

## Day 55

- Good Morning! I hope your Thanksgiving was an amazing time, not just full of good food but of a time of great thankfulness to God and to those around you, whom He has in your life for a reason.
- So, I have to be up front and honest. I haven't had Thanksgiving yet, even though I posted for Thanksgiving yesterday, and am sharing with you today, but because it is Thanksgiving week, I have recorded these ahead of time, so I can prepare for Thanksgiving and spend time with family and friends.
- Having said that, God awakened me very early this morning, which is several days before Thanksgiving. I was awakened with incredible teaching running through me, which really has become quite normal for me. It is like Holy Spirit is teaching my spirit while I sleep, and I think sometimes the teaching gets so intense, it actually wakes my body up. Now, I don't know if that makes sense or not, but that is what it is like for me.
- I was receiving in-depth teaching on, "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Romans 10:17.
- And as I was being awakened with the teaching literally playing out inside of me, I had an amazing revelation regarding it.
- All the years I have spent reading my Bible, over and over and over again, as well as all the places God sent me to have an intense study time with Him in a place in Scripture, all of that was truly being written on my heart; all the words, repeatedly written inside of me, over and over again.
- So, many of you may have heard me say, "How did it take me so long to see and hear all of this amazing revelation?" You may also remember me sharing that in October of 2020, we were at Dutch Sheets reset conference in Ohio, and in the middle of worship during the Saturday session, I was feeling compelled — by my flesh — to apologize for not doing more with my life, more for God — 41 years of knowing Him, at that time, and I had not accomplished the destiny He had placed inside of me at conception. And God, so amazingly, so sweetly said to me, and so clearly I might add, "You are not late. You are right on time. I have always planned for you to be in this moment right now."
- That word from God was so powerful for me in that moment. And the reason I share it here is because, once again, in my flesh, I have thought, "I have been reading my Bible faithfully for over 40 years, and I have never seen the Bible as I am seeing it right now." I was saying that to myself in a semi-negative light. But in the same breath, I could hear Holy Spirit say to me, "But now is the time for you to receive this revelation. Now is the time for Me to give it to you, to release to those I have put before you."
- So, the revelation God gave me this morning regarding Romans 10:17, "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God," is this. He spoke it so clearly inside of me, it resonated through my whole being.
- "The reason you are able to have revelation after revelation after revelation now is because you have the Word written inside of you, over and over and over again, from all those years of reading it."
- "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." God speaks a revelation to me; I catch it because it is grounded in His word, the word that has been written over and over again on my heart. I consecrate to that revelation, which grows my faith up to that revelation, then I step out in that new found faith, which activates it, and then, because I have been faithful to walk in the new revelation, God gives me more.
- And the more I am obedient through faith, the more He gives me. To the point that Holy Spirit is now giving full classes to me while I am sleeping! Okay, I have actually said to the Lord before, "Couldn't you just pour this into me while I sleep, so that I will just know it upon waking up?" Now, I believe that was spoken from a place of laziness on my part, but remember, every word is a seed. And so, all these years after asking God that question, He

is now answering in me! I am being faithful, so the once question spoken in the flesh, is now being given to me as a harvest of the spirit!! God IS Absolutely Good!!

- So, what is the great take away from this revelation? If we want revelation knowledge from Holy Spirit, we have to be putting the Word of God inside of us. Revelation is the light being turned on in a room that was once dark, and now we can see everything in the room. But if nothing is in the room to see, the revelation knowledge from the light being turned on will yield very little. We must fill that room with the Word of God, so when Holy Spirit turns the light on in that room, we will have so much revelation to take from the light being turned on, it will blow our minds in amazement!
- And we also need to be praying for God to give us revelation knowledge. It is vital. Why is it so vital? Revelation knowledge of scripture is how we build the foundation of our life in Christ Jesus, and it is also how we build on that foundation.
- “So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.” Romans 10:17. As we put Bible truth inside of us, and then we hear the Word of God preached or taught, sometimes the same thing over and over, then, one day, after having had that Word written on our hearts, and having had the word spoken over and over to us, the light flips on in a room inside of us, and we see revelation knowledge of those very words inside that room, and the whole thing comes to life! It has many dimensions to it, and we often see it as a movie played out before us. We probably have our jaw drop open. We probably say, “Oh my goodness! You’ve got to be kidding! It has been there the whole time!” We want to share this new found revelation with a friend or family member. We can see it so clearly and so completely that we could teach it for the rest of our lives. As a matter of fact, the new revelation has driven us into our Bible, because we are compelled to search it out. We are compelled to follow Holy Spirit on a treasure hunt, to see every nuance of that fresh revelation, every scripture. And from that revelation, we have one or a handful of scriptures that are now inside of our memory, inscribed so deeply, we can now bring them up at will, even with addresses — like Romans 10:17. It is now a bedrock revelation to me, so I not only know the scripture, I remember the address, which allows me to share it more easily.
- Isn’t that amazing! How do we memorize scripture more affectively? I would ask for revelation from God. Because, for me, if I have had a revelation on something in scripture, that scripture and where it is located in the Bible becomes tattooed on my whole being. And it usually evokes lots of other scriptures to come around it for support. I wouldn’t call it a law, but I would call it a principle. And principles or precepts are great building material to use when building on our firm foundation of our life in Christ Jesus.
- So, as you think on all that has been shared this week, I speak a blessing over you that each truth explodes as fresh revelation inside of you by Holy Spirit, and that as He flips the light on, you hungrily take in every tiny detail of that room, getting every single morsel eaten up, so that revelation will become strong, powerful, and firm inside of you, and that you will remember to consecrate to it, seeing it being planted into your foundation, and that as your faith grows up to it, you will activate it by stepping out in faith.
- Be greatly encouraged! The LORD of your life is excited about you, and He is completely delighted that you are wanting to know Him more, because He longs for you to know Him, as you are known by Him.
