- Good Morning!! I hope you are literally exploding with excitement in the deeper walk with God you are on!
- When I said the other day, that my favorite part in using and sharing what God gives me is that my relationship with Him is deepening and growing, I meant it. To receive fresh revelation from the LORD is the most exhilarating experience of my life. I know of two families that own homes because my mom gave them the seed money to buy them. God told her to give it, and she didn't hesitate to give it. I know of ministries and churches that were able to expand or build buildings because my mom remained obedient and gave every time God told her to.
- What a legacy!! Without even fully understanding God in His system of government of seed, plant, harvest, our Mom taught us it. Out of pure obedience, she honored the LORD of the harvest, without hesitation. I have seen her do it over and over and over and over and over again, and I have always been in awe of her complete obedience and generosity. It has been beautiful to witness, and has been a testimony to my own life to turn around and be as generous and as obedient as she has been for most of my life.
- "Obedience is better than sacrifice." 1 Samuel 15:22. And by the way, that scripture was spoken to King Saul from the LORD, through the prophet Samuel. See, God always gets us full circle.
- God is always trying to get us to walk in His blessings. It is never about control or trying to deny us what we want. It is always about instructing us, so that we will not miss one single blessing He has spoken into existence.
- Blessing comes through our obedience. It isn't said with a controlling air of, "I will only bless you IF you obey me." NO! What He has always been saying is, "I have set everything in motion. Everything, all blessing has been spoken into the earth from the first time I said bless. I am just trying to tell you the way to go, so you can receive every single one of those blessings if possible."
- It's like a game with hidden treasures. If we want to win the game with the most treasure, aren't we going to walk the path that leads to the treasure? Or are we going to play the game our own way, and then be angry that we didn't get any treasure? Or be mad at the person who created the game because our way of doing things didn't give us what we wanted, treasure. You can see how ridiculous that sounds, right?
- "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and

I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.” Jeremiah 29:11-13.

- Why do things our way, the hard way? When Jesus said, “For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.” Matthew 11:30.
- The only one who kind of wins when we don’t walk in obedience, when we do things our own way, is the enemy of our soul, satan. He rejoices (if he can rejoice) or revels in the fact that we are torturing ourselves, and he doesn’t have to do anything.
- This is why obedience is better than sacrifice. Do you know what would fill God with great joy? If we never had to ask forgiveness, if we never had to be corrected, if we literally found and grabbed hold of every blessing He has hidden for us along our paths. All He wants for us is His best!
