

## Day 53

- Good Morning!! I hope you and Holy Spirit had some really good talk time yesterday, and you wrote down everything He said to you.
- So, let me ask again, “What is God saying to you? What is He revealing to you? Are you writing it down? Are you searching scripture with Him to have Him blow your mind with the truth of the fresh revelation? Because if He gives you something, He will always take you to His Word to search it out. He does nothing apart from His Word. And as you search it out, are you consecrating to that new revelation, so that the enemy of our soul, satan, cannot come and steal it away? (Mark 4). Are you then asking Holy Spirit, “What do I do with it? Whom do I share it with?” And if you have asked Him that, and He gives you a name or an avenue in which to share it, share it! Be obedient to step out in anyway He asks you to do.
- “For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately went on a journey.” Matthew 25:14-15.
- Each revelation we receive is a “talent”; it is a gift from God for us to share with the rest of the world around us. “Freely you have received, freely give.” Matthew 10:8. Now, each revelation may not be shared with every person in Creation, but God will always give us a person or people or event in which to share what He has given to us. When we are faithful in sharing it, He gives us more to share, and He gives us more people to share with.
- “Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents. And likewise he who had received two gained two more also.” Matthew 25:16-17.
- So the first two servants were quick to use what had been given to them, and their obedience garnered then double of what they started with. Their faithfulness was quickly rewarded.
- “But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord’s money. After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them.” Matthew 25:18-19.
- The third servant, who had received one talent, did nothing with it. He didn’t heed Matthew 10:8, “Freely you have received, freely give.”
- In the next few verses, we see the lord of the servants call them to him to find out what they did with what he gave them. The first servant had ten talents to show his lord.
- “Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.” Matthew 25:21.
- The second servant was told the same thing from his lord.
- “Then he who had received the one talent came and said, ‘Lord, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you have not sowed, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Look, there you have what is yours.’” Matthew 25:24-25.
- I hope all of you are catching the seed, plant, harvest going on here...so, who is this servant talking to? The LORD, all capitals, God in His system of government; He is speaking with Yahweh, the aspect of God who is in charge of all seed, plant, harvest.
- “But his lord answered and said to him, ‘You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed. So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest. So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents.’” Matthew 25:26-28.

- Now, many of you may feel this is harsh, but as I said before, God never gives us something to keep for ourselves. What could putting it in the bank represent here? Perhaps sharing in Bible study, for to strengthen the already saved would definitely be considered interest back to the LORD. Maybe it is raising your kids up in the way they should go, and when they are old, they will not depart from it. (Proverbs 22:6). Even if we have only been given one talent, there is always something we can do with it. Fervent prayer for others could be the interest on that one talent. “The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.” James 5:16.
- When we come to Jesus, accept His salvation, and make Him Lord of our lives, we have been, “crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.” Galatians 2:20.
- And just maybe, that interest in the bank represents tithing and giving. Because we know that everything is seed, plant, harvest — every word, action, and intent of the heart is seed. When we give to the things of the LORD, churches, ministries, people in need, we have a promise of a return from our giving.
- “Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.” Luke 6:38. That is the promised harvest for giving.
- And tithe, which is to give the first fruits of anything you have: money and a harvest of any kind. It is 10% of what we have just brought in, off the top — first fruits. It is our very seed to the LORD of the harvest. When we take in a blessing, we are to be a blessing. Every farmer knows, that when you bring in a harvest, from that harvest, you collect seeds, and then you reseed from those seeds back into the ground. The reseeded is the tithe offering to the LORD of the harvest. If we have a harvest of money from working, we take the tithe, the 10% first fruits off the top, meaning it is paid first before bills are paid and before we use the money for personal enjoyment.
- “Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this,” Says the LORD of hosts, “If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. “And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, So that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field,” Says the LORD of hosts; “And all nations will call you blessed, For you will be a delightful land,” Says the LORD of hosts.” Malachi 3:10-12.
- If you don’t have a church at this moment, give your first fruits offering to a ministry that is feeding you. That’s what the food in His house is—the teaching of the Word of God. And yes, it is also literal food, for the church is called to help the poor and the hungry, the widows and orphans.
- This tithe and any giving is not offered to the ministry or the person you are giving it to; it is an offering unto the LORD of the harvest. It is our seed back into Him. It is to be given freely and cheerfully.
- “So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.” 2 Corinthians 9:7.
- We give unto the LORD of the harvest; we never give to try and control the person or ministry we give to. We give freely and cheerfully, but we also give expectantly! God tells us of all of the amazing blessings that come to the giver and tither, which includes the LORD Himself rebuking the devourer (satan) for us if we are tithers. That alone is a tremendous reason to tithe!!
- As I have been saying, the system of seed, plant, harvest is always generating; we can either plant good seed that will bring in an amazing harvest of blessing, or we can plant bad seed, or no seed —
- “For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.” Matthew 25:29-30.

- I am commissioned by God to share all that I have learned from Him, that each of us may walk in greater freedom and blessing! For He wants that none of us fall under Hosea 4:6 “My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge.”
- To be destroyed because of ignorance is a great crime. So, again, “What has God been saying to you? Have you written it down? Have you searched it out in Scripture? Have you consecrated to it? And have you begun to share it with whomever God has told you to?
- For, “Freely you have received, freely give.” Matthew 10:18.
  
- I speak blessing over your lives, that everything you put your hand to will yield 30, 60, and a 100 fold, and that each time you will turn around and seed back into the LORD of the harvest, so that all who are around you may be blessed.
- Be greatly encouraged! Your understanding, revelation knowledge, and faith is really increasing! And our Amazing God, Lord Jesus, is roaring over us!! When the Lion of Judah roars, it is always good for His children. Do you hear the Lion roaring?
