GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRIES CLOSE: MARCH 9th, 2026. All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show and filled out entirely or may be made online.

****Online Entries can be made at www.ringsideproductionsllc.com**

You can pay with Credit Card or Check (no convenience fee if paying by check)!

A horse must be entered in the name of his registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. **All entries must be accompanied by a valid check or money order for the full amount of all fees made out to GCAHA or pay with the credit card option.** A signature by the parent is required if a minor is showing. *No entries will be accepted with open checks. All entries must be paid in full. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Open checks will only be accepted for post entries.*

IF ENTERING BY PAPER ENTRY FORM, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING MUST BE MAILED TO THE SHOW SECRETARY (NO EMAIL ENTRIES):

1. The complete, signed entry form and all waivers.
2. Fees Payable to GCAHA. If paying by credit card, fees will apply.
3. **All Memberships and Registration Transfers must be complete prior to entering the show.**

A \$25 Incomplete Entry Fee will be charged for entries in which Memberships are not current or if Registration Transfers are not complete. **No copies of papers or membership cards need to be mailed.**

*If you do not have a current AHA membership, you must join or purchase the AHA single event membership on the AHA website. Exhibitors showing in Amateur Owner classes must be listed as an owner of the horse on the registration papers of the horse they are exhibiting.

**All entries must be made in writing on an official entry form for this show. Every owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler and parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor must sign the entry form waivers and must be an AHA Competition Member or purchase a non-member/single event on the AHA website. A horse must be entered in the name of his recorded owner. The complete address and phone number of the recorded owner must be given, even if an agent enters the horse.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries for all classes except working cow (for working cow see below) will be accepted if made at least one hour prior to the beginning of the session in which the class is to be held. A one-time \$30.00 per horse post entry fee will be charged. Horses entered by March 9th, 2026 may enter additional classes at the show and not be subject to the post entry fee. **Working cow post entries:** Post entries after March 9th and before March 20th will have a one-time working cow post entry fee of \$65.00. No post entries will be allowed for Working Cow after March 20th.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Entries may be scratched from the show PRIOR TO March 9th, 2026 with a refund of all fees EXCEPT the office fee. After that date, withdrawals accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show will receive refunds of class entry fees only.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

Horses shown in the Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and must be entered under their full registered name. Horses shown in the Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry and entered under their registered name.



Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show Committee shall decide on questions not covered by USEF rules and its decisions will be final.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A

COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

AHA REQUIREMENTS:

- A)** All exhibitors entered in this event must be a current AHA member with a competition card or purchase a Single Event Membership fee of \$45.00 per person on the AHA website. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse.
- B)** There is an AHA mandatory fee of \$24.00 per horse. (\$10 AHA judges' commission and education/evaluation, Resolution 9-90 and \$14 AHA per horse fee - concurrent show).
- C)** Walk-trot and Lead line riders are exempt from AHA non-member fees.

ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN: The show complies with Article GR1213 of the USEF Rules. Should an ambulance be needed, call 911 and contact the Show Office or the show arena Paddock Manager.

ARENAS: Ford Arena is 135' x 240' and is sandy loam and clay. Mustang Arena is 135' x 240' and is sandy loam and clay. Warm-up arenas are sandy loam and clay.

BAD CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: There will be a \$50.00 handling fee charged for any returned check or declined credit card. Action in accordance with USEF rules will be taken against any owner, exhibitor or trainer who does not make a returned check/declined credit card charge good and will be reported to AHA.

BARN OFFICE HOURS, ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES: Barn manager is Tony Reid 314-719-6447. Contact Tony for arrival and departure if earlier than Monday, March 23rd or later than Noon, Sunday March 29th. Early arrival or late departure is \$110 per day per stall used. *This is what the facility is charging for early arrival or late departure.*

TULSA FAIRGROUNDS AND/OR GCHA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LEFT UNATTENDED.

CALL FOR CLASSES: The two-minute gate will be enforced. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than two minutes, after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the gate person and request a three-minute gate hold. Note: Due to unforeseeable problems with the mechanical devices, the paddock and barn calls over the PA system must be considered a COURTESY. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES DUE TO EMERGENCIES: In the event that a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), no refund of entry fees will be made.

DOGS: Dogs will be permitted on the show grounds but MUST always be on leashes. No dogs will be allowed in the show arena. This is a USEF Yellow Warning card offense (GR1037 & GR1301.6).

ENTRIES: All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show and filled out entirely. A horse must be entered in the name of his registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. All entries must be accompanied by a valid check or money order for the full amount of all fees made out to GCAHA. A signature is required by the parent if a minor is showing. *No entries will be accepted with open checks. All entries must be paid in full. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Open checks will only be accepted for post entries.*

FARRIER: A Farrier will be available on show grounds beginning March 27th or on call with number posted at office. No other Farrier will be permitted to work on the grounds without registering with the show committee. Exhibitors wishing to use their private Farrier must have the Farrier apply at the Show Office and pay a registration fee of \$100 before they can work on the show grounds.

HEALTH REGULATIONS: ALL horses attending must have the following health requirements and Proof will be required before anyone can get back numbers of the following:

- A negative Coggins Test dated within twelve (12) months (must be original not photocopy).
- All out of state horses must also be accompanied by an Official Health Certificate issued within 14 days of arrival that identifies the animals listed, including all vaccinations, and date and results of required test. Health Certificate must contain the following verbiage: "The equine listed on this CVI have, during the 21 days prior to the shipment date, not originated from a premises under EHV-1 quarantine, not been exposed to an EHV-1 positive equine, and not attended any event where an EHV-1 positive equine has been confirmed."
- All horses admitted to the grounds must have an EHV-1 within the last 6 months.

THE ABOVE ITEMS SHOULD BE CARRIED WITH YOU – DO NOT FORWARD WITH YOUR ENTRY. Any animal brought into Oklahoma must observe all regulations of the State of Oklahoma, Animal Health Division. Any horse that develops a communicable disease must be removed from the show grounds.

USEF GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule

1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number, and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.

INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW: Any exhibitor who fails to settle his indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA and USEF. Any exhibitor who fails to settle his indebtedness in full to a FARRIER or VETERINARIAN for his/her services during the show BEFORE LEAVING THE GROUNDS will be barred from taking part in future shows.

JUDGES: This show will be judged according to the single judge systems. If an official is unable to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official according to USEF rules. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersion on the judging and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee. No contact shall be made with the Judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the committee for such purpose. Further, if a Steward is onsite, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

PRIZE LIST CHANGES AND/OR CORRECTIONS: Changes and/or corrections to the Premium, if any, will be posted on the Club's website, www.gcaha.com.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The show Management will be governed by USEF rules with respect to refusal of entries.

RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither Green Country Arabian Horse Association nor the Tulsa Fairgrounds will be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to any horse exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any person, animal or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Green Country Arabian Horse Association and the Tulsa Fairgrounds against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be the result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions herein set forth.

RV PARKING: RV hook ups with electricity, water and sewer are available. Please call Tulsa Expo Square directly at 918-744-1113 ext. 2154 for more information and to reserve a spot.

SCRATCHING CLASSES: No refund of entry fee when scratching classes.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: Show office will open Wednesday, March 25th by 10 AM. Show office will open each show day 1 hour prior to the start of classes. The show office will remain open throughout the show and will close after the end of the show each day.

STALLIONS are not allowed in showmanship or walk-trot classes.

STALLS: Stalls are 10 X 10 and are on asphalt floors with a door. Stalls and alleyways must be kept clean. Horse tie out is available with a ground tie fee of \$10 per day per horse, no overnight. Stalls can be reserved by sending in the appropriate stall fees, but no stalls will be held without payment. If stalls are removed, or partitions are removed, the fairgrounds will charge us \$34/stall, and those fees will be passed onto the exhibitors.

USEF RULEBOOK AR101 ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE: **Purebred:** Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., or the Arabian Horse Association as a Purebred Arabian and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (or in the case of a foreign entry, which has not been issued said certificate of registration, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Association), or, **if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for** (Exception: AR249.1) **and must be entered under their full registered name.** (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers). A copy of the registration papers showing the owner of record with the Arabian Horse Association must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. A copy of the registration papers will be returned when exhibitors pick up their numbers. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. (Exception: Horses under one year of age).

Half-Arabians and Anglo-Arabians: Horses shown in this section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the International Arabian Horse Association or the Arabian Horse Association or the Canadian Partbred Arabian Register as a Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian, **or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.**

DEFINITIONS & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

DEFINITIONS:

The following abbreviations, as defined, will be used to describe class specifications:

JOTR/JOTD — Junior Owner to Ride/Junior Owner to Drive.

AOTR/AOTD — Amateur Owner to Ride/Amateur Owner to Drive.

JTR/JTD — Junior Exhibitor to Ride/Junior Exhibitor to Drive.

ATR/ATD/AATR — Amateur to Ride/Amateur to Drive/Adult Amateur to Ride.

SELECT — AOT, AAOT, AT, AAT, JOT, JT — Refer to USEF AR113.1f

Amateur — Every rider having reached his/her 19th birthday prior to 12/1/25 must have in his/her possession an amateur card issued yearly by USEF or make application for such card at least one hour prior to riding in Amateur To Ride classes. Applications may be secured from the horse show office. See USEF GR808.

Amateur owners — Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner classes. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR122. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted.)

Limit Horse — A limit horse class is open to horses that have not won six (6) first place ribbons at Regular Member Shows of USEF or the Canadian Equestrian Federation in the particular performance division in which they are shown. A Limit entry is such from the date of the closing of entries for this show.

This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF, Arabian Horse Division. **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.** Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF Rule book, and particularly the complete Arabian and Half-Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications. The show committee will decide questions not covered by the USEF Rules, and its decision will be final.

Breeding/Gelding in-hand classes will use the In the Ring Class Procedure and the Comparative Judging system will be in place. You can view this procedure in the 2022 USEF Rule book AR107. Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian Show Champions and Reserve Champions shall be at least two years old and are selected as outlined in GR810.5. Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian yearling geldings may compete for Champion gelding. Purebred yearling geldings may compete for Champion gelding. In a Breeding section of the Arabian division, the Junior, Senior or Show (Grand) Championship will be awarded to one of the horses which has placed first in a qualifying class. Qualifying classes for championships must be designated in the prize list. After the Championship has been awarded, the horse which has placed second in the qualifying class to the horse awarded the Championship shall compete with the remaining first place winners for the Reserve Championship.

Lead-Line: Open to riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday as of December 1, 2023. Rider is exempt from AHA and USEF membership requirements. Refer to the USEF rulebook Subchapter AR-28 Lead-line section for more information.

Ranch Horse Riding: The Ranch Horse Riding horse should reflect the versatility, attitude, and movement of a working horse. The horse's performance should simulate a horse riding outside the confines of an arena and that of a working ranch horse. This class should show the horse's ability to work at a forward, working speed while under control by the rider. Light contact should be rewarded, and horse does not have to be shown on a full drape of reins. **The overall manners and responsiveness of the horse while performing the Walk/Trot-Jog/Canter-Lope and the extended jog & extended lope (at least one direction), and the horse's quality of movement are the primary considerations. Patterns available in office.**

Walk-Trot 10 & Under Classes: Open to riders 10 years old and under. A rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized or non-recognized competition that required a lope or canter. Stallions are prohibited. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter any other classes except Breeding/In-Hand, Showmanship, or other Walk-Trot classes.

Academy Class Specifications

The AHA Academy Riding division is designed to welcome new riders into the Arabian horse show world by offering a positive, low-pressure introduction to competition. Open to beginning riders of any breed, Academy classes provide an opportunity to build skills, gain confidence, and experience the joy of showing within a supportive and educational environment. Sections may be provided to allow multiple riders to show the same horse. ***Sections will be assigned at Instructors request.**

RIDERS: * Are encouraged to be in a professionally operated lesson program. (not required) * Are encouraged but not required to be an AHA member. First Year Academy Exhibitors are eligible for a FREE AHA Youth Membership. * Riding saddle seat suits, hunt coats and western chaps are NOT allowed * Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or colored jeans are considered appropriate. * A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. * A riding helmet is MANDATORY for riders 18 years of age and under and suggested for all ages. * Appropriate footwear with a small heel is MANDATORY. * Riders are NOT allowed to cross enter into any non-Academy riding classes and are ineligible to compete in Academy classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a non-Academy type show.

HORSES & EQUIPMENT: * Horses must be regularly used as lesson horses: While it is preferred that horses are owned by instructors, horses may be owned or leased by riders IF they are used and shown regularly by other riders as a lesson/school horse. * Any breed of horse is allowed, and registration is not required. Horses must be suitable to Academy division displaying good manners and a quiet disposition. * Any horse and rider that is deemed unsafe or is not abiding by these rules may be eliminated by the horse show management or judge. * A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. * Work bridles and bits, including snaffles are allowed, and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, the tie down martingales is NOT allowed. * Horses can cross enter in any Academy type class within the same show, but riders may not cross enter between the Leadline, Walk/Trot, or the Walk/Trot/Canter classes. * Show grooming is permitted, but not necessary as **HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED**.

JUDGING: * All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage. and upon the riding skills of the rider. * Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horses rate in a consistent manner. * Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. * Headers are allowed in the line up in all walk/trot classes. * **HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED**, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses while presenting themselves to their advantage. * Horsemanship Pleasure is meant to differ from the Equitation class in that it is judged more on the rider's ability to display their horse to its best advantage, communicating to the judge through their horsemanship and riding abilities that the horse is a pleasure to ride and can be guided and set up to show to its best advantage. * Classes may be split at the discretion of show management. * Entries into these classes must follow written Show Premium rules but are NOT AHA or USEF sanctioned classes.

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.
