

Track A Family Practice (FP) / Greater Victoria / Attachment of up to 2000 patient / 2250 patient waitlist to be generated

Patient residing in Greater Victoria. Patient is not in Long Term Care and is “unattached” or current primary care provider to leave practice within 6 months*.

*Patients cannot have left a practice by their own choice.

Patient qualifies for Complex Care (G14033, G14075) (**two** of: Diabetes, Kidney Disease, Respiratory Disease, Heart Failure, Ischemic Heart Disease, Liver Disease, Cerebrovascular Disease, Neurodegenerative Disease)
 or
 Patient is Medically Frail.
 or
 Patient is over the age of 70.

Patients will be allocated in a ratio of 5 (ROS FP IMG) : 5 (Dr. Elnagmy) : 2 (Dr. Velikovsky) : 2 (Dr. Zabakolas) : 1 (Dr. Turpin). Intake for these start October 2020. Dr. Ward will act as MRP until Feb 2021 on behalf of Dr. Elnagmy and until July 2021 for ROS FP IMG.

Waitlist for Track A FP will close after the first 2250 patient applications have been obtained. Patients can expect to be called anywhere from October 2020—December 2021. Typically, only 5-10 ‘meet and greet’ visits can be done per day and **a patient is NOT considered part of a medical practice until this visit has occurred.**

Patients who qualify will be called for official intake and meet-and-greets in the order their applications were received. They will be called a maximum of 2 times and then removed from the list. No preference will be given to sex, social-economic status, race, sexual orientation, religion, etc... however, for this track, preference is given to the elderly and Complex Care patients who reside in Greater Victoria.
