opened the door to your healing. Revelation told you that if you but touched My garment, you would be healed. You consecrated yourself to that revelation and then activated your faith, and so when you touched My garment, you were indeed healed. Did you see, Daughter, everyone here was touching Me, begging for Me to heal them or given them something, but it was you who showed them that in all things of the LORD, God in His system of government, that to turn My head to you, it takes the law of faith, in acting on that law, I will fulfill Luke 4:18-19 and John 14:12-14. And why will I do it? Because your faith action is worship to me, and when I am worshiped by My children, I always draw near. For, if you draw near to God, He will draw near to you. (James 4:8)."
- "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and

recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.” Luke 4:18-19.

- “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.” John 14:12-14.
- It was so incredibly important for Jesus to teach this truth of the law of faith to this woman, to all who were listening, and to us right here and now, that he paused in following the first law of faith call and made it clear to everyone — Why did He do it? He had to; it is part of His purpose in fulfilling all the Father called Him to do. “He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor.” He had to stop and preach to gospel of freedom and prosperity; because all who were present were poor — poor in spirit, poor in understand, poor in truth, poor in body.
- After teaching this amazing truth, Jesus continued on His original set course of the law of faith, entered the ruler’s house, and healed the man’s daughter.
- The lesson was so important to be set in foundational stone, He knew the dead would keep.
- We belong to the Jubilee Giver! We are the children of the Most High God. What liberty are you not living? Is it your health, your spirit, your soul (mind, will, and emotions)? Maybe a bit of all three? Grab hold of this revelation for yourself, consecrate to it; as your faith rises to meet this revelation, activate it by stepping out into it. Remember, to decree and declare Luke 4:18-19 is worship to Jesus; and when we step out in faith, and worship Jesus with our declarations of His word, He will turn to us and work to fulfill His purpose in our lives. He has to; He bound Himself to His purpose when He said, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.” Luke 4:21.
- Just as He told me on our driveway that day, “You have learned about the dominion and authority I have given you; now, go lay hands on that tree and command life back into it.” It didn’t happen instantly, but when He told me to do it, I believed Him; I had faith to do it. I activated my faith by being obedient in following His command. And over a matter of days, faith unlocked the door, activated the words of my command, and the LORD, God in His system of government, moved upon my command, and life came back to that tree. This is the power of God! All glory and honor and praise to our God and King!! In Jesus Mighty, Amazing, Matchless Name! Amen!
- I speak blessing over your lives, that you have become powerhouse warriors with no boundaries, full of faith to move all kinds of mountains, and a purpose firmly consecrated to it, so that you can run your race with endurance.
- Be greatly encouraged! The God of peace speaks over you, and each time you activate faith and see His power of liberty come into your life or those you pray for, declare, “Go in Peace,” which will tell the enemy, satan, that he has no right to try and steal that liberty because the God of peace is guarding your heart and your mind through Christ Jesus! Amen! Powerful!
- So, I declare over you regarding this revelation, Go in Peace!
