#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

## Barry Baker Clerk of the Circuit Court

**Synopsis:** Consider approval to fund the Clerk's Office an additional \$7,000 to account for an increase in Board-related clerking duties.

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

To have the Board of County Commissioners fund an additional \$7,000 for an increase in Board-related clerking duties.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

In discussions with the Code Enforcement Officer, Robin Crespo, our office has learned that there will be a drastic increase in Code Enforcement hearings to account for a large backlog of cases as well as ongoing and future cases. Instead of once a quarter or once a year, these hearings will be held on basically a weekly basis for approximately 4 hours each for the foreseeable future. This will require a deputy clerk to attend some 16 to 20 hours of hearings per month, in addition to time spent both before and after the hearings to have the minutes ready. As our office already clerks several other boards, this will result in meeting overlaps with the two deputy clerks who currently attend these meetings. We are requesting \$7,000 to help fund a partial position for this additional clerking work.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

That the Suwannee County Board of County Commissioners review the information presented by the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court and approve a \$7,000 increase in funding to account for an increase in Board-related clerking duties.
